## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your HTNZIR 19-inch HD Flat Screen Widescreen TV. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper and safe operation.

The HTNZIR 19-inch HD LED TV is designed for versatile use in various environments such as kitchens, bedrooms, RVs, and campers. It features a 1440x900 HD resolution display, a built-in ATSC tuner for over-the-air digital channels, and multiple connectivity options.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove the TV and all accessories from the packaging.
2. Place the TV on a stable, flat surface using the built-in stand. Ensure adequate ventilation around the TV.
3. For optimal signal reception when using the ATSC tuner, consider placing the TV near a window or in an elevated position facing local broadcast towers.

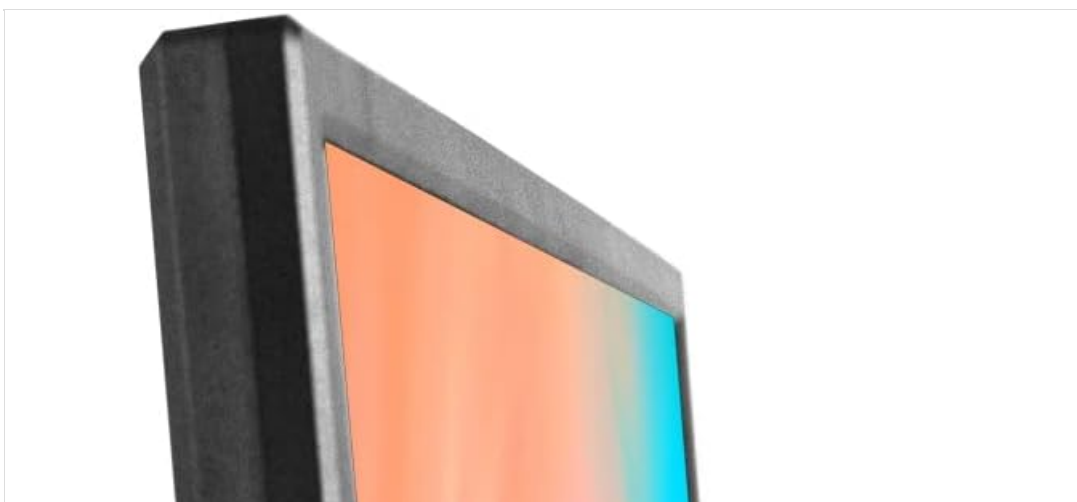




Image: Side profile of the HTNZIR 19-inch HD TV, illustrating its slim design and the integrated stand.

## 2. Connecting Power

1. Connect the power adapter to the DC Power input port on the back of the TV.
2. Plug the other end of the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
3. For RV or car use, the TV supports 12V DC input. Ensure the correct 12V DC power source is used.

### 3. Connecting External Devices

The TV offers various input ports for connecting external devices:

