# Fakir FW3503 Multifunctional Chopper User Manual

Model: FW3503

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Fakir FW3503 Multifunctional Chopper. This appliance is designed to simplify your food preparation tasks, offering efficient chopping, mincing, and mixing capabilities. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the motor unit, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always ensure the lid is securely locked in place before operating the appliance.
- Blades are sharp. Handle with care.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW (COMPONENTS)

Familiarize yourself with the various parts of your Fakir FW3503 Multifunctional Chopper:

- **Motor Unit:** Contains the motor and control buttons.

- **Lid:** Secures the bowl and activates the safety mechanism.
- **Processing Bowl (Clear):** A transparent bowl for chopping and mixing, typically with a 1-liter capacity.
- **Processing Bowl (Stainless Steel):** An alternative stainless steel bowl for various tasks.
- **Chopping Blade:** Sharp blades for cutting and mincing ingredients.
- **Dough Blade:** A specialized blade for mixing dough.

## 4. SETUP

---

Follow these steps to assemble your chopper before use:

1. **Choose Your Bowl:** Select either the clear processing bowl or the stainless steel processing bowl based on your task.

2. **Insert Blade:** Carefully place the desired blade (chopping or dough) onto the central shaft inside the bowl. Ensure it sits securely.

3. **Add Ingredients:** Place your ingredients into the bowl. Do not overfill; observe the 'MAX' level marking on the bowl.
4. **Attach Lid:** Place the lid onto the bowl, ensuring it aligns correctly and locks into place.
5. **Position Motor Unit:** Place the motor unit on top of the lid, aligning the drive shaft with the blade assembly.
6. **Connect Power:** Plug the appliance into a suitable power outlet.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Fakir FW3503 offers quick and efficient processing for various ingredients. Always ensure the appliance is properly assembled and the lid is securely in place before operation.

### General Operation:

- Once assembled and plugged in, press and hold the desired function button on the motor unit.

- The appliance will operate as long as the button is pressed. Release the button to stop.
- For best results, use short pulses rather than continuous operation, especially for chopping.
- Do not operate continuously for more than 30 seconds. Allow the motor to rest for at least 2 minutes between cycles.

Specific Functions:

- **Vegetable Chopping:** Use the chopping blade. Press the 'Vegetable' button for quick chopping of vegetables like onions, carrots, or herbs. Use short pulses to achieve desired consistency.
- **Meat Mincing:** Use the chopping blade. Press the 'Meat' button for mincing raw meat. Cut meat into small cubes before processing.
- **Dough Mixing:** Use the dough blade. Press the 'Dough' button for mixing small batches of dough. Add liquids gradually as needed.

The durable and sharp blades allow for quick and efficient chopping of even tough ingredients, significantly reducing preparation time compared to traditional methods.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygienic operation of your chopper. Its practical detachable design makes cleaning easy.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Disassemble:** Carefully remove the motor unit, lid, and blade from the processing bowl.
3. **Clean Blades:** Handle the blades with extreme care as they are very sharp. Wash them under running water with a mild detergent. Use a brush if necessary.
4. **Clean Bowls and Lid:** Wash the processing bowls and lid in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately. These parts may also be dishwasher safe (check product markings for confirmation).
5. **Clean Motor Unit:** Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth. Never immerse the motor unit in water or any other liquid.
6. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing the appliance. Store in a cool, dry place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fakir FW3503, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not start	Not plugged in; Lid not properly secured; Motor unit not correctly placed.	Ensure plug is firmly in outlet; Check that the lid is locked; Re-position the motor unit.
Motor runs, but blades do not turn	Blade not correctly installed; Overloaded bowl.	Re-install the blade, ensuring it sits on the shaft; Reduce the amount of ingredients in the bowl.



Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Uneven chopping results	Ingredients too large; Overloaded bowl; Insufficient pulsing.	Cut ingredients into smaller, uniform pieces; Reduce quantity; Use more short pulses.
Appliance stops during operation	Overheating protection activated; Overload.	Unplug and let the appliance cool down for 10-15 minutes; Reduce ingredient load.
