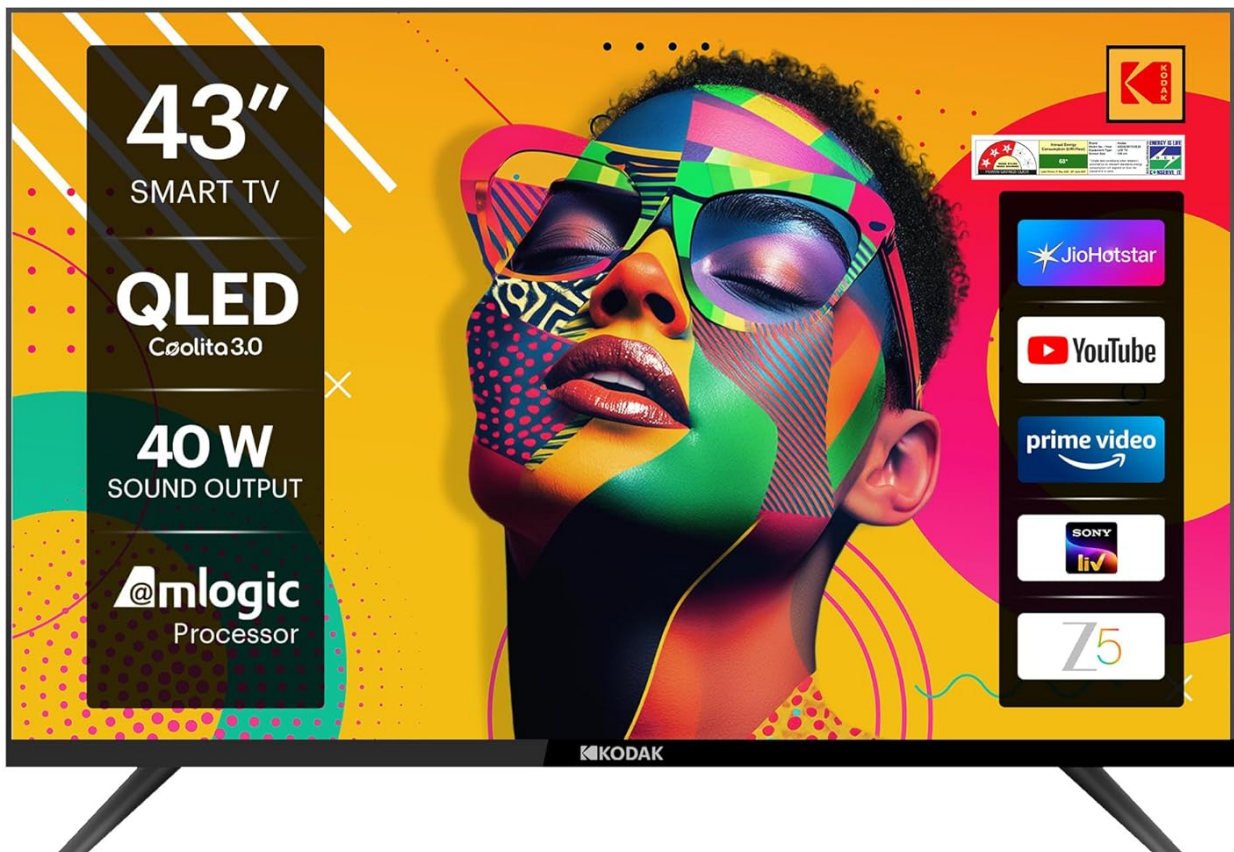

## INTRODUCTION

- 2 AAA Batteries (for remote control)
- 1 Power Cord
- Base Stand
- 4 Stand Screws

