Inaccurate positioning	Loose mechanical connection; Encoder issue; Controller tuning required	Tighten connections; Check encoder feedback; Perform controller auto-tuning
Unusual noise or vibration	Misalignment; Worn bearings; Loose components; Overload	Check alignment; Inspect bearings; Tighten fasteners; Reduce load or check sizing
