# Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference.

The Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router is designed to provide portable internet access, supporting 4G and 3G networks. It features an integrated 8000mAh lithium-ion battery, allowing for extended use and the ability to charge other devices. The device supports connection for up to 10 devices simultaneously and offers secure internet access with WPA/WPA2 encryption.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router is a compact and versatile device. It features an LED display for status indication, a micro SIM card slot, and USB ports for charging and data transfer. Its design emphasizes both functionality and security.




**Figure 3.4:** The router depicted with a security shield, emphasizing its secure internet access features like WPA/WPA2 encryption.

### 4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router:

- 1. Insert Micro SIM Card:** Locate the micro SIM card slot on the device. Carefully insert your activated micro SIM card into the slot until it clicks into place. Ensure the card is inserted in the correct orientation as indicated on the device.

2. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button (usually located near the SIM slot) for a few seconds until the device powers on and the LED indicators light up.
3. **Initial Configuration (Optional):** For advanced settings or to change the default WiFi name (SSID) and password, connect to the device's WiFi network using a computer or smartphone. Open a web browser and navigate to the router's administration page (usually 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Refer to the device's label for default login credentials.

**Note:** This device is a European version and supports networks in Europe, Africa, Southeast Asia, the Middle East, and Central Asia (FDD B1 3 5 7 8 20, TDD B38 40 41, WCDMA B1 5 8).

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Connecting to the WiFi Network

1. Ensure the hotspot is powered on.
2. On your device (smartphone, laptop, tablet), search for available WiFi networks.

3. Select the network name (SSID) corresponding to your Jectse Hotspot. The default SSID and password are typically found on a sticker inside the battery compartment or on the device itself.
4. Enter the WiFi password when prompted.
5. Once connected, you can access the internet. The hotspot supports up to 10 connected devices simultaneously.

## 5.2. Using as a Power Bank

With its 8000mAh battery, the Jectse Hotspot can also function as a power bank to charge other devices.

1. Connect your smartphone or other USB-powered device to the "5V OUT" USB port on the hotspot using a compatible USB cable.

2. The hotspot will begin charging your device.

### 5.3. Direct USB Connection (Tethering)

You can connect the hotspot directly to a computer via USB for internet access, functioning as a USB modem.

1. Connect the hotspot to your computer using the provided USB cable.
2. The computer should automatically detect the device and install necessary drivers.
3. Once recognized, the computer will use the hotspot's internet connection.




Figure 5.3: The router connected to a desktop computer, illustrating its direct USB connection capability for internet access.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to about 50% before storage.
- Avoid Impacts:** Protect the device from drops and impacts, which can damage internal components.
- Ventilation:** Ensure the device has adequate ventilation during operation to prevent overheating.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Jectse 4G LTE Mobile WiFi Hotspot Router, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No Internet Connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure the SIM card is correctly inserted and activated.</li> <li>Check if you have an active data plan with your mobile carrier.</li> <li>Verify network coverage in your current location.</li> <li>Restart the hotspot and your connected device.</li> </ul>
Slow Internet Speed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Check network signal strength on the hotspot's display.</li> <li>Reduce the number of connected devices.</li> <li>Move to an area with better network coverage.</li> <li>Ensure no background applications are consuming excessive bandwidth.</li> </ul>
Cannot Connect to WiFi	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Verify the WiFi password.</li> <li>Ensure the hotspot's WiFi is enabled.</li> <li>Restart both the hotspot and the device attempting to connect.</li> <li>Check if the maximum number of connected devices (10) has been reached.</li> </ul>
Device Not Charging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to the "5V OUT" USB port and your device.</li> <li>Check if the hotspot has sufficient battery charge.</li> <li>Try a different USB cable or charging device.</li> </ul>