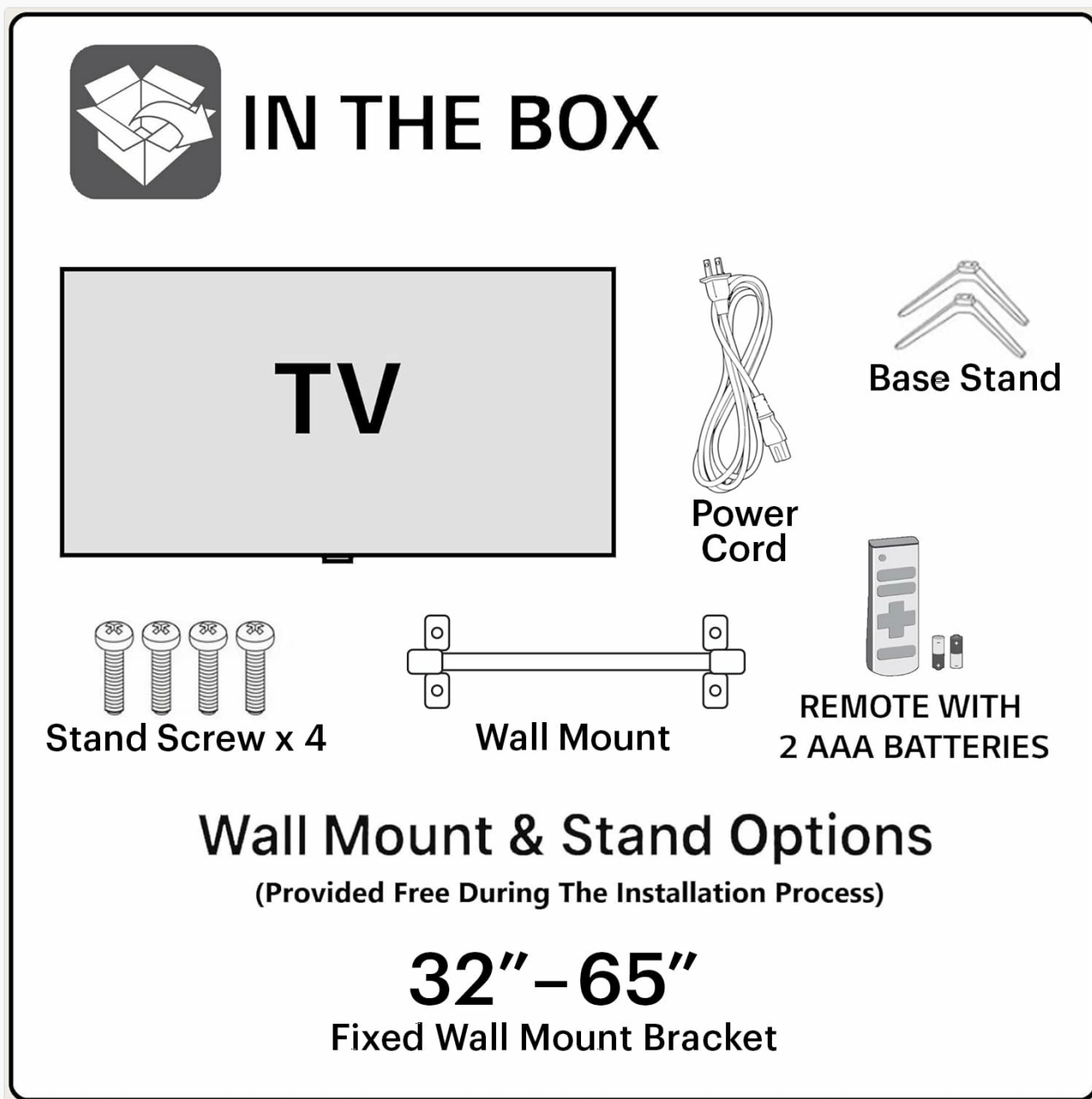


Image: Diagram illustrating the items included in the TV packaging, such as the TV unit, remote, power cord, stand, screws, and wall mount.

# SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

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## 1. Physical Installation

Your television can be installed using either the included base stand or a wall mount.

### Stand Installation:

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
2. Attach the base stands to the designated slots on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands with the provided stand screws.

### Wall Mount Installation:

The TV comes with a wall mount. Professional installation is recommended for wall mounting to ensure safety and proper alignment. Refer to the wall mount instructions for detailed steps.