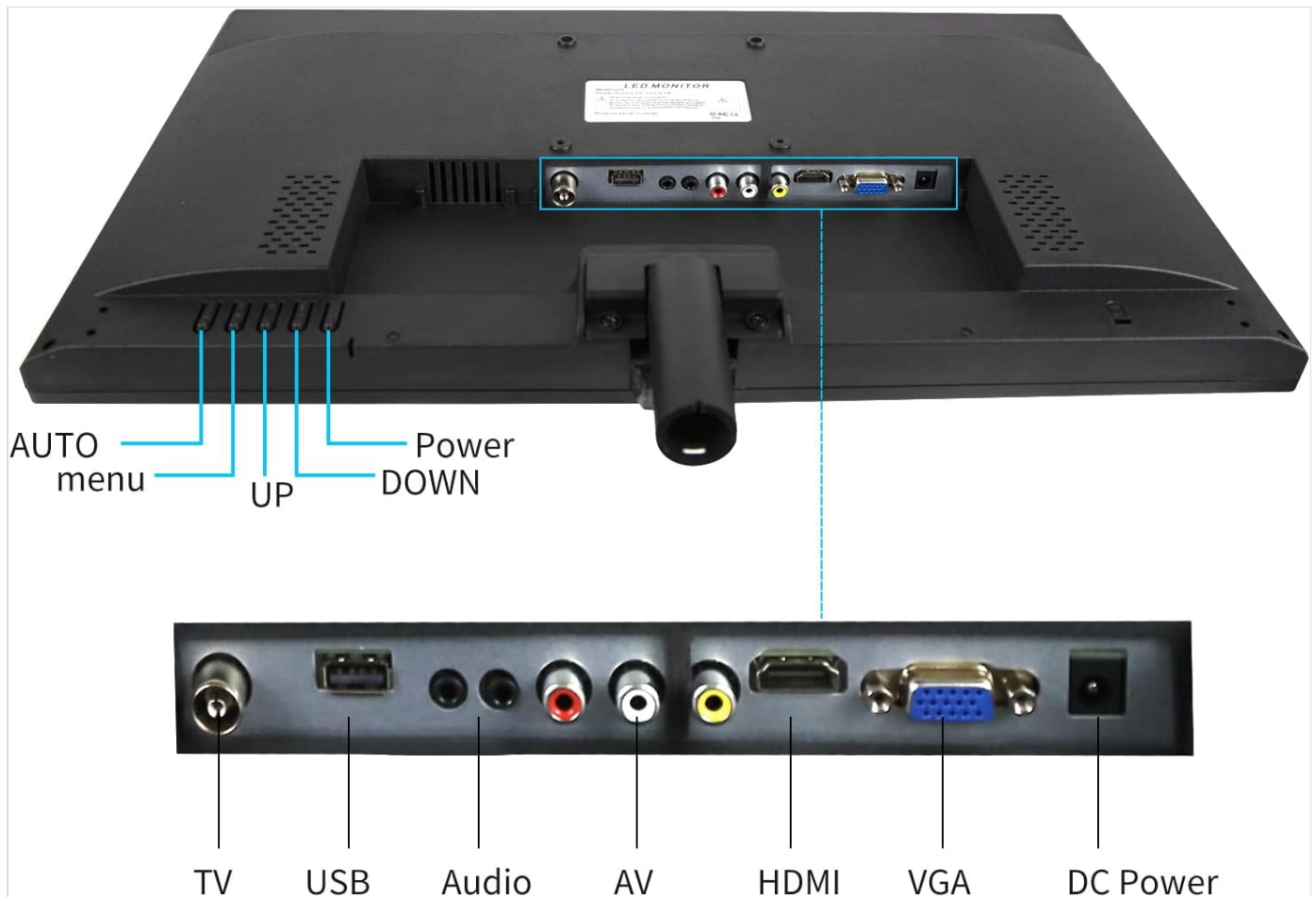

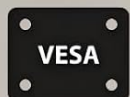
- **HDMI Port:** Connect streaming devices, gaming consoles, or Blu-ray players for high-definition audio and video.
- **USB Port:** Insert a USB flash drive to play compatible media files (photos, music, videos).
- **VGA Input:** Connect a computer or laptop to use the TV as a monitor.
- **AV Input:** Connect older devices such as DVD players or VCRs using composite video and stereo audio cables.
- **TV (Antenna) Input:** Connect an external antenna for receiving free over-the-air digital broadcasts via the built-in ATSC tuner.

*Note: This is a non-smart TV and does not support direct connection to cable/satellite services like Xfinity, DirecTV, or Comcast without an external set-top box.*

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Power On/Off

- Press the **Power** button on the remote control or on the TV's side panel to turn the TV on or off.

## 2. Initial Channel Scan (ATSC Tuner)

After connecting an antenna, you need to scan for available channels:

1. Press the **Menu** button on the remote control.
2. Navigate to the **Channel** or **Setup** menu.
3. Select **Auto Scan** or **Channel Search**.
4. The TV will scan for available over-the-air digital channels (ABC, CBS, NBC, FOX, PBS, etc.). This process may take several minutes.
5. Once complete, you can use the **Channel Up/Down** buttons to browse channels.

*Important: Channel availability depends on your location and signal strength. An external antenna is recommended for improved reception.*

## 3. Input Source Selection

To switch between connected devices (HDMI, USB, AV, VGA, TV):

- Press the **Source** or **Input** button on the remote control.
- Use the arrow buttons to select the desired input source.
- Press **OK** or **Enter** to confirm your selection.

#### 4. Media Playback via USB

To play media files from a USB flash drive:

1. Insert your USB flash drive into the USB port on the back of the TV.
2. Select **USB** as the input source.
3. Navigate through the folders and files using the remote control.
4. Select the desired file (photo, music, or video) and press **OK** to play.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your TV.

