1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the AECOJOY 12' x 14' Outdoor Storage Shed. This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new storage shed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety and the safety of others are paramount. Always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully.
- Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves and eye protection, when handling heavy or sharp components.
- Ensure the shed is properly anchored to a level, stable ground surface to prevent tipping, especially in windy conditions.
- Do not exceed the weight limit or storage capacity of the shed. Distribute weight evenly.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Avoid assembling in strong winds or adverse weather conditions.
- Inspect all parts for damage before assembly. Do not use damaged parts.

3. PRE-ASSEMBLY CHECKLIST

Before starting assembly, ensure you have all necessary components and tools. The shed is typically packed in 3 boxes. Unpack all boxes and verify that all parts are present and undamaged against the parts list provided in your physical manual.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires at least two people. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in your physical manual. The following points highlight key aspects of the assembly process:

1. **Prepare the Foundation:** Ensure the chosen site is level and firm. A concrete slab or a treated timber foundation is recommended for optimal stability and longevity.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:** Connect the base rails according to the diagrams in your manual. Ensure the frame is square and level before proceeding.
3. **Install Wall Panels:** Attach the wall panels to the base frame, working from one corner. Secure each panel as instructed. Pay close attention to the orientation of panels.
4. **Reinforce with Pillars:** The shed features 4 pillars in each corner to provide additional support to the frame. Ensure these are correctly installed for enhanced stability.

