Midea MERI26B1AGY Countertop Bullet-Ice Maker Instruction Manual

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using your Midea MERI26B1AGY Countertop Bullet-Ice Maker. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the appliance is connected to a properly grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquids.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Use only potable water in the ice maker.
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Do not place the appliance near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- This appliance is for household use only.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Midea MERI26B1AGY Countertop Bullet-Ice Maker is designed to produce bullet-shaped ice quickly and efficiently. It features a compact design, two ice cube size options, and a self-cleaning function.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including any tape or protective film. Inspect the appliance for any damage.

3.2 Placement

Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance (at least 4 inches of space on all sides). This unit is designed for countertop use.

3.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the 'Maintenance' section for detailed cleaning instructions.

4. OPERATION

4.1 Adding Water

Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the 'MAX' fill line. Do not overfill.

4.2 Powering On and Selecting Ice Size

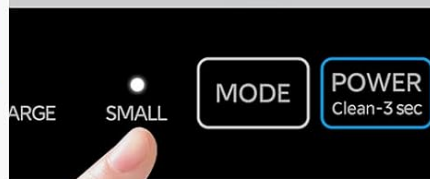
1. Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Press the 'ON/OFF' button to turn on the appliance.

3. Press the 'MODE' button to select your desired ice cube size: 'LARGE' or 'SMALL'. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.

4.3 Ice Production

The ice maker will begin its ice production cycle. The first batch of ice bullets will be ready in approximately 6 minutes. The appliance can produce up to 26 pounds of ice per day.

4.4 Indicators

- **ADD WATER:** This indicator light will illuminate when the water reservoir needs to be refilled.
- **ICE FULL:** This indicator light will illuminate when the ice basket is full. The ice maker will pause production until ice is removed.

4.5 Using the Ice Scoop and Basket

The ice maker comes with a removable ice basket and an ice scoop for convenient serving. When the ice basket is full, carefully remove it and transfer the ice to a cooler or other container.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Self-Cleaning Function

The ice maker is equipped with a one-touch auto-clean function to simplify maintenance.

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled with clean water.
2. Press and hold the 'POWER' button for 3 seconds.
3. The self-clean cycle will run for approximately 5 minutes.
4. After the cycle, drain the water and rinse the interior.

5.2 Regular Cleaning

- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

- **Interior:** Periodically clean the water reservoir and ice basket with a mild detergent and warm water. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Drainage:** Regularly drain any remaining water from the reservoir to prevent mineral buildup.

5.3 Storage

If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is thoroughly cleaned and dried. Store in a cool, dry place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir. Power not connected.	Fill water reservoir. Ensure power cord is securely plugged in.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water level is low.	Add potable water to the reservoir up to the 'MAX' line.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are too small or cloudy.	Water temperature too high. Ambient temperature too high.	Use colder water. Place the ice maker in a cooler environment.
Machine is noisy.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump).	This is normal during operation. Ensure the unit is on a stable surface.
