## **1. INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for choosing the Electactic 2.56 Cu.ft Compact Refrigerator. This appliance is designed for convenient food and beverage storage in various settings such as dorm rooms, offices, bedrooms, or small apartments. Its compact size, reversible door, and quiet operation make it a versatile addition to any space.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your refrigerator, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Connect to a properly grounded outlet only.
- Do not attempt to repair or replace any part of your refrigerator unless specifically recommended in this manual. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.
- Unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or performing any maintenance.

- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Keep children away from the refrigerator.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1 Unpacking

1. Remove all packaging materials, including foam and adhesive tape.
2. Inspect the refrigerator for any damage. Report any damage to your retailer immediately.
3. Clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a soft cloth and mild detergent before use.

### 4.2 Placement

- Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface.
- Allow at least 4 inches (10 cm) of space between the back and sides of the refrigerator and any adjacent walls or cabinets for proper ventilation.
- Avoid placing the refrigerator in direct sunlight or near heat sources (e.g., stoves, heaters).
- Ensure the ambient temperature is between 50°F (10°C) and 90°F (32°C) for optimal performance.

### 4.3 Leveling the Refrigerator

The refrigerator has adjustable leveling legs at the front. Adjust them to ensure the unit is level and stable. A level refrigerator operates more efficiently and prevents the door from swinging open or closed unintentionally.

### 4.4 Door Reversal

This refrigerator features a reversible door, allowing it to open from either the left or right side to suit your space. Refer to the detailed instructions in the separate door reversal guide (if provided) or contact customer support for assistance with this procedure.

## 4.5 Initial Power-On

After placement and leveling, plug the refrigerator into a dedicated 115V AC outlet. Allow the unit to run for at least 2-3 hours empty before placing food inside to ensure it reaches the desired temperature.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 5.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator is equipped with a rotary thermostat button located inside the unit. It offers 7 variable temperature settings. Turn the dial to your desired setting. A higher number indicates a colder temperature.

- The refrigerator compartment temperature range is approximately 32°F to 50°F (0°C to 10°C).
- The small freezer compartment is suitable for making ice cubes and keeping items chilled, but it is **not** suitable for storing ice cream or long-term freezing of perishable foods due to its temperature range.




Image 5.1: Thermostat Dial

## 5.2 Adjustable Shelves

The refrigerator includes adjustable glass shelves that can be repositioned to accommodate items of various sizes. To adjust, carefully lift the shelf and slide it out. Reinsert into the desired slots.




Image 5.2: Adjustable Shelf

## 5.3 Door Storage

The refrigerator door features a large-capacity chamber suitable for storing frequently used beverage bottles or cans, optimizing internal space.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1 Cleaning

1. Always unplug the refrigerator before cleaning.
2. Wash the interior with a mild detergent and warm water. Use a soft cloth to prevent scratching.
3. Clean the exterior with a soft cloth dampened with water and a mild detergent.
4. Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or scouring pads, as they can damage surfaces.
5. Regularly clean the drip tray located beneath the freezer compartment.

### 6.2 Manual Defrosting

This refrigerator features manual defrost. Frost will accumulate on the freezer compartment walls. When the frost layer becomes about 0.2 inches (5 mm) thick, defrost the unit:

1. Unplug the refrigerator.

2. Remove all food items and place them in another cooler.
3. Leave the door open to allow frost to melt naturally. You can place towels at the bottom to absorb water.
4. Do not use sharp objects or heating devices to remove frost, as this can damage the cooling system.
5. Once defrosted, clean and dry the interior thoroughly before plugging it back in and returning food.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please check the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator does not operate.	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; temperature control set to "OFF".	Ensure plug is secure; reset circuit breaker; set temperature control to a numerical setting.
Temperature is not cold enough.	Temperature control set too warm; door opened too frequently; warm food placed inside; poor ventilation.	Adjust temperature to a colder setting; minimize door openings; allow hot food to cool before storing; ensure adequate space around the unit.
Excessive noise.	Refrigerator not level; contact with wall/cabinet; normal operating sounds.	Adjust leveling legs; move unit away from obstructions; gurgling/hissing sounds are normal refrigerant flow.
Water on floor.	Drip tray overflowing; door not sealed properly.	Empty and clean drip tray; check door gasket for proper seal.
