## **Generic Splash Guard Instruction Manual**

For Electric Garbage Disposals: GFC320F-01, GFC520F-01, GFC535T, GFC530H-01, and Compatible Models

### **1. INTRODUCTION**

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This manual provides essential information for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new Generic Splash Guard. This component is designed to fit various electric garbage disposal models, preventing food and water splash-back during operation and reducing operational noise. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and retain them for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

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### **WARNING: Risk of Electric Shock and Injury.**

- Always disconnect power to the garbage disposal unit at the circuit breaker before attempting any installation, maintenance, or troubleshooting.
- Never place hands or foreign objects into the disposal opening.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves, during installation.
- If you are unsure about any step, consult a qualified electrician or plumber.

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

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This section outlines the steps for replacing an existing splash guard. Ensure the power to the disposal is OFF before proceeding.

### **Tools Required:**

- Gloves

- Flashlight (optional)

### Installation Steps:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Locate the circuit breaker for your kitchen and turn off the power to the garbage disposal. Verify the power is off by attempting to turn on the disposal switch.
2. **Remove Old Splash Guard:** Reach into the disposal opening. The old splash guard is typically held in place by friction or a small lip. Gently pull it out from the drain opening. It may require some force.
3. **Clean Drain Opening:** Inspect the drain opening for any food debris or residue. Clean the area thoroughly to ensure a proper fit for the new splash guard.
4. **Install New Splash Guard:** Align the new Generic Splash Guard with the drain opening. The ribbed side or wider edge usually faces downwards into the disposal. Press the splash guard firmly into the opening until it sits securely. Ensure it is flush with the sink flange.

5. **Restore Power:** Turn the power back on at the circuit breaker.
6. **Test:** Run water into the sink and briefly turn on the disposal to ensure the splash guard remains in place and functions correctly.

## 4. OPERATING

The splash guard operates passively. When the garbage disposal is turned on, the flexible flaps allow food waste and water to enter the grinding chamber while containing splashes and reducing noise. No specific user action is required for its operation beyond ensuring it is correctly installed.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning of the splash guard is recommended to prevent food buildup and odors.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After using the disposal, run water for a few seconds to flush any small food particles from the splash guard.
- **Periodic Deep Cleaning:** Approximately once a month, or as needed, remove the splash guard (following steps 1 and 2 from the Installation section). Clean it thoroughly with warm, soapy water and a brush. Rinse well and reinstall.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the splash guard for signs of wear, tears, or hardening. A damaged splash guard may not effectively prevent splashes or reduce noise and should be replaced.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food or water splashing out of the drain.	Splash guard is worn, torn, or improperly seated.	Inspect the splash guard for damage. Re-seat it firmly or replace if damaged.
Water draining slowly.	Food debris buildup on or under the splash guard.	Remove and clean the splash guard thoroughly. Clear any obstructions in the drain opening.
Increased noise from disposal.	Splash guard is missing or damaged.	Ensure the splash guard is properly installed. Replace if damaged.
Splash guard falls out.	Improper installation or worn-out material.	Reinstall the splash guard, ensuring it is pressed firmly into place. If it continues to fall out, it may be worn and require replacement.