## 2. Connecting Peripherals

The TV offers various connectivity options for external devices.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect gaming consoles, set-top boxes, or Blu-ray players to the 2 HDMI ports. One port supports eARC for enhanced audio return.
- **USB Ports:** Connect hard drives or other USB devices to the 2 USB ports for media playback.
- **Ethernet:** For a stable internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ45 port.
- **Optical Audio Out:** Connect to external sound systems for digital audio output.
- **AV Input:** For older devices, use the AV1 and AV2 inputs (Audio-L, Audio-R, Video).
- **Earphone Jack:** Connect headphones for private listening.

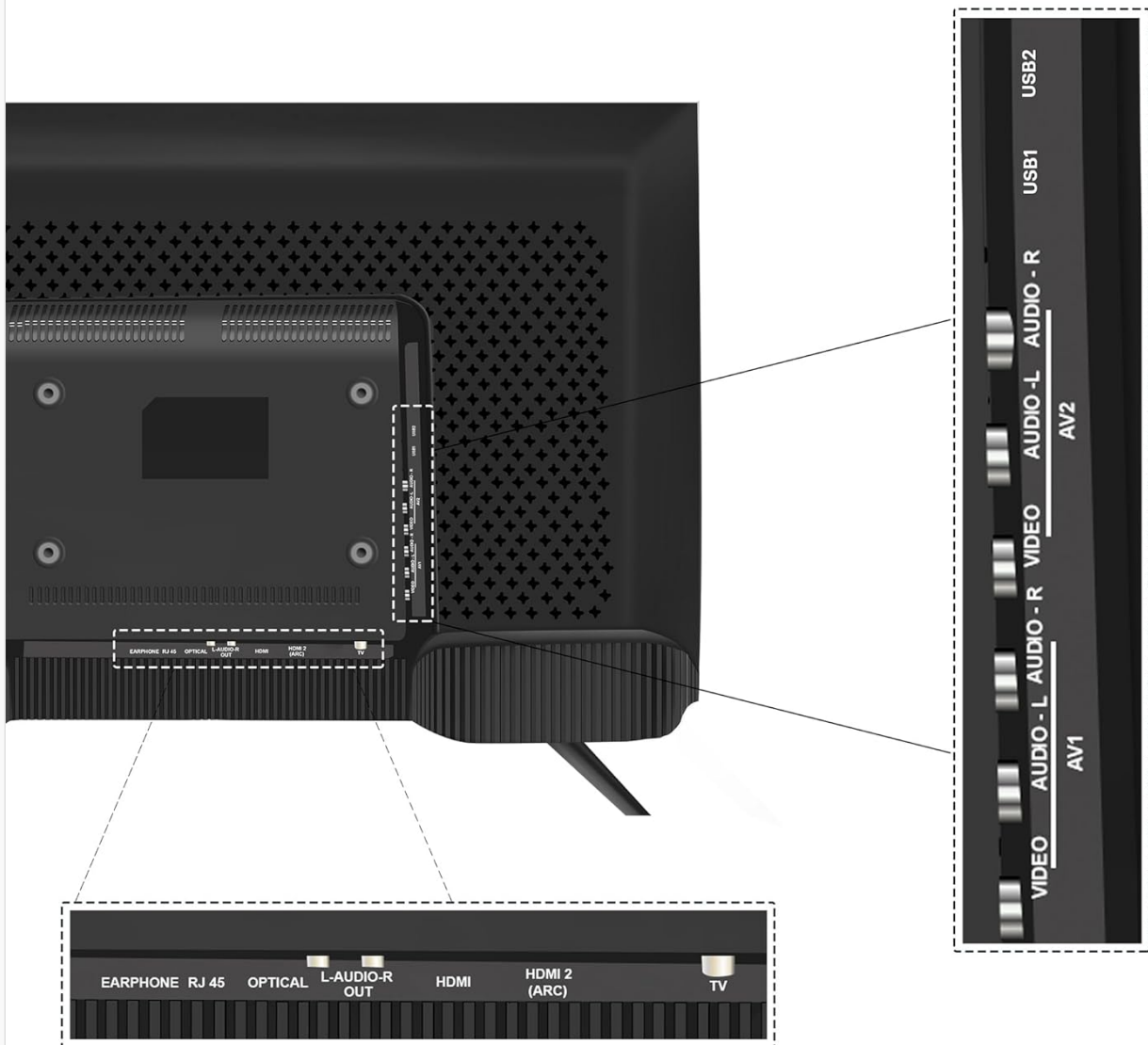


Image: Close-up view of the TV's rear panel, highlighting the various input/output ports including HDMI, USB, Optical, Ethernet, and AV inputs.

