SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

OPERATING AND FEATURES

Once assembled, the Lloyd's Titan Mech offers several interactive features:

- **Posable Joints:** The mech features highly posable body parts, including wings, legs, feet, arms, and shoulders. This allows for dynamic display and play configurations.
- **Cockpit:** A dedicated cockpit is integrated for one of the minifigures to pilot the mech.

- **Weaponry:** The mech is equipped with a large sword and a brick-built shield. The shield can be attached to the mech's back to function as wings.
- **Minifigures:** The set includes Lloyd, Grimfax, and a collectible Elemental Master of Ice minifigure, each with their own accessories for imaginative play.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Dust your LEGO model regularly with a soft brush or cloth. For deeper cleaning, use a mild soap solution and a soft cloth, then rinse with clear water and air dry. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the assembled model or loose bricks in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration and material degradation.
- **Handling:** Handle the model with care, especially when adjusting posable parts, to prevent accidental detachment of pieces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues during assembly or with the completed model, consider the following:

- **Missing Pieces:** Double-check all packaging and sorting areas. If a piece is genuinely missing, contact LEGO Customer Service for replacement parts.
- **Incorrect Assembly:** Refer back to the instruction booklet or the LEGO Builder app. Carefully retrace your steps

to identify any misplaced or incorrectly attached bricks.

- **Loose Connections:** Ensure all bricks are firmly pressed together. LEGO connections are designed to be secure when properly aligned and pressed.
