PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The LANDOT Automatic Rotating Curling Iron is designed for effortless hair styling, creating consistent curls with its automatic rotation feature. It incorporates ceramic tourmaline technology for reduced frizz and enhanced shine, along with multiple heat settings to suit various hair types.

SETUP

1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove the curling iron and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect the device for any signs of damage.
2. **Power Connection:** Plug the curling iron into a standard electrical outlet (100-240V compatible). Ensure the power cord is not twisted or damaged.
3. **Initial Heat-Up:** Press and hold the power button to turn on the device. The LED display will show the current temperature. Allow approximately 30 seconds for the device to reach the desired temperature.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for optimal curling results and safe operation:

1. **Prepare Hair:** Ensure hair is dry and detangled. For best results, divide hair into sections approximately 1 inch wide.

2. **Select Temperature:** Use the temperature control buttons to select the appropriate heat setting for your hair type.
 - 300°F - 340°F: Fine, delicate, or color-treated hair.
 - 350°F - 390°F: Normal or medium hair.
 - 400°F - 430°F: Thick or coarse hair.
3. **Position Hair:** Take a 1-inch section of hair and insert it into the curling chamber, ensuring the hair is fed straight through the groove up to the roots.
4. **Initiate Curl:** Press the rotation button (left or right, depending on desired curl direction). The curling iron will automatically wrap the hair around the barrel.
5. **Hold and Release:** Hold the button for approximately 8-10 seconds until you hear a beep. This indicates the curl is set. Release the button and gently pull the curling iron away from your hair.
6. **Repeat:** Continue with the remaining sections of hair. Allow curls to cool completely before styling for longer-lasting results.

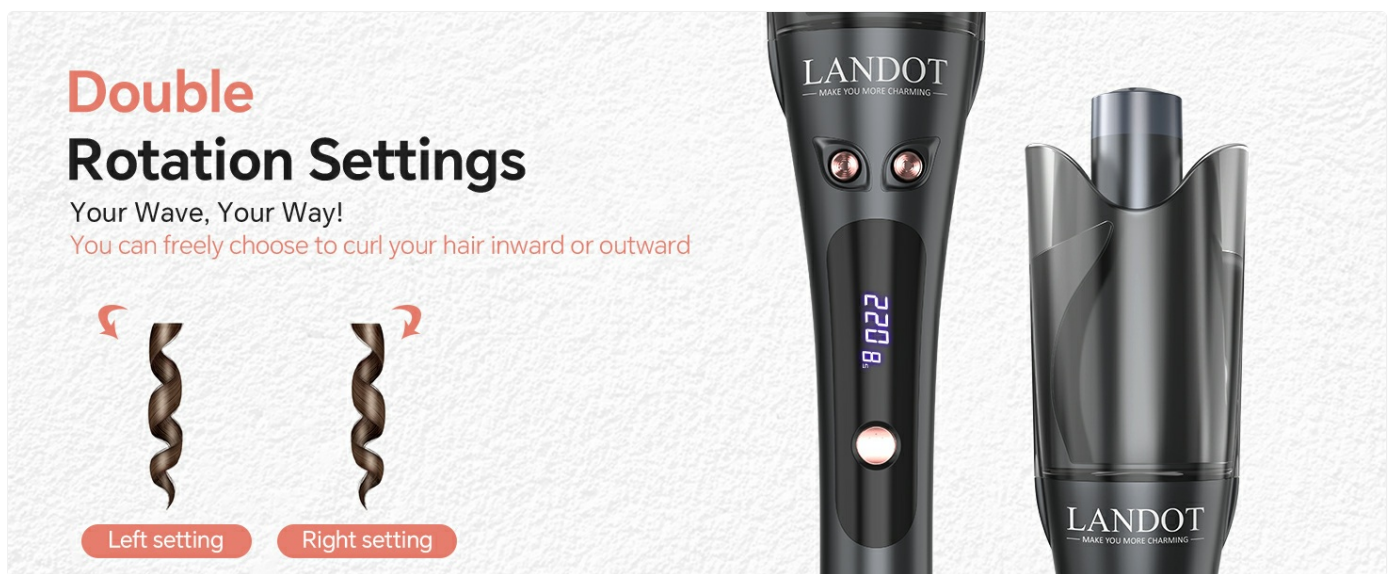


Image: Step-by-step guide on how to insert hair, rotate, hold, and release for curling.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Not properly plugged in; power outlet issue.	Check power connection. Try a different outlet.
Hair gets tangled in the chamber.	Section of hair is too large; hair is not detangled.	Use smaller sections (max 1 inch). Ensure hair is combed through before curling.
Curls are not holding.	Incorrect temperature setting; insufficient holding time; hair not fully dry.	Increase temperature (if hair type allows). Hold for the full 8-10 seconds. Ensure hair is completely dry.
Device is not heating up.	Power issue; internal malfunction.	Verify power connection. If problem persists, contact customer support.