### 3. Power On

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a power outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Remote Control

The included remote control allows you to navigate the TV's features. Insert the 2 AAA batteries into the remote control, ensuring correct polarity.

- **Supported Applications:** Access popular streaming services such as JioHotstar, YouTube, Prime Video, Sony Liv, and Zee5.
- **Google Assistant:** Use voice commands for search, control, and information (if supported by the specific Linux TV implementation).
- **Open Browser:** Browse the internet directly on your TV.

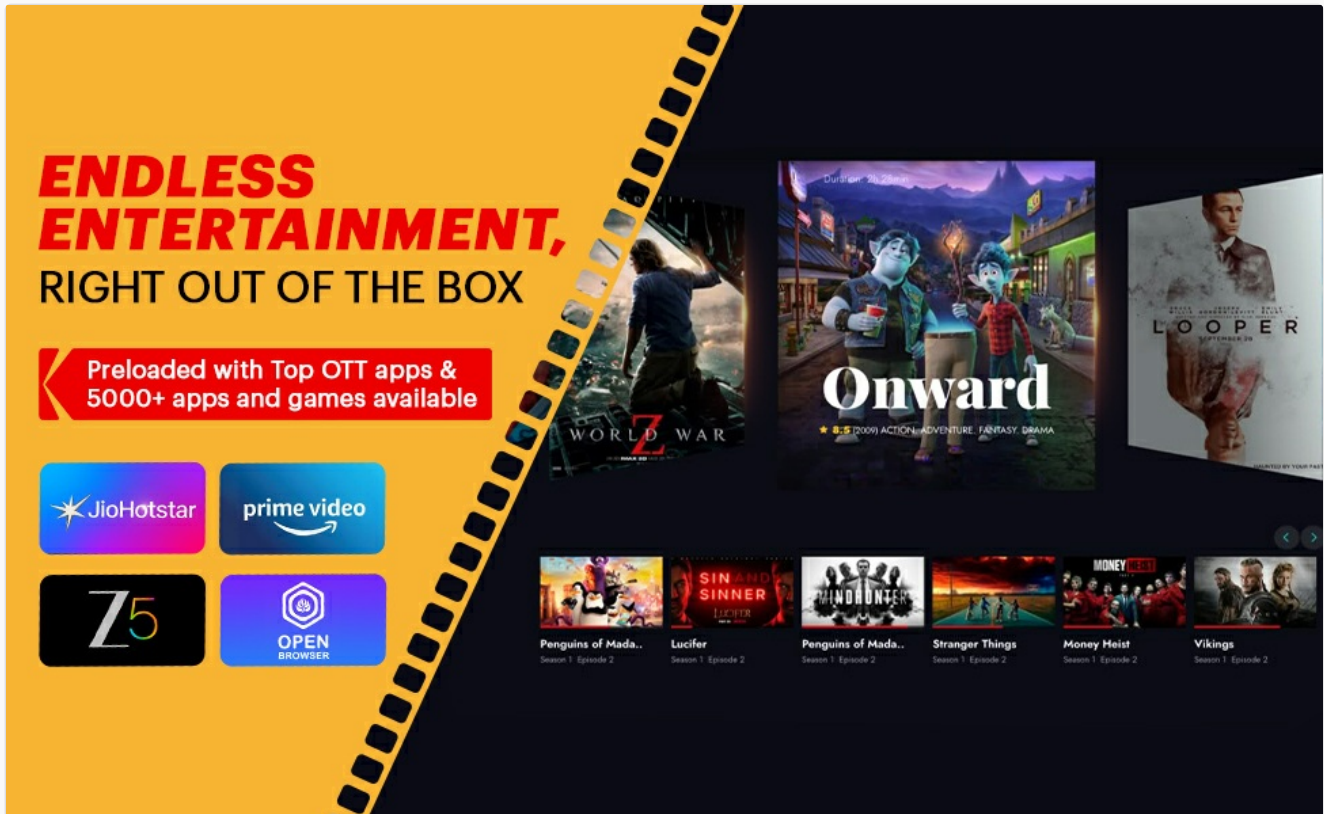

### 3. Picture and Sound Settings

#### Picture Settings:

- **Brightness:** Adjust the overall luminance of the screen.
- **Contrast:** Controls the difference between the brightest and darkest areas.

#### Sound Settings:

## MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your television.

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution (do not spray directly on the screen).
- **Cleaning the Body:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV's frame and back panel.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate airflow around the TV. Do not block ventilation openings.
