1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Kenmore 2214785 24-inch Premium Hybrid Tub Dishwasher is designed for efficient and quiet dish cleaning. It features advanced technologies to ensure thorough washing and drying.

- **UltraWash System:** Utilizes 2 pressurized spray arms and a 3-stage filter to remove stubborn food particles, ensuring dishes are cleaned with filtered water.
- SmartWash Cycle: Sensor technology automatically detects soil levels and adjusts water temperature, pressure, and cycle time for optimal cleaning.
- MoreSpace Adjustable Upper Rack: Provides flexibility to accommodate large or oddly shaped items
 with two height levels.
- Sani Rinse Option: Offers a UL-certified sanitization cycle for enhanced hygiene.
- Heated Dry Option: Facilitates quick water evaporation for sparkling, dry dishes.
- Quiet Operation: Operates at a low noise level of 54 dBA.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Electrical Safety: Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded. Do not use extension cords.
- Water Supply: Connect to a potable water supply only. Ensure all water connections are secure to prevent leaks.
- Installation: Installation must be performed by a qualified installer in accordance with all local codes and ordinances
- **Child Safety:** Keep children away from the dishwasher during operation. Do not allow children to play inside or on the dishwasher.
- **Sharp Objects:** Load sharp items so they are not likely to damage the door seal or tub. Load sharp knives with handles up.
- Flammable Materials: Do not store or use flammable materials near the dishwasher.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper measurement and preparation are crucial for a smooth installation. This section guides you through the necessary steps before your dishwasher arrives.

3.1 Measuring Your Space

Before delivery, measure the path from the delivery truck to the final installation location, including gates, hallways, doorways, corners, and stairways. Also, measure the dimensions of the installation space in your kitchen.

3.2 Required Tools and Parts

Ensure you have the following tools and parts ready for installation. Some items may be included with your dishwasher, while others may need to be purchased separately.

- Water Line: An established hot water line is necessary for operation. Ensure the water supply is accessible and within reach of the dishwasher's connection point.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the dishwasher's controls and cycles for optimal cleaning performance.

4.1 Loading the Dishwasher

Proper loading ensures effective cleaning. Utilize the **MoreSpace Adjustable Upper Rack** to accommodate various dish sizes. Place larger items in the lower rack and smaller items, glasses, and cups in the upper rack. Ensure spray arms are not obstructed.

4.2 Wash Cycles and Options

Select the appropriate cycle and options based on the soil level and type of dishes.

- Normal: For regular loads and everyday messes.
- Heavy Duty: Ideal for heavily soiled dishes, pots, and pans.
- EcoWash: Energy-efficient cycle for lightly soiled dishes.
- Express Wash: Quick cycle for lightly soiled dishes that need to be cleaned fast.
- SmartWash: Automatically adjusts settings based on soil level detected by sensors.
- Sani Rinse: Adds a high-temperature rinse to sanitize dishes.
- Heated Dry: Activates a heating element for improved drying performance.
- Delay Start: Allows you to set the dishwasher to start at a later time.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Kenmore dishwasher.

5.1 Cleaning the UltraWash Filter

The 3-stage UltraWash Filter captures food particles and should be cleaned monthly to maintain performance. To clean, remove the filter assembly, rinse under running water to remove trapped particles, and reassemble securely.

5.2 General Cleaning

- Exterior: Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. For fingerprint-resistant stainless steel, use a stainless steel cleaner.
- Interior: Periodically clean the interior with a dishwasher cleaner or a mixture of vinegar and baking soda to prevent odor and mineral buildup.
- Door Seal: Wipe the door gasket with a damp cloth to remove food particles and residue.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before calling for service, review these common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishes not clean	Improper loading, clogged filter, low water temperature, incorrect detergent.	Reload dishes correctly, clean UltraWash filter, ensure hot water supply, use recommended detergent.
Dishwasher not draining	Clogged drain hose or filter, air gap blockage, drain pump issue.	Check and clear drain hose/filter, inspect air gap, consult service if pump is faulty.
Excessive noise	Improper loading, foreign object in pump, spray arm hitting dishes.	Adjust dish placement, remove foreign objects, ensure spray arms rotate freely.
Water leaks	Loose hose connections, damaged door gasket, excessive suds.	Tighten connections, inspect/replace gasket, use less detergent.
