4. SETUP

4.1. Wireless Connection (2.4GHz)

1. Locate the USB adapter inside the mouse's bottom compartment.
2. Plug the USB adapter into an available USB port on your computer.
3. Turn on the mouse using the power switch on the bottom.
4. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.

4.2. Wired Connection

1. Connect the Type-C cable to the mouse's front port.
2. Connect the other end of the Type-C cable to an available USB port on your computer.
3. The mouse will function immediately in wired mode and will also charge.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. DPI Adjustment

The Rapoo VT7 features 26K independent X/Y DPI for precise tracking. Use the DPI +/- buttons on the mouse to switch between sensitivity levels on-the-fly. You can customize these settings further using the A Hub software.

5.2. Programmable Buttons

The mouse is equipped with 10 programmable buttons. These buttons can be customized for macros or specific functions using the A Hub software. Settings can be saved to the onboard memory for use across different devices.

5.3. Polling Rate

Experience a true 8000Hz wireless polling rate for minimal lag and fast reactions, ideal for competitive gaming environments.

6. CHARGING

The Rapoo VT7 is equipped with a long-lasting internal rechargeable battery. To charge the mouse:

1. Connect the provided Type-C cable to the mouse's charging port.
2. Plug the other end of the cable into a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).
3. The mouse supports wireless charging (P5 Wireless Charging Dock sold separately).

A full charge can provide up to 750 hours of battery life at 1000Hz, thanks to the integrated Nordic nRF54L15 MCU for ultra-low-power wireless technology.




Image: Multiple screenshots of the Rapoo A Hub software interface, showing options for button programming, DPI settings, and other advanced customizations.




Image: A screenshot from the A Hub software displaying the

DPI settings interface with adjustable X and Y axis sliders.




Image: A screenshot from the A Hub software illustrating the key programming interface, allowing users to assign functions and macros to mouse buttons.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

9.1. Mouse Not Responding

- Ensure the mouse is powered on.
- For wireless mode, check if the USB adapter is securely plugged into the computer. Try a different USB port.
- For wired mode, ensure the Type-C cable is securely connected to both the mouse and the computer.
- Check the battery level. If low, charge the mouse.

9.2. DPI/Button Customization Issues

- Ensure the A Hub software is installed and up-to-date.
- Restart the software and try applying settings again.
- Refer to the software's help section for detailed customization guides.
