## 1. INTRODUCTION

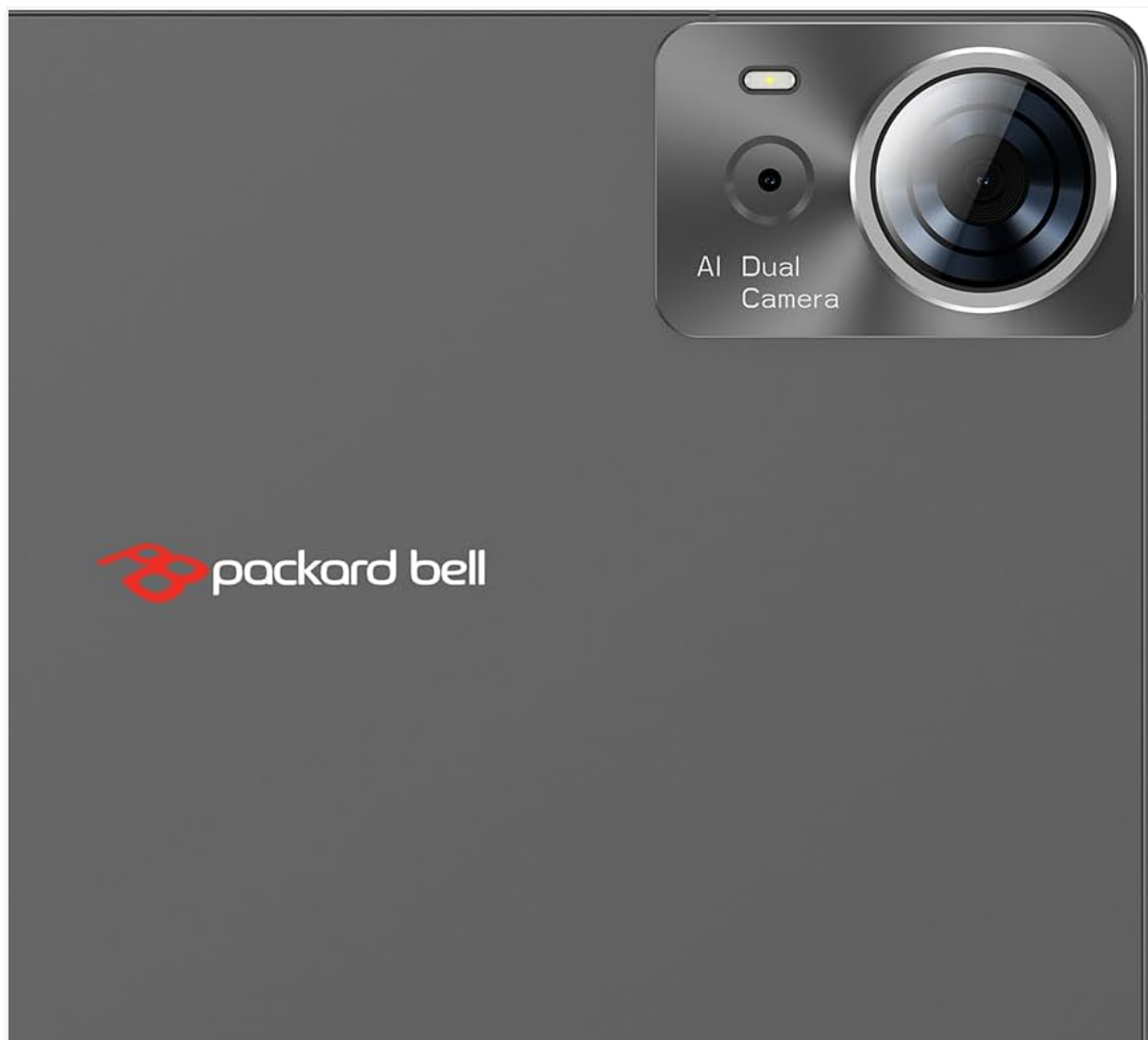


**Figure 3.4:** Top and bottom views of the tablet, showing speaker grilles and additional ports.

### 3.1. Buttons and Ports Overview

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off or restart. Press briefly to turn the screen on/off.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust the device's volume.
- **USB Type-C Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** Connect headphones or external speakers.
- **SIM/MicroSD Card Slot:** Insert your SIM card for cellular connectivity and a MicroSD card for expanded storage.
- **Front Camera:** For video calls and selfies (5MP).
- **Rear Camera:** For high-quality photos and videos (13MP).

## 4. SETUP

---

### 4.1. Charging the Tablet

Before first use, fully charge your tablet. Connect the USB Type-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the power adapter to a wall outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

### 4.2. Inserting SIM and MicroSD Cards

1. Locate the SIM/MicroSD card slot on the side of the tablet.

2. Use the provided ejector tool (if applicable) to open the tray.
3. Carefully place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or MicroSD card into the tray, ensuring correct orientation.
4. Gently push the tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.

### 4.3. Powering On and Initial Setup

1. Press and hold the Power button until the Packard Bell logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, set up your Google account, and configure other initial settings.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1. Basic Navigation

- **Tap:** Select an item or activate a function.
- **Tap and Hold:** Access contextual menus or move icons.
- **Swipe:** Navigate through screens, lists, or content.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.

### 5.2. Connecting to Networks

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi. Turn Wi-Fi on and select your desired network. Enter the password if prompted.
- **Cellular Data (LTE):** Ensure a valid SIM card is inserted. Go to Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network. Enable Mobile data.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth. Turn Bluetooth on and pair with desired devices.

### 5.3. Using the Cameras

Open the Camera app from the home screen or app drawer. You can switch between the front (5MP) and rear (13MP) cameras, select different modes (photo, video), and adjust settings.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

### 6.1. Cleaning the Tablet

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, which can damage the surface. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water.

### 6.2. Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures.
- Use only the original charger or a certified compatible charger.
- Do not leave the tablet fully discharged for extended periods.

### 6.3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to Settings > System > System update.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Tablet does not power on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and try again. If it still doesn't power on, perform a forced restart by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
- **Wi-Fi connection issues:** Check if Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router and the tablet. Forget the network in settings and reconnect.
- **Slow performance:** Close unused apps. Clear cache data. Check for available storage space. Restart the tablet.
- **Apps crashing:** Ensure apps are updated to their latest versions. Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage). Reinstall the app if necessary.
- **Touchscreen unresponsive:** Restart the tablet. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
