Key features include:

- **Display Screen:** Shows recording status, time, battery level, and file information.
- **REC/SAVE Switch:** Slide up to start recording, slide down to save.
- **POWER Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off.
- **RESET Button:** Small pinhole button for factory reset if needed.
- **USB-C Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **Headphone Jack:** 3.5mm port for audio playback.
- **Integrated Clip:** For easy portability.

SETUP

1. Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the recorder. Connect the supplied USB-C cable to the device's USB-C port and the other end to a computer or a USB power adapter (not included).

- A full charge takes approximately **1.5 hours**.
- A fully charged device provides up to **20 hours** of continuous recording.
- The display will indicate charging status.

2. Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the **POWER** button until the screen illuminates.
- To power off: Press and hold the **POWER** button until the screen turns off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. One-Button Recording

The device features a simple slide switch for quick recording.

- To start recording: Slide the **REC/SAVE** switch upwards to the "REC" position. The device will begin recording immediately.
- To save recording: Slide the **REC/SAVE** switch downwards to the "SAVE" position. The current recording will be saved, and the device will stop recording.

2. AI Noise Reduction

The Vandlion V11B incorporates an advanced AI chip to enhance audio clarity by reducing background noise.

- This feature automatically identifies and minimizes distracting sounds, focusing on human speech.
- It is active during recording to provide high-fidelity voice capture.

Easy To Carry Around

3. Voice Activated Recording (VOR)

The Voice Activated Recording function allows the device to record only when sound is detected, conserving memory and battery life.

- To enable VOR: Access the device's menu by long pressing the **Play/Pause/Confirm** button when not recording, then navigate to the VOR settings. Set VOR to "ON".
- Once enabled, slide the **REC/SAVE** button to "REC". The recorder will start recording when sound above a set threshold (e.g., >65dB) is detected and pause when sound falls below the threshold (e.g., <65dB).

Voice Activated Recording

Set AVR to ON, switch to record button, and it will start recording when sound is detected

4. Playback

You can listen to your recordings directly from the device using headphones or by transferring files to a computer or Android phone.

- **Using Headphones:** Connect the included headphones to the 3.5mm jack. Use the control buttons (Vol+, Vol-, Previous, Next, Play/Pause/Confirm) on the headphone cable to navigate and play recordings.
- **Connecting to Computer/Phone:** Transfer files as described in the "File Management" section below.

5. Password Protection

To protect your recordings, you can set a 4-digit password.

- To set a password: Access the device's menu (long press the **Play/Pause/Confirm** button when not recording) and navigate to the "Password" settings. Follow the on-screen prompts to set your 4-digit code.
- Once enabled, the password will be required to access the device's files.

6. File Management and Transfer

Recordings are saved with timestamps for easy organization. You can transfer files to a computer (Windows/Mac) or an Android phone.

- Connect the device to your computer or Android phone using the supplied USB-C cable.
- The device will appear as a removable storage drive.
- You can then drag and drop recording files (MP3 or WAV format) to your desired location.
- **Note:** This device is not compatible with iPhones for direct file transfer.

MAINTENANCE

- Keep the device dry and away from extreme temperatures.
- Clean the device with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- Avoid dropping the device or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Regularly back up your recordings to prevent data loss.
- If the device becomes unresponsive, use a small pin to press the **RESET** button.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the device for at least 1.5 hours.
Cannot record.	Memory full; device frozen.	Transfer files to a computer to free up space. Press the RESET button.
Poor audio quality.	Microphone obstructed; excessive background noise.	Ensure microphone is clear. Use AI Noise Reduction in appropriate environments.
Cannot transfer files to iPhone.	Device is not compatible with iPhone for direct transfer.	Transfer files to a computer (Windows/Mac) or Android phone instead.
Forgot password.	Password lost.	Contact customer support for assistance. A factory reset might be required, which will erase all data.
