ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps for initial assembly:

2. Charge the toy for 8-12 hours before first use.
3. Place the toy on a flat, stable surface.
4. Help your child onto the toy and ensure they are securely seated with the seat belt.
5. Use the parental remote control to guide the toy safely, with an effective range of up to 30m.
6. Always supervise your child while they are using the toy.

CHARGING THE BATTERY

The vehicle is powered by a 24V battery. Before first use, charge the battery for 8-12 hours. Subsequent charges typically take 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge the battery. Always use the provided charger.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and safe operation of your ride-on toy, perform the following maintenance:

- Regularly inspect the vehicle for loose parts, damaged wiring, or worn tires.
- Clean the vehicle with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Store the vehicle in a dry, covered area when not in use to protect it from weather elements.
- Ensure the battery is fully charged before storing for extended periods and recharge every 3 months to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Low battery charge; loose battery connection; motor issue.	Charge battery; check battery terminals; contact customer support.
Remote control not working	Remote battery low; remote not paired; interference.	Replace remote batteries; re-pair remote (refer to remote manual); move to an area with less interference.
Lights or music not working	Loose wiring; component failure.	Check connections; contact customer support.