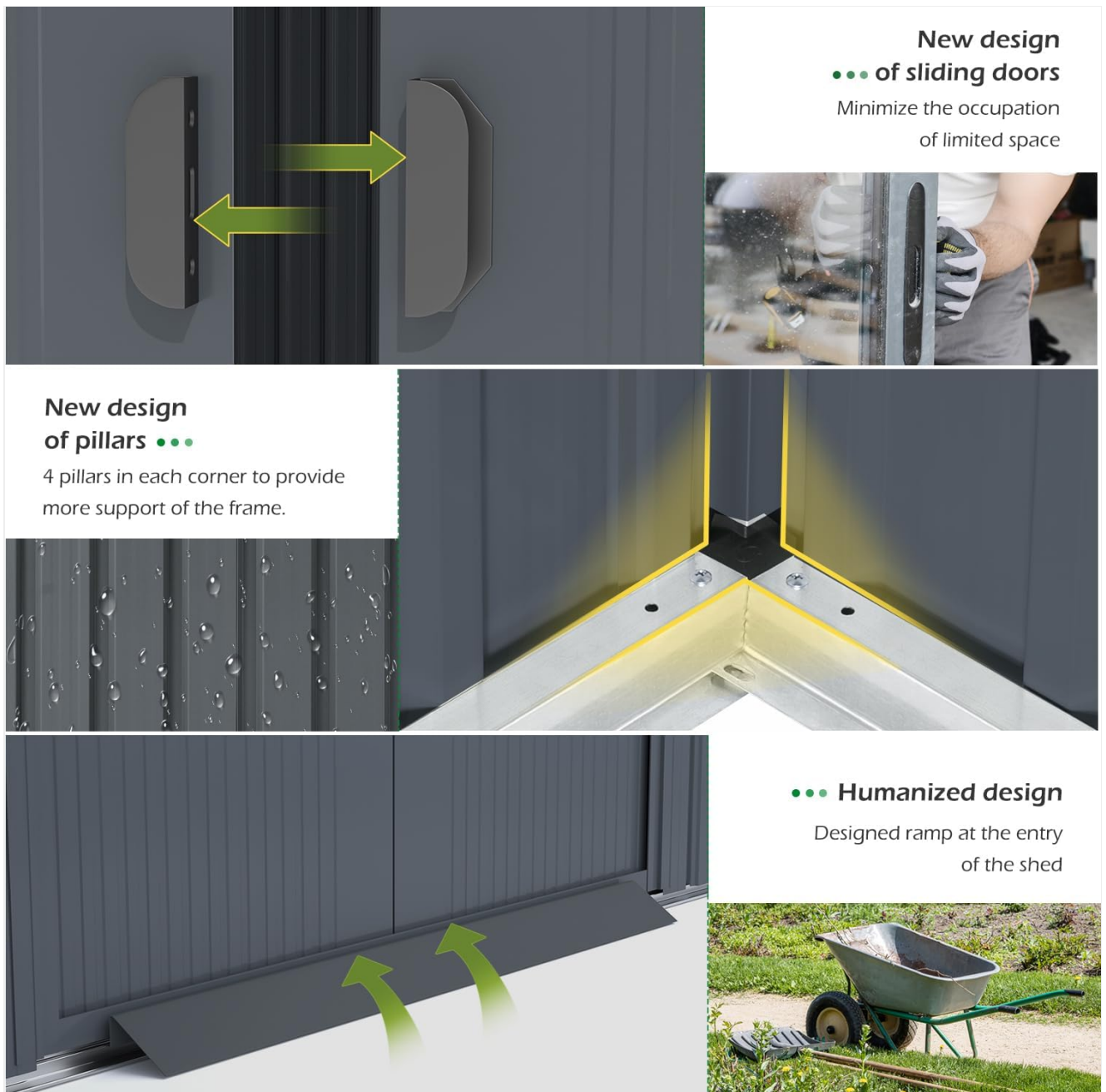


Image 3: Detail showing the reinforced corner pillars for structural support.

5. **Roof Assembly:** Construct the roof frame and attach the roof panels. Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened to prevent leaks and ensure structural integrity.
6. **Install Sliding Door:** Mount the sliding door mechanism and door panels. The sliding door design minimizes space requirements for opening.

7. **Attach Entry Ramp:** Install the designed ramp at the entry of the shed for easier access with wheeled equipment.

8. **Ventilation Installation:** Ensure the special design air vent windows are correctly installed for proper air fluidity inside the shed.

9. **Final Inspection:** Double-check all connections, screws, and anchors to ensure the shed is securely assembled and stable.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Sliding Door Operation:

The AECOJOY storage shed features a smooth-gliding sliding door designed for ease of use and space efficiency. To open, gently push the door along its track. To close, pull the door until it is fully shut. Ensure the door is properly aligned on its tracks for optimal performance. Avoid forcing the door if it encounters resistance.

Ventilation:

The integrated air vents promote air circulation within the shed, helping to reduce condensation and maintain a suitable environment for stored items. Ensure these vents remain unobstructed.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your AECOJOY storage shed:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the exterior of the shed periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the metal finish.
- **Door Tracks:** Keep the sliding door tracks clean and free of debris (leaves, dirt, etc.) to ensure smooth operation. Lubricate the tracks annually with a silicone-based spray if needed.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all screws, bolts, and anchors for tightness. Re-tighten any loose fasteners to maintain structural integrity.
- **Drainage:** Ensure that water drains away from the shed's base to prevent moisture buildup and potential corrosion.
- **Snow Removal:** In areas with heavy snowfall, remove excessive snow from the roof to prevent structural strain.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during or after assembly, consider the following common solutions:

- **Difficulty with Assembly / Misaligned Parts:**
Ensure all parts are correctly oriented as per the manual diagrams. Sometimes, slight adjustments or loosening adjacent fasteners can help align holes. If parts appear to be manufactured incorrectly or are damaged, contact customer support immediately for replacement parts or guidance. Do not force misaligned components, as this can cause damage.
- **Shed Leaning or Unstable:**
Verify that the foundation is perfectly level. Re-check all base frame connections and ensure the shed is properly anchored to the ground. Uneven ground is a common cause of instability.
- **Sliding Door Sticking:**
Inspect the door tracks for debris or obstructions. Clean the tracks thoroughly. Check if the door panels are correctly seated in the tracks and that the shed frame is square. Lubricate tracks if necessary.
- **Water Leaks:**
Ensure all roof panels are properly overlapped and all fasteners are tightened. Check for any gaps or damaged seals. Apply silicone sealant to problematic areas if needed.

