1. INTRODUCTION

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start	No power; Incorrect wiring; Motor overload; Seized bearings	Check power supply and circuit breaker; Verify wiring connections; Check for obstructions; Consult a qualified technician.
Motor runs hot	Insufficient airflow; Overload; Incorrect voltage; Bearing issues	Clean fan blades/grilles; Reduce load if possible; Verify correct voltage; Consult a qualified technician.
Excessive noise or vibration	Loose mounting; Unbalanced fan blade; Worn bearings	Tighten mounting bolts; Inspect and balance fan blade; Consult a qualified technician for bearing replacement.
Motor hums but does not turn	Capacitor failure (if applicable); Seized bearings; Obstruction	Consult a qualified technician for capacitor check/replacement; Check for obstructions; Consult a qualified technician for bearing issues.
