1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Empava 24-Inch Built-in Dishwasher, Model BDW50. This manual provides essential information for the safe installation, operation, and maintenance of your new appliance. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the dishwasher and retain them for future reference.

The Empava BDW50 dishwasher is designed for residential use, offering efficient cleaning with 15 place settings, 8 wash cycles, and an ultra-quiet 49 dB operation. Its stainless steel tub and auto door dry feature ensure optimal performance and convenience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your dishwasher, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- This appliance must be grounded. Connect only to a properly grounded outlet.
- Do not operate the dishwasher if it is damaged, malfunctioning, or has missing or broken parts.
- Keep children away from the dishwasher, especially when the door is open.
- Use only detergents and rinse agents recommended for automatic dishwashers.
- Load sharp items so they are not likely to damage the door seal or tub.
- Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after use.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or performing maintenance.

3. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and efficient operation of your dishwasher. It is recommended that installation be performed by a qualified technician.

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the dishwasher for any shipping damage. Report any damage to your dealer immediately.

3.2 Dimensions and Cut-Out Requirements

Ensure your cabinet opening meets the required dimensions for a proper fit.

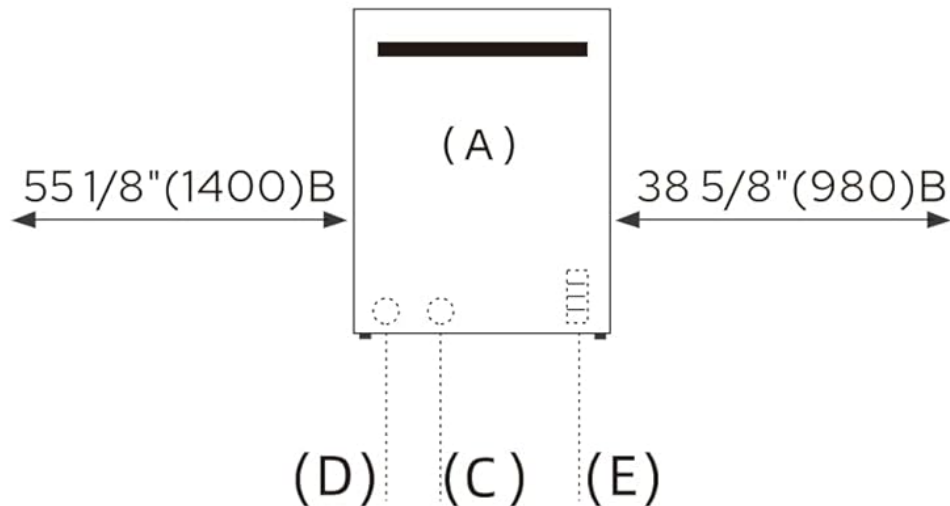

3.3 Connections

All connections (drain, inlet, electrical) are located at the rear of the appliance. Ensure proper access and secure connections.

