INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HelloBaby HB6550Plus-2 Baby Monitor. This system provides a secure, non-WiFi connection for monitoring your baby with a 6-inch IPS split screen and two cameras. It features remote pan-tilt-zoom, invisible night vision, two-way talk, lullabies, and temperature alerts to ensure your child's safety and comfort.

- 6-inch IPS Split-Screen Parent Unit (Monitor) x 1
- Remote Pan/Tilt/Zoom Camera Unit x 2
- HelloBaby AC Charger x 3 (One for the monitor, two for the cameras)
- Wall Mounting Screws x 2
- User Manual x 1

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and follow these safety instructions to prevent injury or damage:

- **Strangulation Hazard:** Keep all cords out of reach of children. Never place the camera or monitor within 3 feet (1

meter) of the crib or playpen. Secure cords to a wall or floor using clips to prevent entanglement.

- **Choking Hazard:** This product contains small parts. Keep them away from children.
- **Overheating:** Do not cover the monitor or camera with blankets or towels. Ensure proper ventilation.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not expose the product to water or moisture. Use only in dry indoor environments.
- **Power Source:** Use only the AC adapters provided by HelloBaby. Using unauthorized adapters may damage the product and void the warranty.
- **Interference:** This product operates on a 2.4GHz frequency. Keep it away from other 2.4GHz devices (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, microwaves) to avoid interference.
- **Adult Supervision:** This product is intended to assist in monitoring, not to replace responsible adult supervision.

SETUP

1. Camera Placement

Place the camera units in a location that provides a clear view of your baby. Ensure the camera is at least 3 feet (1 meter) away from the crib to prevent strangulation hazards from the power cord. The cameras can be placed on a flat surface or wall-mounted using the included screws.

- **Optimal View:** Position the camera to capture the entire crib area.
- **Power Connection:** Connect the camera to a power outlet using one of the provided AC chargers.

Up, Down, All-around

2. Monitor Placement

Place the parent unit (monitor) in a convenient location where you can easily view the screen and hear alerts. Ensure it is within the operational range of the cameras (up to 1000ft outdoors, less indoors depending on obstacles).

- **Power Connection:** Connect the monitor to a power outlet using one of the provided AC chargers. The monitor has a built-in rechargeable battery for portable use.
- **Antenna:** Extend the antenna on the monitor for maximum range and signal stability.

3. Powering On and Pairing

Once both the cameras and monitor are connected to power, turn them on. The units are typically pre-paired from the factory. If a camera does not connect automatically, you may need to manually pair it:

1. Access the monitor's menu.
2. Navigate to the "Camera" or "Pairing" option.
3. Select an available camera channel.
4. Press the pairing button on the back of the camera unit within 10 seconds.
5. The monitor will display the camera's feed once successfully paired.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Functions

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button on the monitor.
- **Volume Control:** Use the dedicated volume buttons on the monitor to adjust the audio level.
- **Brightness:** Adjust screen brightness through the monitor's menu settings.

2. Split-Screen Mode

The 6-inch IPS display allows simultaneous viewing of two cameras. Activate split-screen mode via the monitor's menu or a dedicated button (refer to your monitor's specific button layout).

- **Audio Selection:** In split-screen mode, you can select which camera's audio to hear. The monitor will provide visual alerts for sounds detected by the other camera.
- **Auto-Switch Mode:** Enable this feature to cycle between cameras every 15 seconds, providing hands-free multi-room awareness.

3. VOX / ECO Mode

VOX (Voice Operated eXchange) or ECO mode conserves battery by turning off the monitor screen when no sound is detected. The screen automatically activates when sound is picked up by the camera.

- **Activation:** Enable VOX/ECO mode through the monitor's menu. You can often adjust the sound sensitivity level.
- **Visual Sound Indicators:** Even when muted or in VOX mode, colored LED indicators on the monitor will show sound levels, alerting you to crying or noise.

4. Two-Way Talk

Press and hold the microphone button on the monitor to speak to your baby through the camera's speaker. Release the button to hear your baby again.

5. Lullabies

The monitor includes 8 pre-programmed lullabies. Access the lullaby function through the menu to play soothing melodies to your baby remotely.

6. Night Vision

The cameras are equipped with invisible infrared night vision, automatically activating in low-light conditions. This provides a clear view of your baby in total darkness without disturbing them with visible red lights.

7. Temperature Monitoring

The camera units include a room temperature sensor. The current temperature of the baby's room is displayed on the monitor. You can set alerts for temperatures outside a desired range.

8. Pan, Tilt, and Zoom (PTZ)

Use the directional buttons on the monitor to remotely control the camera's pan (horizontal) and tilt (vertical) movements. The cameras offer 355° pan and 120° tilt for comprehensive room coverage. The digital zoom function allows you to get a closer look at your baby.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the monitor and camera surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, fully charge the monitor before first use. Avoid extreme temperatures. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery every few months.
- Lens Cleaning:** Gently wipe the camera lens with a lens cleaning cloth if it becomes dirty to ensure clear image quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
No image/sound on monitor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure both monitor and camera are powered on and connected to power.Check if the camera is paired with the monitor (refer to "Setup" section).Move the monitor closer to the camera to improve signal.Recharge the monitor battery.
Poor image quality/signal interference	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure the monitor antenna is extended.Reduce the distance between the camera and monitor.Move the units away from other 2.4GHz devices (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, microwaves).Check for obstructions like thick walls or metal objects.
VOX mode not activating	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Adjust the VOX sensitivity level in the monitor's menu.Ensure the camera's microphone is not obstructed.
Camera not responding to PTZ controls	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure the camera is powered on and properly paired.Check signal strength.Restart both the camera and monitor.




