# Apple Pencil (1st Generation) Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

The Apple Pencil (1st Generation) is a versatile digital stylus designed for use with compatible iPad models. It offers precise input for drawing, note-taking, sketching, and document annotation. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Apple Pencil.

## SETUP

---

### Pairing with iPad

1. Ensure your iPad is updated to the latest iOS version.
2. Remove the cap from the Apple Pencil to reveal the Lightning connector.
3. Plug the Apple Pencil's Lightning connector into the Lightning port on your iPad.
4. A "Pair" button will appear on your iPad screen. Tap it to complete the pairing process.
5. For iPad (10th generation) users: Connect the Apple Pencil to the USB-C to Apple Pencil Adapter, then connect the adapter to your iPad's USB-C port. Tap "Pair" when prompted.

## OPERATING THE APPLE PENCIL

---

The Apple Pencil is designed to feel natural and responsive, similar to a traditional writing instrument. It features advanced technology for precise control.

### Key Features:

- **Pixel-Perfect Precision:** Enjoy accurate input for detailed work.
- **Tilt Sensitivity:** Tilt the Apple Pencil to create shading effects, just like a graphite pencil.
- **Pressure Sensitivity:** Apply more pressure to draw thicker lines or less pressure for finer strokes.
- **Palm Rejection:** Rest your hand on the iPad screen while using the Apple Pencil without interference.

## CHARGING

---

The Apple Pencil (1st Generation) charges directly from your iPad.

1. Remove the magnetic cap from the Apple Pencil.
2. Plug the exposed Lightning connector into the Lightning port on your iPad.
3. The Apple Pencil will begin charging. You can check the battery level in the Widgets view on your iPad.
4. For iPad (10th generation) users: Use the included USB-C to Apple Pencil Adapter. Connect the Apple Pencil to one end of the adapter and a USB-C charging cable to the other end. Then, connect the USB-C charging cable to your iPad or a power adapter.

## TIPS AND ACCESSORIES

The Apple Pencil comes with an extra tip for replacement. To replace the tip:

1. Gently unscrew the current tip from the Apple Pencil.
2. Screw on the new tip until it is secure. Do not overtighten.

The included USB-C to Apple Pencil Adapter is specifically for iPad (10th generation) to enable pairing and charging.

## COMPATIBILITY

The Apple Pencil (1st Generation) is compatible with the following iPad models:

- iPad (6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th generation)

- iPad Air (3rd generation)
- iPad mini (5th generation)
- iPad Pro 12.9-inch (1st & 2nd generation)
- iPad Pro 10.5-inch
- iPad Pro 9.7-inch

*Note: iPad (10th generation) requires the included USB-C to Apple Pencil Adapter for pairing and charging.*

## MAINTENANCE

- Keep the Apple Pencil clean by wiping it with a soft, lint-free cloth.
- Avoid exposing the Apple Pencil to extreme temperatures or liquids.
- Store the Apple Pencil safely to prevent damage to the tip or connector.
- Replace the tip if it becomes worn or damaged to maintain optimal performance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Pencil Not Pairing:

- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad.
- Plug the Apple Pencil firmly into your iPad's Lightning port (or via adapter for iPad 10th Gen).
- Restart your iPad and try pairing again.
- Check if the Apple Pencil has sufficient charge.

### Pencil Not Responding:

- Verify the Apple Pencil is charged.
- Ensure the tip is securely screwed on.
- Check if the Apple Pencil is still paired with your iPad in Bluetooth settings.
- Try using the Apple Pencil in a different compatible app.