E: Electrical

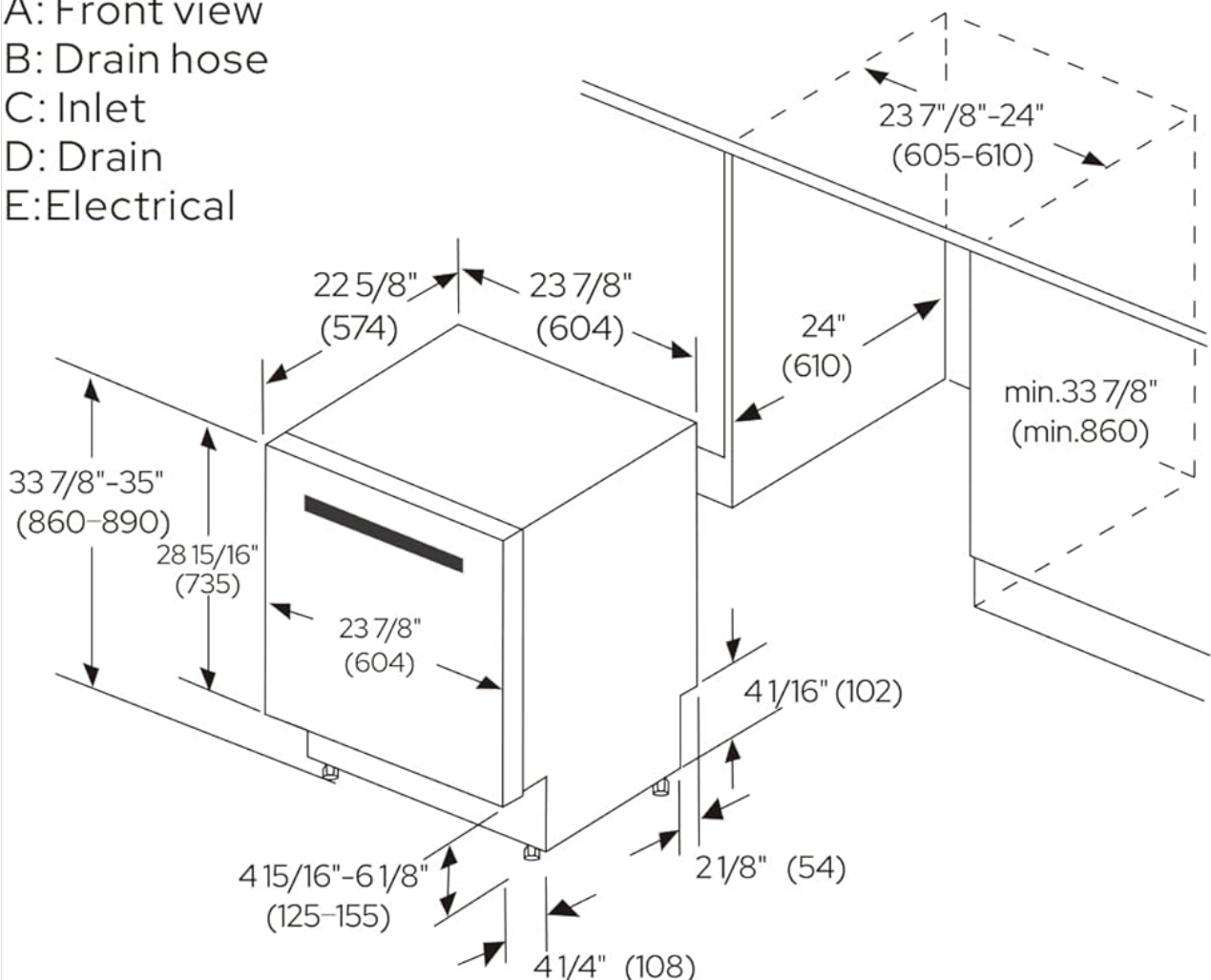


Figure 3.3.1: Rear view of the dishwasher showing connection points for drain hose (B), inlet (C), and electrical (E). A junction box for hardwired connection is available as an accessory.

3.3.1 Electrical Connection

The dishwasher requires a 120V, 60Hz, dedicated electrical supply. Ensure the circuit is properly grounded.

3.3.2 Water Supply Connection

Connect the dishwasher to a hot water supply line with a minimum temperature of 120°F (49°C) and a maximum of 149°F (65°C).

3.3.3 Drain Connection

Connect the drain hose to the household drain system. Ensure the drain hose is properly secured to prevent leaks.

3.4 Included Components for Installation

The following components are included to assist with installation:

- Drain Hose, Hose Clamp
- Mounting Brackets, Screws
- Door Correction Cover
- Steam Proof Film

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the control panel and basic operation before first use.

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The dishwasher features a hidden top control panel for a sleek, integrated look.

4.2 Basic Operation Steps

1. **Load the Dishwasher:** Refer to Section 5 for proper loading techniques.
2. **Add Detergent and Rinse Aid:** Fill the detergent dispenser and rinse aid dispenser.
3. **Select a Wash Cycle:** Press the desired cycle button (e.g., Auto, Heavy, Normal).
4. **Select Options (Optional):** Choose additional options like Half Load or High Temp.
5. **Start the Cycle:** Close the dishwasher door firmly. The cycle will begin.
6. **Auto Door Dry:** At the end of the cycle, the door will automatically open to facilitate drying.

5. LOADING THE DISHWASHER

Proper loading ensures optimal cleaning performance and prevents damage to dishes. The Empava BDW50 offers 15 place settings and three racks for flexible loading.

5.1 Third Rack (Utensils)

The third rack is ideal for cutlery, small utensils, and espresso cups.

5.2 Upper Rack

The upper rack is suitable for glasses, cups, small bowls, and plates. Ensure items do not block the spray arms.

