1. Introduction

The Moman H4C is a motorcycle helmet headset designed to enhance your riding experience with integrated communication and recording capabilities. It features a 1080P HD camera, Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity, Hi-Fi stereo sound, and IPX6 waterproofing. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and safety.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always prioritize road safety. Do not operate the device in a manner that distracts you from riding.
- Ensure the device is securely mounted to your helmet before riding.
- Adjust volume levels to allow awareness of surrounding traffic sounds.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the device. This may void the warranty and pose safety risks.
- Keep the device away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- Charge the device using only the provided cable and a compatible power source.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

• Moman H4C Headset Unit

- · Helmet Mounting Bracket
- · Speakers (pre-attached to wiring)
- Microphone (boom or soft wire, depending on helmet type)
- USB Charging Cable
- 32GB TF Card (pre-installed or separate)
- User Manual
- · Adhesive Pads and Velcro for installation

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the Moman H4C.

- 1. Locate the charging interface on the headset (refer to Image 4.1).
- 2. Connect the USB charging cable to the headset and a compatible USB power adapter.
- 3. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. A full charge typically takes about 3 hours.

4.2 Installing the TF Card

The H4C supports TF cards up to 256GB. A 32GB card is included.

- 1. Locate the TF card slot on the headset (refer to Image 4.1).
- 2. Gently insert the TF card into the slot until it clicks into place. Ensure correct orientation.

4.3 Mounting to Helmet

Choose a suitable location on the left side of your helmet for optimal access to controls.

- 1. **Attach Mounting Bracket:** Use the adhesive pad or clamp mount to securely attach the bracket to the helmet shell. Ensure the surface is clean and dry before applying adhesive.
- 2. **Install Speakers:** Position the speakers inside the helmet's ear pockets. Use the provided Velcro pads to secure them. Ensure they are aligned with your ears for clear audio.
- 3. **Install Microphone:** For full-face helmets, use the soft wire microphone and tuck it along the helmet lining towards your mouth. For open-face or modular helmets, use the boom microphone and position it close to your mouth.
- 4. Connect Headset Unit: Slide the Moman H4C unit onto the mounting bracket until it locks securely. Connect the



4.4 App Installation (RoadCam)

Download the "RoadCam" application to your smartphone for video viewing and management.

- Search for "RoadCam" on the Google Play Store (Android) or Apple App Store (iOS).
- Install the application on your smartphone.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the On/Off key (refer to Image 4.1) for approximately 3 seconds until the indicator light illuminates and you hear a power-on prompt.
- Power Off: Press and hold the On/Off key for approximately 3 seconds until the indicator light turns off and you hear a power-off prompt.

5.2 Bluetooth Pairing

The H4C uses Bluetooth 5.3 for stable connection to your smartphone.

- 1. Ensure the H4C is powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the On/Off key for approximately 5-7 seconds until the indicator light flashes red and blue alternately,

indicating pairing mode.

- 3. On your smartphone, go to Bluetooth settings and search for "Moman H4C".
- 4. Select "Moman H4C" to connect. Once paired, the indicator light will turn blue and flash slowly.

5.3 Connecting Two Smartphones

The H4C can connect to two smartphones simultaneously.

- 1. Pair the first smartphone as described in Section 5.2.
- 2. After the first phone is connected, put the H4C back into pairing mode (usually by pressing the On/Off button again for a few seconds until it flashes red/blue).
- 3. Pair the second smartphone.
- 4. Both phones should now be connected, allowing for simultaneous navigation, calls, and music (though only one audio source can be active at a time).

5.4 Music Playback

- Play/Pause: Short press the On/Off/Play/Pause key.
- Volume Up: Short press the Volume Up/Next Song key.
- Volume Down: Short press the Volume Down/Previous key.
- Next Song: Long press the Volume Up/Next Song key.
- **Previous Song:** Long press the Volume Down/Previous key.

5.5 Call Management & Al Voice Assistant

- **Answer Call:** Short press the On/Off/Answer key when an incoming call is received. The device supports automatic answering.
- End Call: Short press the On/Off/Answer key during a call.
- Reject Call: Long press the On/Off/Answer key when an incoming call is received.
- Activate Al Voice Assistant: Press the dedicated Al Voice Assistant button (refer to Image 4.1) to activate your smartphone's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).



5.6 Camera Operation

The integrated 1080P HD camera records your rides with a 120° wide-angle lens and 360° rotation.

- Start/Stop Recording: Press the Recorder Key (refer to Image 4.1) to start or stop video recording.
- Activate WiFi: Press the Camera/WiFi Key to activate the device's WiFi hotspot. This allows connection to the "RoadCam" app.
- **App Control:** Connect your smartphone to the H4C's WiFi hotspot. Open the "RoadCam" app to view live footage, download recorded videos and photos, and adjust camera settings.
- Loop Recording: The camera automatically overwrites the oldest unprotected files when the TF card is full, ensuring continuous recording.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Water Resistance: The H4C is IPX6 waterproof, meaning it is protected against powerful water jets. It is suitable for use in rain but should not be submerged in water. Ensure all ports are securely closed.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. If storing for extended periods, charge the device to about 50% and recharge every few months.
- Storage: Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low battery; device frozen.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes. If still unresponsive, try holding the On/Off button for 10-15 seconds to force a reset.
Cannot pair with smartphone.	Device not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on phone; interference.	Ensure the H4C is in pairing mode (flashing red/blue). Turn off and on your phone's Bluetooth. Move away from other Bluetooth devices.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low audio volume during calls.	Phone volume low; headset volume low; speaker placement.	Increase volume on both the H4C and your smartphone. Ensure speakers are correctly positioned directly over your ears inside the helmet.
Video recording issues (e.g., not recording, poor quality).	TF card full or corrupted; camera lens obstructed; low battery.	Check TF card status via the app or by removing it. Format the TF card if necessary (this will erase all data). Clean the camera lens. Ensure the device is sufficiently charged.
WiFi connection issues with "RoadCam" app.	WiFi not activated on H4C; incorrect password; app issues.	Ensure H4C WiFi is activated. Re-enter WiFi password. Restart the "RoadCam" app and your phone's WiFi.
Camera lens angle is not horizontal after mounting.	Mounting position; fixed lens design.	The H4C camera lens has a fixed orientation relative to the main unit. Ensure the main unit is mounted horizontally on the helmet. The camera body itself can rotate 360 degrees for angle adjustment, but the lens within the body is fixed. Adjust the entire unit's rotation on its mount to achieve the desired horizontal view.




