1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Aeitto Nugget Ice Maker. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new ice maker. Please read it thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Refrigerant Settling:** Before plugging in your ice maker, it must stand upright for at least 6 hours to allow the refrigerant fluid to settle.
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** When using, please avoid direct sunlight to ensure optimal performance and longevity.
- **Do Not Invert:** Do not invert the ice maker, as it may cause compressor or refrigeration system failures.
- **Drainage Pipe:** Before use, ensure the drainage pipe is securely connected to prevent leaks that could cause damage.
- **Hand Safety:** Always mind your hands when operating the ice maker, especially near moving parts or the ice dispensing area.
- **Water Quality:** Use clean, potable water for ice production.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- Ice Maker (1 unit)

4. SETUP GUIDE

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

3. **Refrigerant Settling:** Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 6 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle, preventing potential damage.
4. **Install Drip Tray:** Position the drip tray at the front base of the ice maker.
5. **Connect Drainage Pipe:** Ensure the drainage pipe at the back of the unit is securely connected to prevent leaks.
6. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, activate the self-cleaning mode 1-2 times to thoroughly clean the interior. Refer to the "Operating Instructions" for details on the self-cleaning function.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Making Ice

1. **Add Water:** Open the lid and pour clean, potable water into the water tank. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.
2. **Power On:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
3. **Start Ice Production:** Press the "ICE" button on the control panel. The indicator light will illuminate, and the ice-making process will begin.
4. **First Batch:** The first batch of nugget ice typically takes about 5 minutes. Subsequent batches may be faster.
5. **Ice Full Indicator:** The "ICE FULL" indicator light will turn on when the ice basket is full, and the machine will pause ice production.
6. **Add Water Indicator:** The "ADD WATER" indicator light will turn on when the water level is low, and the machine will pause. Add more water to resume.
7. **Collecting Ice:** Use the provided ice scoop to retrieve ice from the basket. If there are ice cubes in the basket, it is recommended to tilt the ice basket at a corner for a few seconds so that the remaining water can flow to the water tank and avoid water spilling on the table.

5.2 Self-Cleaning Function

The ice maker features an automatic self-cleaning function to maintain hygiene:

1. **Empty Water:** Ensure the ice basket is empty and the water tank is filled with clean water.
2. **Activate Cleaning:** Press the "CLEAN" button on the control panel. The machine will initiate a cleaning cycle, typically lasting about 15 minutes.
3. **Drain Water:** After the cleaning cycle is complete, drain the water from the unit using the drainage pipe.

4. **Repeat (Optional):** For thorough cleaning, you may repeat the cycle 1-2 times.

5.3 Light Function

Press the "LIGHT" button to illuminate the interior of the ice maker, which can be useful in low-light conditions or for checking ice levels.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Regular Cleaning:** To keep ice tasting fresh and the ice maker looking great, it is recommended to perform a cleaning and sanitizing cycle at least once per week, depending on water hardness.
- **Descaling:** Descale the unit once a month, or more often if you live in a hard water area. Refer to the descaling instructions in the full manual (if available) or use a suitable descaling solution for ice makers.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Drainage:** Ensure the drainage hose is clear and free of obstructions for smooth water discharge.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; power not connected; "ICE FULL" sensor activated.	Add water; ensure power cord is securely plugged in; empty ice basket.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water level is low.	Refill the water reservoir with potable water.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice is watery or melts quickly.	Ambient temperature too high; first few minutes of operation.	Ensure unit is in a cool environment; this is normal during initial operation and will improve.
Unusual noise during operation.	Ice may be caught in internal mechanisms; unit not level.	Unplug, check for obstructions, and restart; ensure unit is on a level surface.