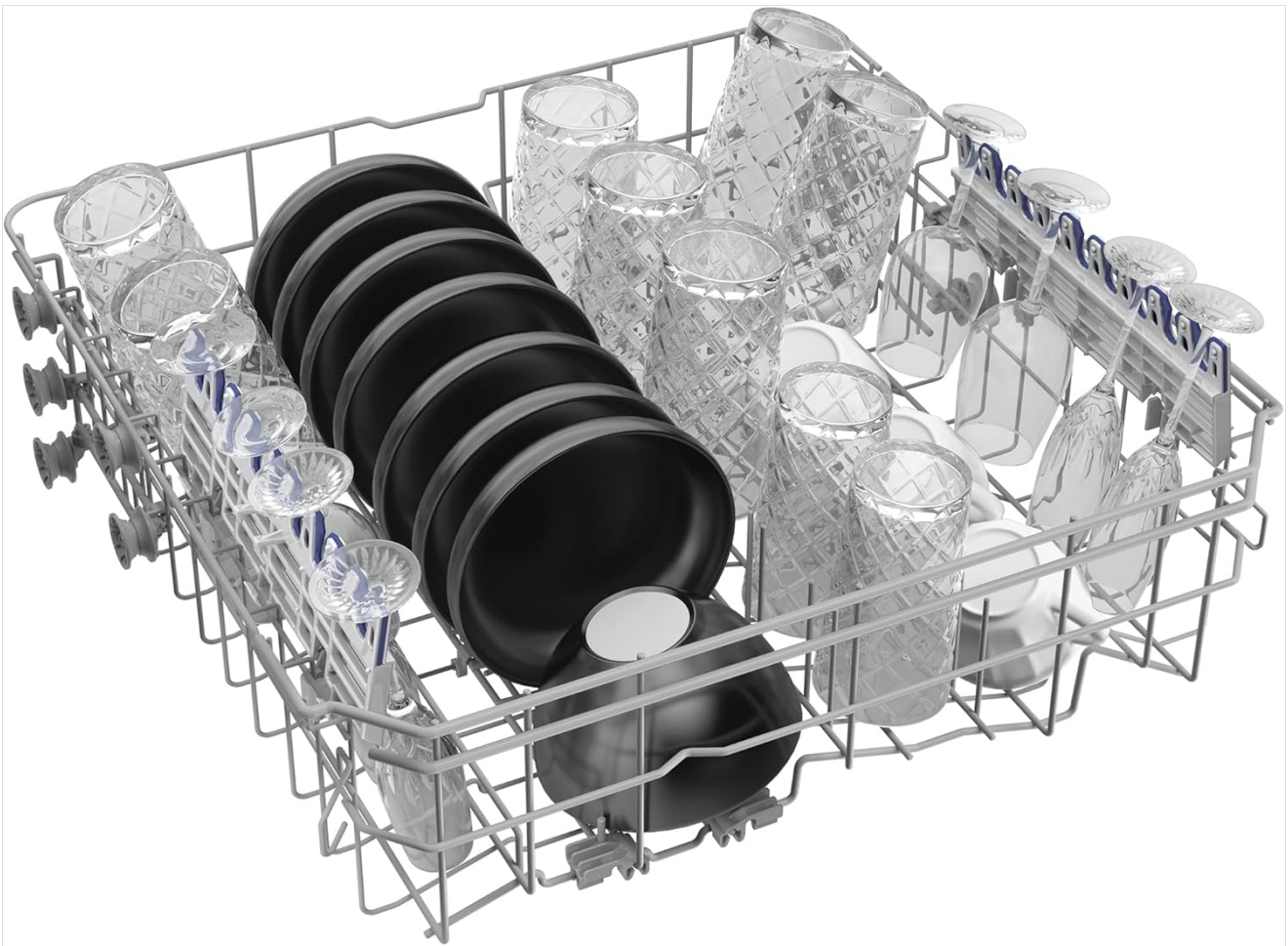


Figure 5.2.1: The upper rack, shown loaded with various glassware and smaller plates, demonstrating efficient space utilization.

5.3 Lower Rack

The lower rack is designed for larger items such as dinner plates, serving dishes, pots, and pans.

6. WASH CYCLES AND OPTIONS

The Empava BDW50 offers 8 wash cycles and 6 custom options to accommodate various dishwashing needs.

6.1 Available Wash Cycles

- **Auto:** Automatically detects soil level and adjusts wash time and temperature.
- **Heavy:** For heavily soiled dishes, pots, and pans.
- **ECO:** Energy-efficient cycle for normally soiled dishes.
- **Normal:** Standard cycle for everyday dishes.
- **Delicate:** Gentle wash for fragile items.
- **Lightning:** Quick wash for lightly soiled dishes.
- **Glass:** Specialized cycle for glassware.
- **Rinse:** For rinsing dishes that will be washed later.

6.2 Custom Options

- **Delay:** Postpones the start of the wash cycle.

- **Sanitize:** Uses high temperature to sanitize dishes.
- **High Temp:** Increases wash temperature for improved cleaning.
- **Half Load:** Reduces water and energy consumption for smaller loads.
- **Child Lock:** Locks the control panel to prevent accidental operation.
- **Auto Program:** Automatically selects the best wash program.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your dishwasher.

7.1 Cleaning the Exterior

Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stainless steel, use a specialized stainless steel cleaner to prevent streaks and fingerprints.

7.2 Cleaning the Interior

Periodically clean the interior of the dishwasher. You can run an empty cycle with a dishwasher cleaner or a cup of white vinegar placed in the bottom rack.

7.3 Filter Maintenance

The dishwasher features a removable filter system. Regularly check and clean the filter to prevent food particles from recirculating and affecting wash performance. Refer to the detailed instructions in the full user manual for filter removal and cleaning.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, review the following common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Power supply issue, door not closed properly, cycle not selected.	Check power connection, ensure door is latched, select a wash cycle.
Dishes are not clean	Improper loading, clogged filter, insufficient detergent, blocked spray arms.	Reload dishes correctly, clean filter, use recommended detergent, ensure spray arms rotate freely.
Water not draining	Clogged drain hose or filter, air gap issue.	Check and clear drain hose/filter, inspect air gap if applicable.
Dishwasher is noisy	Improper loading, foreign object in pump, installation issue.	Ensure dishes are not rattling, check for foreign objects, verify proper installation.
