EasyKeys Master Lock J958 Padlock Replacement Key Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the identification and proper use of your EasyKeys Master Lock J958 replacement key. This key is specifically designed for Master Lock padlocks within the J301-J999 series. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure correct application and functionality.

KEY IDENTIFICATION: LOCATING YOUR LOCK CODE

To ensure you have the correct replacement key, it is crucial to verify your lock's code. The lock code can typically be found in one of the following locations:

Where to Find Your Lock Code




On the Key

Important Notes

- Order by Manufacturer → Lock codes are manufacturer-specific.
- Key Cuts Differ → Even if codes look similar, they vary by brand.

This image illustrates common locations where you can find your lock code. These include directly on the original key, etched onto the face of the lock cylinder, on a label positioned inside or behind the lock mechanism, or on a label affixed to the cabinet or door associated with the lock.

- **On the Key:** The code may be stamped or engraved directly onto your original key.
- **On the Lock Face:** For some locks, the code is visible on the front face of the lock cylinder.

- **On a Label Inside/Behind the Lock:** The code might be printed on a sticker or label located within the lock mechanism or on the surface behind it.
- **On the Cabinet/Door Label:** If the lock is part of a furniture piece or door, the code could be on a label attached to the cabinet or door itself.

Important: Always use the lock code from the key or original packaging, not the padlock itself, to ensure compatibility.

USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Insert Key:** Gently insert the EasyKeys Master Lock J958 replacement key fully into the padlock's keyway. Do not force the key.
2. **Turn Key:** Rotate the key clockwise or counter-clockwise (depending on the lock mechanism) to engage the internal tumblers and unlock the padlock.
3. **Remove Key:** Once the padlock is unlocked or locked, return the key to its original insertion position and carefully withdraw it.

Regularly check the padlock for any debris in the keyway that might obstruct key insertion or operation.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- **Manufacturer Specificity:** Lock codes are specific to their manufacturer. Ensure your padlock is a Master Lock brand.
- **Key Cut Variations:** Even if lock codes appear similar across different brands, the actual key cuts vary significantly. Always match the key to the correct brand and code.
- **Genuine Part:** This is a genuine original equipment part, cut on a K1-OEM key blank.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Key Does Not Insert Fully:** Check the padlock's keyway for any obstructions such as dirt, debris, or broken key fragments. Use compressed air to clear if necessary.
- **Key Inserts but Does Not Turn:** Verify that the lock code on your replacement key precisely matches the code required for your Master Lock padlock. Ensure the padlock is not seized due to rust or lack of lubrication.
- **Padlock Remains Locked:** Confirm that your padlock is indeed a Master Lock brand and falls within the J301-J999 series. This key is not universally compatible with all padlocks.
