INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the RORIOS Men's Analog Quartz Watch, Model AA-AMU006. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new timepiece. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening your RORIOS watch box, please verify that all the following items are included:

- 1 x RORIOS Men's Analog Quartz Watch (Model AA-AMU006)
- 1 x User Manual (this document)
- 1 x Luxury Leather Watch Box

SETUP

1. Initial Time and Date Setting

1. **Pull out the Crown:** Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch) to position 2 for

date adjustment, or position 3 for time adjustment.

2. **Set the Date:** In position 2, turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the correct date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this is when the date mechanism is engaged and could be damaged.
3. **Set the Time:** In position 3, turn the crown to move the hands clockwise until the correct time is displayed. Ensure you differentiate between AM and PM for accurate date change.
4. **Push in the Crown:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into position 1 (normal operating position) to start the watch movement.

2. Adjusting the Bracelet

The stainless steel bracelet is designed for comfort and durability. If the bracelet requires adjustment to fit your wrist, it is recommended to visit a professional jeweler or watch repair service. They have the specialized tools and expertise to remove or add links without damaging the watch or bracelet.

OPERATING THE WATCH

1. Reading the Time

The watch features a classic analog display with hour, minute, and second hands. The luminous hands and markers provide visibility in low-light conditions after exposure to light.

2. Date Display

The date window is located on the dial and automatically advances every 24 hours. If the date needs manual correction (e.g., after a month with fewer than 31 days), refer to the 'Set the Date' instructions in the Setup section.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, wipe the case and bracelet regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stainless steel, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

2. Water Resistance

This RORIOS watch is designed to resist daily splashes, such as hand washing or light rain. It is **not** suitable for swimming, showering, or diving. Exposure to hot water or steam should also be avoided as it can compromise the watch's seals.

3. Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement, which requires a battery. When the watch stops running, it indicates that the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and prevent damage to the movement.

4. Storage

When not in use, store your watch in its original luxury leather box or a soft pouch to protect it from dust, moisture, and scratches. Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures or strong magnetic fields.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:**

Check if the crown is fully pushed in (position 1). If it is, the battery may need replacement.

- **Date Not Changing:**

Ensure the time is set correctly, especially distinguishing between AM and PM. If the date changes at noon, the watch is set 12 hours off. Adjust the time accordingly.

- **Condensation Inside the Crystal:**

Small amounts of condensation may appear temporarily under certain temperature changes. If condensation persists or appears as large droplets, it indicates a potential issue with the watch's water resistance. Seek professional service immediately.
