1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use and care of your Timex Men's Monopoly Watch, model TW2Y47100JR. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.

2. SETUP: SETTING THE TIME

To set the time on your Timex Monopoly Watch, follow these steps:

1. **Locate the Crown:** The crown is the small knob located on the right side of the watch case.
2. **Pull Out the Crown:** Gently pull the crown outwards until you feel a click. This will stop the second hand.
3. **Set the Time:** Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
4. **Push In the Crown:** Once the correct time is set, push the crown back into its original position. The second hand will resume movement.

3. OPERATING YOUR WATCH

3.1 Wearing the Watch

Adjust the green fabric strap to fit comfortably around your wrist. The buckle should be securely fastened to prevent the watch from slipping or causing discomfort.

3.2 Water Resistance

Your Timex Monopoly Watch is water resistant up to 30 meters (3 ATM). This means it is suitable for everyday use and can withstand splashes or brief immersion in water. However, it is **not recommended** for swimming, showering, or diving. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet to prevent water intrusion.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the fabric strap, a damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure it is thoroughly dried afterwards.
- **Avoid Chemicals:** Do not expose your watch to harsh chemicals, solvents, or detergents, as these can damage the case, strap, or internal components.
- **Temperature Extremes:** Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) or sudden temperature changes, which can affect its accuracy and seals.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the watch stops running, it indicates the battery needs replacement. This should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and function. The watch uses a SR626SW cell.

- **Storage:** When not in use, store your watch in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and strong magnetic fields.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running	Dead battery	Replace battery (SR626SW) by a professional.
Incorrect time display	Crown pulled out; time not set correctly	Push crown in completely. Re-set time as per Section 2.
Condensation under crystal	Water intrusion; exposure to extreme temperature changes	Seek professional service immediately to prevent further damage.