- **Power Off:** Turn off the TV and unplug it from the power outlet during electrical storms or when not in use for extended periods.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord disconnected; Power outlet off	Ensure power cord is securely connected; Check power outlet and circuit breaker.
No picture, but sound is present	Incorrect input source selected; Loose HDMI/AV cable	Press the 'Input' button on the remote to select the correct source; Check cable connections.
No sound, but picture is present	Volume muted or too low; External audio system issue	Unmute or increase volume; Check connections to external audio devices.
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted or incorrectly inserted; Obstruction between remote and TV	Replace batteries; Ensure clear line of sight to TV's IR receiver.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password; Router issues; Signal interference	Re-enter Wi-Fi password; Restart router; Move TV closer to router or use Ethernet.
Smart TV apps freezing or slow	Insufficient memory; Network congestion	Close unused apps; Restart TV; Check internet speed.

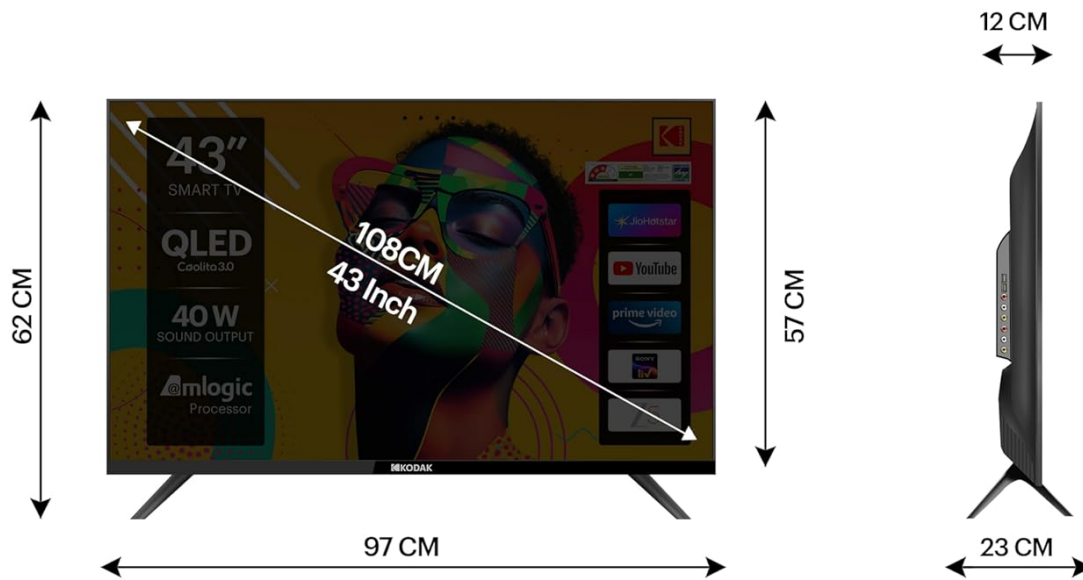


Image: Diagram illustrating the physical dimensions of the 43-inch Kodak QLED SE TV, including width, height, and depth.
