1. Introduction

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the physical components and layout of your MIRO C69M Pro smartphone.

The MIRO C69M Pro features a 6.9-inch waterdrop display on the front, providing an expansive viewing area. The rear panel houses a multi-camera system with an LED flash. The device is designed with a slim profile and a lightweight feel for comfortable handling.

4.1 Inserting SIM Cards and SD Card

Your MIRO C69M Pro supports dual SIM cards and an expandable storage option. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray. Carefully place your Nano-SIM cards and/or microSD card into the designated slots, ensuring correct orientation. Reinsert the tray firmly into the phone.

4.2 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button (usually on the right side) until the MIRO logo appears on the screen.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power button until the power options menu appears. Select 'Power off' and confirm.
- To Restart: From the power options menu, select 'Restart' and confirm.

4.3 Initial Setup Wizard

The first time you power on your device, you will be guided through an initial setup wizard. Follow the on-screen prompts to:

- · Select your language.
- · Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
- Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password, fingerprint, or face unlock).
- · Review and accept terms and conditions.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Navigation

- Touch: Tap an icon to open an app or select an item.
- Swipe: Drag your finger across the screen to scroll through lists, switch between home screens, or view notifications.
- Pinch: Use two fingers to zoom in or out on photos and web pages.
- Long Press: Press and hold an item for more options or to move it.

5.2 Home Screen

The home screen is your central hub for accessing apps, widgets, and notifications. You can customize it by adding or removing app icons and widgets.

5.3 Notifications and Quick Settings

Swipe down from the top of the screen to access your notifications and quick settings panel. Here you can manage alerts, toggle Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and other features.

6. CAMERA USAGE

Your MIRO C69M Pro is equipped with a powerful 50MP main camera and a 16MP front camera for capturing high-quality photos and videos.

6.1 Taking Photos

- 1. Open the Camera app.
- 2. Select your desired mode (Photo, Portrait, Video, etc.).
- 3. Tap the shutter button to capture an image.
- 4. Use the on-screen controls to switch between the main 50MP rear camera and the 16MP front camera.

6.2 Recording Videos

- 1. In the Camera app, switch to Video mode.
- 2. Tap the record button to start recording.
- 3. Tap the record button again to stop recording.

7. CONNECTIVITY

The MIRO C69M Pro offers various connectivity options to keep you connected.



7.1 Wi-Fi

To connect to a Wi-Fi network:

- 1. Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi.
- 2. Toggle Wi-Fi on.
- 3. Select your desired network from the list and enter the password if required.

7.2 Bluetooth

To pair with a Bluetooth device:

- 1. Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth.
- 2. Toggle Bluetooth on.
- 3. Ensure your Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
- 4. Select the device from the 'Available devices' list and follow the pairing instructions.

7.3 Mobile Data (4G)

Ensure your SIM card is properly inserted and activated. To enable or disable mobile data, go to Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network and toggle 'Mobile data' on or off. The device supports various 4G LTE bands for global roaming.

8. BATTERY MANAGEMENT

Your MIRO C69M Pro is equipped with a 5160mAh battery, providing extended usage. It also supports 20W PD fast charging.

8.1 Charging the Battery

Connect the provided USB cable to the phone's Type-C port and the other end to a compatible 20W PD fast charger (not always included) or a standard USB power adapter. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status. For optimal charging, use the original or certified charging accessories.

8.2 Battery Saving Tips

- · Reduce screen brightness.
- Enable Battery Saver mode in Settings.
- Turn off Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and GPS when not in use.
- Close unused apps running in the background.
- · Limit background data usage for apps.

9. MAINTENANCE

9.1 Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and body of your phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as they can damage the device's finish.

9.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to Settings > System > System update to check for updates.

9.3 Storage Management

Your device comes with 256GB of internal storage. To manage storage, go to Settings > Storage. You can free up space by deleting unnecessary files, uninstalling unused apps, or moving media to a microSD card.

10. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your MIRO C69M Pro.

10.1 Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the phone to a charger for at least 15 minutes before attempting to power on.
- Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.

10.2 Network Connectivity Issues

- Wi-Fi: Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled and you have the correct password. Try restarting your router.
- Mobile Data: Check if mobile data is enabled in settings. Verify your SIM card is properly inserted and your plan is active.
- No Signal: Move to an area with better network coverage.

10.3 Apps Crashing or Freezing

- Close and reopen the app.
- Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache/Clear data).
- Uninstall and reinstall the app.
- Ensure your phone's software is up to date.

10.4 Factory Reset (Last Resort)

If issues persist, a factory reset may resolve them. **Warning:** This will erase all data on your phone. Back up important data before proceeding. Go to Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset).
