1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

This building set contains small parts and is **not suitable for children under 3 years old** due to choking hazards. Recommended for ages **12 years and older**. Please retain this instruction manual for future reference. All materials are non-toxic plastic.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly.

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the detailed step-by-step diagrams in the included instruction booklet. Ensure each piece is firmly connected to prevent loosening.

3.1 General Assembly Tips

- Organize your pieces by color and type before starting.
- Press pieces together firmly until you hear a click or feel a secure connection.
- Refer to the visual instructions for correct orientation of each block.

3.2 Flower Assembly

The set includes 11 stems and components for 9 classic flowers: Roses, Peonies, Tulips, Borage Moss, Gerbera, Carnation, Snapdragon, Chinese Rose, Calendula, Climbing Rose, Ozothamnus Diostmifolius, and Green Rose. Some flowers feature adjustable petals.

Adjustable Flowers (Peony, Carnation, Cerbera)

Certain flowers, such as the peony, carnation, and cerbera, are designed with a twisting mechanism to simulate blooming. Carefully assemble the internal gear system and petals as shown in the instructions. Once assembled, gently twist the base of the flower to open or close the petals to your desired state.

3.3 Vase Assembly

Assemble the vase according to the provided diagrams. The vase forms a stable base for your flower arrangement.

3.4 Arranging Your Bouquet

Once all flowers and the vase are assembled, you can arrange them creatively. The flower bed in the vase has multiple connection points, allowing for personalized floral arrangements. Experiment with different placements to achieve your desired aesthetic.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Adjusting Flower Bloom

For flowers with the twisting mechanism, gently rotate the base of the flower to open or close the petals. Avoid excessive force to prevent damage to the internal components.

4.2 Displaying Your Bouquet

The assembled bouquet is designed for table display, shelves, or fireplaces. Ensure it is placed on a stable, flat surface to prevent accidental falls. The vase is sturdy for display but handle with care when moving.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the bouquet, gently dust with a soft, dry cloth or a soft brush. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these may damage the plastic components or fade colors.

5.2 Storage

If you need to store the bouquet, it can be partially or fully disassembled. Keep all pieces in a secure container to prevent loss. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to maintain color integrity.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Loose Connections

If parts feel loose, gently press them together more firmly. Ensure the connecting studs are properly aligned with the holes.

6.2 Difficulty with Petal Mechanisms

Some users have reported that the internal wheel contraction for opening and closing petals can be challenging to assemble. Ensure all clips are correctly attached to both the inner and outer parts of the wheel. If a piece is missing or damaged, contact customer support.

6.3 Vase Instability

If the vase feels unstable, double-check all connections in the base. Ensure it is placed on a completely flat and level surface. If the assembled flowers make the vase top-heavy, try redistributing the weight or ensuring the flower stems are fully inserted.
