


SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the functionality and safety of your car stereo. It is recommended to have this unit installed by a professional if you are unfamiliar with car audio wiring.

1. Wiring Connections

Refer to the wiring diagrams below for correct connections. Ensure all connections are secure to prevent malfunctions.




Image: Detailed wiring diagrams for the main power harness and speaker connections, along with rear panel port introductions.

- **Power Cable:** Connect the yellow wire to the constant 12V power supply, the red wire to the accessory 12V supply (switched with ignition), and the black wire to ground.
- **Speaker Cables:** Connect the speaker wires according to the color codes for front left, front right, rear left, and rear right speakers.
- **Steering Wheel Control (KEY):** Connect the steering wheel control wire(s) to your vehicle's steering wheel control interface (if applicable).
- **Reverse Camera (REVERSE):** Connect the reverse camera trigger wire to the vehicle's reverse light circuit.
- **Antenna (ANT):** Connect your car's radio antenna.

2. Rearview Camera Connection (Optional)

If you are installing an optional rearview camera, connect it as shown in the diagram. The unit will automatically display the rearview image when the vehicle is in reverse gear.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Short press the volume knob to mute, long press to power off.
- **Volume Control:** Rotate the volume knob to adjust the sound level.
- **Touchscreen:** Navigate menus and control functions by touching the 7-inch display.

2. Bluetooth Hands-Free

Connect your mobile phone via Bluetooth for hands-free calling and audio streaming.

Bluetooth Hands-Free

1. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile phone.
2. On the car stereo, go to the Bluetooth menu and search for available devices.
3. Select the car stereo's Bluetooth name (e.g., "CAMECHO BT") from your phone's list and pair.
4. Once paired, you can make/receive calls and play music wirelessly.

3. FM Radio & Equalizer

Access FM radio stations and customize your audio experience with the built-in equalizer.

FM Radio & Equalizer

Support FM function. Built-in preset EQ for a variety of music styles.

- **FM Radio:** Select the FM function to scan for stations or manually tune to a frequency. Save your favorite stations as presets.
- **Equalizer (EQ):** Access the EQ settings to choose from preset sound modes (e.g., Pop, Classic, Rock) or customize the audio frequencies to your preference.

4. Mirror Link Function

Mirror your smartphone screen onto the car stereo display for navigation, video playback, and other applications.

you can mirror the mobile phone screen to the car player.

- Connect your Android or iOS phone to the stereo using a USB cable.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to enable mirror link. This may require installing a specific app on your phone.
- Once connected, your phone's screen will be displayed on the stereo, allowing for control via the stereo's touchscreen.

5. Steering Wheel Control

Utilize your vehicle's existing steering wheel buttons to control the stereo for a safer driving experience.

- Access the steering wheel control settings in the system menu.
- Follow the instructions to program your steering wheel buttons to control functions like volume, track skip, and mode selection.

6. Multimedia Playback

The unit supports various media inputs for audio and video playback.

- **USB/Type-C:** Insert a USB drive or connect a device via the Type-C port for media playback or phone charging.
- **SD Card:** Insert an SD card into the dedicated slot for media playback.
- **AUX Input:** Connect external audio devices using a 3.5mm AUX cable.

7. Color Key Light Setting

Customize the backlight color of the physical buttons on the unit.

COLOR KEY LIGHT

- Navigate to the system settings menu.
- Find the 'Color Key Light' or 'Illumination' option.
- Choose from various colors (Red, Green, Blue, Yellow, Cyan, Purple, White) or set it to cycle through colors automatically.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your CAMECHO car stereo, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the touchscreen. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **General Cleaning:** Keep the unit free from dust and debris. Use a soft brush or compressed air to clean around buttons and ports.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not expose the unit to extreme heat or cold for extended periods, as this can affect electronic components.

- **Check Connections:** Periodically check all wiring connections to ensure they are secure and free from corrosion.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your car stereo, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power/Unit does not turn on	Incorrect wiring, blown fuse, vehicle battery issue.	Check power cable connections (yellow, red, black). Verify vehicle fuses and the stereo's fuse. Ensure vehicle battery is charged.
No sound output	Speaker wires incorrectly connected, volume too low, mute function active, faulty speakers.	Check all speaker wire connections. Increase volume. Ensure unit is not muted. Test with different audio sources.
Touchscreen unresponsive or inaccurate	Screen calibration needed, software glitch, physical damage.	Try restarting the unit. Check for a screen calibration option in settings. If issue persists, contact support.
Bluetooth not connecting	Bluetooth not enabled, incorrect pairing process, interference.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Delete previous pairings and re-pair. Move closer to the unit.
Mirror Link not working	Incorrect USB cable, required app not installed, phone settings.	Use a high-quality USB data cable. Ensure the necessary mirror link app is installed and permissions are granted on your phone.
