MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will help preserve the appearance and structural integrity of your floor bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth before first use and periodically thereafter to remove dust and debris. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the wood finish.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check all screws, bolts, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as needed to maintain stability.
- **Damage Control:** Inspect the wood for any signs of splitting or splinters. Sand smooth any rough areas and apply a child-safe finish if necessary to prevent injury.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources, which can cause wood to dry out, crack, or warp. Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Bellemave Twin Floor Bed, consider the following common solutions:

- **Parts Do Not Align:** If parts do not align during assembly, double-check that you are using the correct pieces as indicated in the assembly manual. Loosen all connections slightly, adjust the parts into place, and then re-tighten.
- **Loose Connections/Wobbling:** Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened. If wobbling persists,

disassemble and reassemble the affected section, paying close attention to the alignment of each piece.

- **Wood Splitting/Splinters:** This can occur due to manufacturing variations or environmental factors. Carefully sand down any rough or splintered areas with fine-grit sandpaper. For larger splits, contact customer support.
- **Gaps Between Mattress and Frame:** Verify that you are using a standard twin-size mattress. If gaps are present, ensure the bed frame is assembled squarely and all components are correctly aligned. Small gaps may be unavoidable with certain mattress dimensions.
- **Flimsy Sections:** If any part of the bed feels flimsy, re-examine the assembly of that specific section. Ensure all hardware is installed and tightened correctly. If the issue persists, it may indicate a manufacturing defect, and customer support should be contacted.
