1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HOOBRO 4-Panel Freestanding Dog Gate. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your pet gate. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always ensure the gate is securely assembled and placed on a flat, stable surface.
- This gate is designed for small to medium-sized dogs and pets. Do not use for pets that can easily climb over or push through the gate.
- Do not use this gate as a child safety barrier. It is not intended for children.
- Regularly check all components for wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if any part is damaged.
- Keep pets away from the gate during assembly to prevent injury.
- Do not modify the product in any way. Use only manufacturer-supplied parts.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly:

- 4 x Metal Gate Panels (pre-assembled with hinges)
- 2 x Metal Support Feet
- 1 x Latch Mechanism (pre-attached to one panel)
- Screws for attaching support feet (quantity as per design)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The HOOBRO dog gate comes mostly pre-assembled. Follow these steps to complete the setup:

1. **Unfold the Gate Panels:** Carefully unfold the four metal gate panels to your desired configuration (Z, U, L, or square shape). The 360° rotating hinges allow for flexible arrangement.




Figure 4.1: Gate panels with 360° rotating hinges allowing for various shapes.

2. **Attach Support Feet:** Locate the two metal support feet. Align each foot with the designated holes at the bottom of the gate panels (typically at the ends or strategic points for stability). Secure them using the provided screws. Ensure the feet are firmly attached to provide maximum stability.

3. **Position the Gate:** Place the assembled gate in the desired location, such as a doorway, hallway, or at the bottom of stairs. Adjust the panels to fit the space, ensuring it is stable and cannot be easily pushed over by your pet.



5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Main Gate Operation

The main gate features a lockable latch for convenient access. To open, slide the latch mechanism and swing the gate panel open. To close, swing the panel back into position and engage the latch until it clicks securely.

5.2 Cat Door Operation

A smaller door is integrated into one of the panels, designed for cats or smaller pets to pass through. This door can swing open one-way. Ensure the cat door is clear of obstructions for your pet's safe passage.

Two Doors

Easily separate cats and dogs, creating ideal play zones for each.

5.3 Folding and Storage

For compact storage, the gate can be folded. Simply collapse the panels along the hinges. The design allows for a flat, space-saving profile, ideal for storing under furniture or in closets.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the gate with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish. Dry thoroughly after cleaning.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all hinges, latches, and connections for tightness and signs of wear or damage. Tighten any loose screws.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the gate in a dry place to prevent rust or damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gate is unstable or wobbly.	Support feet not properly attached or tightened; uneven surface.	Ensure support feet are securely fastened with all screws. Place the gate on a flat, level surface. Adjust panel angles for better balance.
Main gate latch is difficult to open/close.	Misalignment of panels; latch mechanism obstructed or stiff.	Adjust the gate panels to ensure proper alignment. Check for any debris obstructing the latch. Apply a small amount of lubricant if the mechanism is stiff.
Cat door does not swing freely.	Hinges are stiff or obstructed.	Check for any debris around the cat door hinges. Ensure the gate is not placed in a way that puts pressure on the cat door.
Gate does not fit the opening.	Incorrect configuration for the space.	Utilize the 360° rotating hinges to adjust the gate into a Z, U, or L shape to better fit your specific doorway or area.




Figure 8.1: Product dimensions overview.