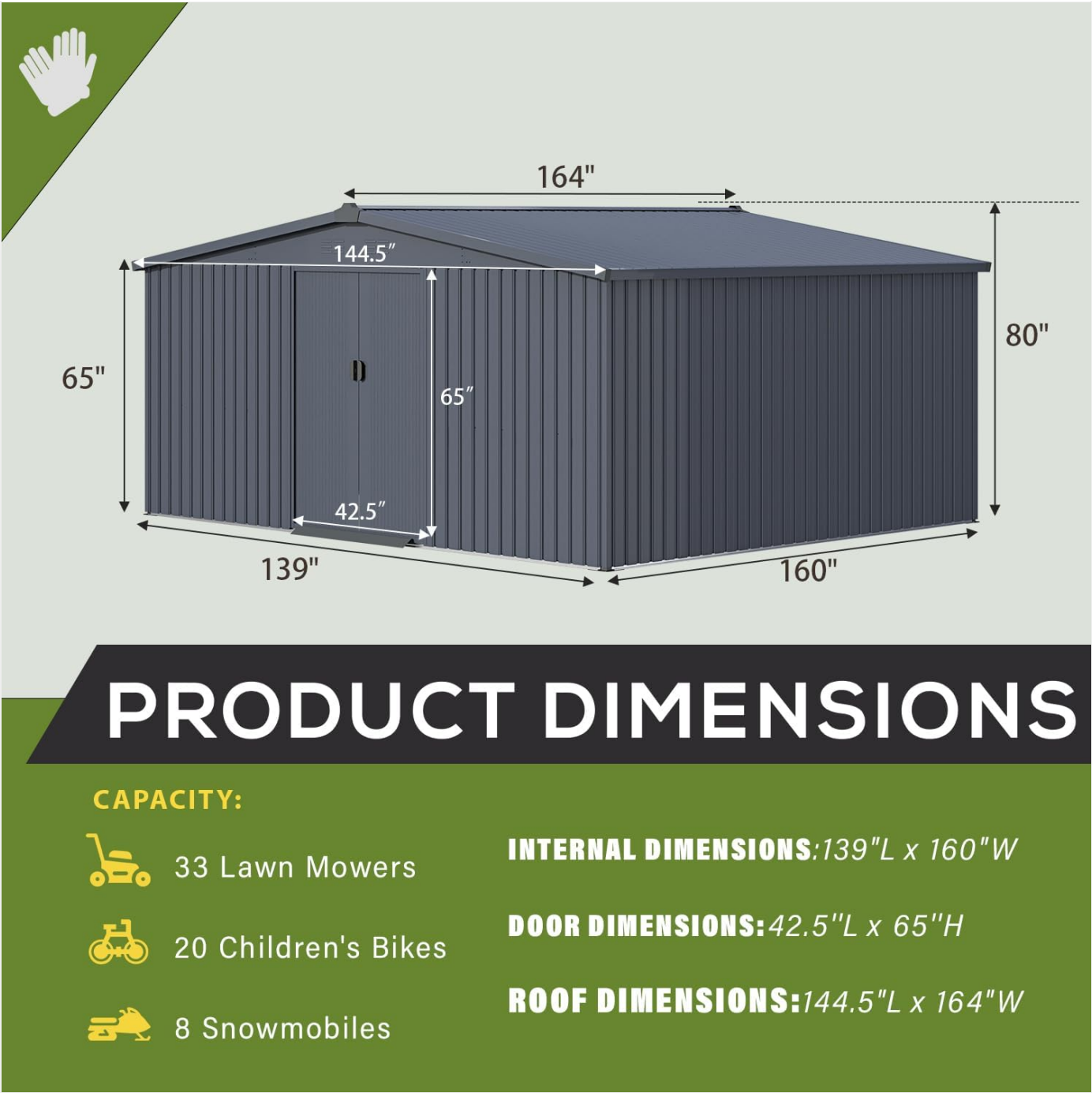


Image 7: Detailed product dimensions including internal, door, and roof measurements.
