1. INTRODUCTION

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AIPER Scuba SE is a cordless robotic pool cleaner designed for above-ground pools up to 860 sq. ft. It features powerful suction, a long-lasting battery, and smart auto-parking for convenient use.

3. SETUP

3.1 Charging the Device

Before initial use, fully charge your AIPER Scuba SE. A full charge typically takes 3-4 hours and provides up to 95 minutes of runtime.

1. Locate the charging port on the device.
2. Connect the provided charger to the device and a power outlet.
3. The LED indicator will show red during charging and turn green when fully charged.

3.2 Assembly

The AIPER Scuba SE comes pre-assembled for immediate use. Ensure the brushes are securely snapped into place on the underside of the unit.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Starting the Cleaning Cycle

1. Ensure the device is fully charged.
2. Press the one-click activation button located on the top of the device.
3. Gently lower the cleaner into your above-ground pool. It will sink to the bottom and begin its cleaning cycle automatically.

4.2 Smart Auto-Parking

When the battery level is low, the AIPER Scuba SE will automatically navigate to the nearest poolside wall and stop. This feature simplifies retrieval, ensuring you don't have to chase the cleaner across the pool.

4.3 Retrieval

Use the provided retrieval hook (or a standard pool pole with a hook attachment) to easily lift the cleaner out of the water. Allow excess water to drain before removing it completely from the pool area.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Filter

Regularly clean the filter tray to maintain optimal cleaning performance.

1. Open the cleaner's cover by releasing the latches.
2. Remove the filter tray.
3. Rinse the filter tray thoroughly with a hose to remove collected debris.
4. Reinsert the clean filter tray and close the cover securely.

5.2 Storage

After each use, ensure the cleaner is clean and dry before storing it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device not moving:** Ensure the battery is fully charged and the activation button has been pressed. Check for any obstructions in the wheels or suction inlet.
- **Poor cleaning performance:** Clean the filter tray. Ensure the pool water chemistry is balanced.
- **Device not charging:** Verify the charger is correctly connected to both the device and the power outlet. Check the charging indicator light.
