1. Introduction

Welcome to the user manual for your XINLEI Mobile TV Stand, model ML70A. This stand is designed to provide a versatile and stable mounting solution for most 32-75 inch flat or curved screen televisions. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper installation and safe operation.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to your product:

- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 88 lbs (40 kg).
- Ensure the VESA mounting pattern of your TV is compatible (Min 100x100mm, Max 600x400mm).
- Always lock the casters when the stand is in a stationary position to prevent accidental movement.
- Assemble the stand on a soft, clean surface to avoid scratches.
- · Keep children and pets away during assembly.
- If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble. Contact customer support.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. While a detailed parts list is not provided, typical components include:

- X-shaped base components
- · Dual support columns
- · TV mounting brackets
- · Lockable casters (wheels)
- · Assembly hardware (screws, washers, nuts, Allen wrench)

5. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have two people for certain steps, especially when mounting the TV.

Step 1: Assemble the Base

Connect the X-shaped base components and attach the dual columns. Ensure all screws are tightened securely.





6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Adjusting Height

The stand offers 4 levels of height adjustment. To adjust, unlock the safety pins on the columns, raise or lower the TV to the desired height, and re-insert the safety pins securely.




Image description: An illustration demonstrating the four levels of height adjustment available on the TV stand, allowing users to optimize viewing height for different seating positions.

Moving the Stand

To move the stand, unlock all four casters. Gently push the stand to its new location. Once positioned, lock all casters to prevent unintended movement.

7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper function of your TV stand:

- Regularly check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem: The TV stand is unstable.

Solution: Ensure all assembly screws are fully tightened. Verify that the TV weight and VESA pattern are within the specified limits. Make sure the casters are locked when the stand is stationary.

Problem: Difficulty moving the stand.

Solution: Check that all four casters are unlocked. Clear any obstructions from the caster wheels.


Problem: TV is not level after mounting.

Solution: Re-check the installation of the TV mounting brackets on the back of the TV. Adjust the height of the columns if necessary to ensure the TV is level.
