Timex Women's Trend 25mm Watch Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and care of your Timex Women's Trend 25mm Watch. This timepiece features a 25mm polished case, a gold-tone sunray dial with applied indices, an elegantly fluted bezel, and a gold-tone stainless-steel bracelet. It is equipped with a quartz movement and luminant hands for visibility in low light conditions.

SETUP

1. Setting the Time

1. **Pull out the crown:** Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) to its outermost position.
2. **Adjust the time:** Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise until the hour and minute hands indicate the correct time.
3. **Push in the crown:** Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position against the watch case. This will start the watch movement.

2. Adjusting the Bracelet

The watch features a deployment clasp for secure wearing. To adjust the bracelet length, it may be necessary to remove or add links. This procedure typically requires specialized tools and is best performed by a qualified jeweler or watch technician to avoid damage to the bracelet or clasp.

OPERATING

1. Time-Telling

Your watch displays time using traditional hour and minute hands. The luminant hands provide enhanced visibility in low-light conditions, allowing you to read the time without external illumination.

2. Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). This rating means the watch is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming. It is **not** suitable for diving, snorkeling, or prolonged water activities. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

- Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet or submerged.
- Do not expose the watch to hot water, steam, or harsh chemicals, as this can compromise the water resistance seals.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, regularly wipe the case and bracelet with a soft, dry cloth. For the stainless-steel bracelet, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

2. Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a 12V battery (included). When the watch stops running, the battery will need to be replaced. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and to prevent damage to the movement. Refer to the specifications section for battery type.

3. Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and strong magnetic fields.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch is not running	Battery depleted; Crown not pushed in	Replace battery (professional service recommended); Push crown fully into case
Time is inaccurate	Time not set correctly; Low battery	Reset the time; Replace battery (professional service recommended)
Condensation under crystal	Water resistance compromised	Immediately contact Timex customer support or a qualified watch repair center. Do not attempt to open the watch.