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution specifically designed for electronics. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- **Cleaning the Cabinet:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV cabinet. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the ventilation openings on the back of the TV are not blocked. Do not place the TV in an enclosed space without adequate airflow.
- **Power Cord:** Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support for a replacement.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No power / TV does not turn on.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the TV and a working electrical outlet.</li><li>• Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.</li><li>• Verify the power button on the remote or TV is pressed.</li></ul>
No picture / Black screen.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Confirm the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, AV, TV).</li><li>• Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, VGA) are secure.</li><li>• If using an antenna, perform a channel scan.</li></ul>

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No sound / Poor audio quality.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increase the volume using the remote control.</li> <li>• Check if the TV is muted.</li> <li>• Ensure audio cables are properly connected for AV or external audio systems.</li> <li>• If using HDMI, verify the source device's audio output settings.</li> </ul>
Remote control not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replace the batteries in the remote control.</li> <li>• Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's infrared sensor.</li> <li>• Point the remote directly at the TV.</li> </ul>
Cannot find channels with antenna.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure the antenna is properly connected to the TV's "TV" input.</li> <li>• Perform a channel scan (refer to "Initial Channel Scan" section).</li> <li>• Adjust the antenna's position or orientation. Consider using a stronger external antenna if signal is weak.</li> <li>• Check local broadcast availability in your area.</li> </ul>

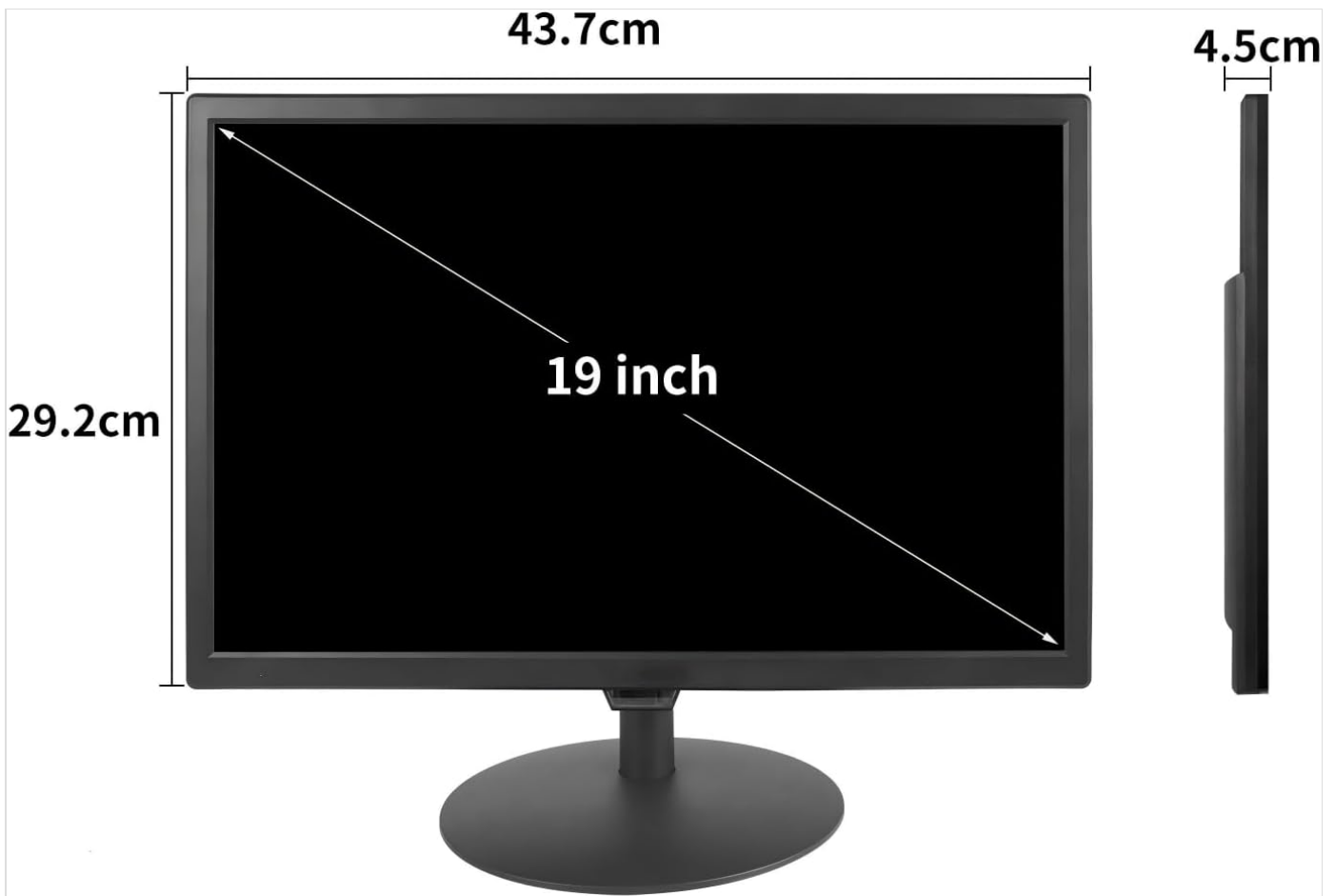
