## SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all parts listed in the packaging contents are present.
2. **Battery Installation:** Locate the removable battery pack. Align it with the battery slot on the main motor unit and slide it in until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Charging the Battery:** Connect the power adapter to the charging port on the main motor unit or directly to the removable battery. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. The battery indicator lights will show charging status. Fully charge the battery before first use.
4. **Assembling the Stick Vacuum:**
  - Attach the extension wand to the main motor unit by aligning the connectors and pushing until it clicks.
  - Attach the motorized floor brush head to the other end of the extension wand, ensuring it clicks into place.
5. **Assembling as Handheld:** For handheld use, attach desired accessory nozzles (e.g., crevice tool, dusting brush) directly to the main motor unit.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the trigger on the handle to turn the vacuum on. Press it again to turn it off.
2. **Battery Indicator:** The LED lights on the top of the main unit indicate the remaining battery life.
3. **Adjusting Suction Power:** The vacuum operates at a powerful 20KPa suction.
4. **Using the Floor Head:** For hard floors and low-pile carpets, use the motorized floor brush head. Its low-profile design allows for easy cleaning under furniture and appliances.
5. **Using Attachments:**
  - To change attachments, press the release button on the connection point and pull the current attachment off.
  - Align the new attachment with the connection point and push until it clicks into place.
  - Use the crevice tool for narrow gaps and corners.
  - Use the dusting brush for delicate surfaces, baseboards, and upholstery.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your INSE V770 vacuum cleaner.

### 1. Emptying the Dustbin

1. Ensure the vacuum is turned off.
2. Locate the dustbin release button on the main motor unit (often near the dustbin itself).
3. Press the release button to detach the dustbin from the main unit.
4. Position the dustbin over a trash receptacle.
5. Locate the dustbin bottom release latch and press it to open the bottom flap, allowing debris to fall out.
6. Close the dustbin flap securely and reattach the dustbin to the main unit until it clicks.

## 2. Cleaning the Filter

1. After emptying the dustbin, twist the top cover of the dustbin counter-clockwise to remove it.
2. Carefully pull out the filter assembly (usually a cylindrical filter with a mesh screen).
3. Use the provided cleaning tool (often with a brush and a small blade) to brush off accumulated dust and debris from the filter. Tap the filter gently against a hard surface to dislodge fine dust.
4. Rinse the filter under running water if necessary (ensure it is completely dry before reinstallation).
5. Reinsert the clean filter assembly into the dustbin and twist the top cover clockwise to secure it.

## 3. Cleaning the Brush Roll

1. Ensure the vacuum is off and detached from the power source.
2. Turn the motorized floor brush head upside down.
3. Locate the brush roll access cover (often secured by a latch or screws). Open or remove the cover.
4. Carefully remove the brush roll.
5. Use the provided cleaning tool's blade to cut away any tangled hair or fibers wrapped around the brush roll. Use the brush end to remove any remaining debris.
6. Clean any debris from the brush roll housing.

7. Reinsert the clean brush roll, secure the access cover, and reattach the floor head.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:**
  - Check if the battery is fully charged.
  - Ensure the battery is correctly installed.
  - Verify the power adapter is properly connected during charging.
- **Reduced Suction:**
  - Empty the dustbin if it is full.
  - Clean the filter as described in the Maintenance section.
  - Check for blockages in the nozzle, extension wand, or main unit.
  - Ensure all connections are secure.
- **Brush Roll Not Spinning:**
  - Check for tangled hair or debris on the brush roll and clean it.
  - Ensure the brush roll is correctly installed.
- **Unusual Noise:**
  - Check for any foreign objects caught in the brush roll or air pathways.
  - Ensure all components are securely assembled.
