2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MTYBBYH S25 headphones are designed for versatile use, featuring IPX8 waterproofing, an integrated 32GB MP3 player, and Bluetooth 5.2 connectivity. They offer a secure fit for various activities, including swimming and sports.

3. CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

Before initial use, fully charge the headphones. Ensure the charging contacts are clean and dry.

1. Connect the magnetic end of the USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall

adapter).

3. The indicator light will show charging status (refer to product specific light indicators if available, otherwise assume standard).
4. A full charge typically takes approximately 1.5 to 2 hours.

4. WEARING THE HEADPHONES

Proper fit is crucial for both sound quality and waterproof performance.

1. **Select Ear Tips:** Choose the appropriate ear tips. Use the dual-layer swim earbuds for water activities to create a waterproof seal. For land use, the single-layer earbuds offer comfort.
2. **Positioning:** Place the ear hooks over your ears. Gently insert the earbuds into your ear canals, ensuring a snug and comfortable fit.
3. **For Swimming:** To enhance the waterproof seal and secure the headphones, it is recommended to wear a swim cap over your ears and the headphones.

5. OPERATING MODES

The MTYBBYH S25 headphones support two primary operating modes: Bluetooth for land use and MP3 for underwater use.

5.1 Bluetooth Mode (For Land Use)

Bluetooth mode allows wireless connection to your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth-enabled devices.

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light flashes (usually blue/red alternately) to indicate pairing mode.
2. **Pairing:** On your device, enable Bluetooth and search for "MTYBBYH S25". Select it to connect. Once connected, the indicator light will typically show a steady blue light or flash slowly.
3. **Controls:** Use the integrated buttons on the headphones for playback control (Play/Pause, Volume Up/Down, Next/Previous Track) and call management.

Important: Bluetooth signals do not transmit effectively underwater. Always switch to MP3 mode for swimming or diving.

5.2 MP3 Mode (For Underwater Use)

The built-in 32GB MP3 player allows you to enjoy music without a connected device, ideal for underwater activities.

1. Transferring Music:

- Connect the headphones to your computer using the USB magnetic charging cable.
- The headphones will appear as a removable disk drive.
- Drag and drop your MP3, WMA, APE, or FLAC audio files directly into the headphone's storage.
- Safely eject the device from your computer before disconnecting the cable.

2. **Switching to MP3 Mode:** (Specific button press or sequence to switch modes, e.g., double-press the Power/Mode button). Refer to the quick start guide for exact button functions.

3. **Controls:** Use the integrated buttons for playback control (Play/Pause, Volume Up/Down, Next/Previous Track).



6. WATERPROOF USAGE GUIDELINES

The MTYBBYH S25 headphones are IPX8 rated, making them suitable for swimming and other water sports. Follow these guidelines for optimal performance and longevity.

1. **Activate MP3 Mode:** Always ensure the headphones are in MP3 mode before entering the water. Bluetooth connectivity is not effective underwater.
2. **Secure Fit:** Use the dual-layer swim ear tips and ensure they form a tight seal in your ear canals. Wearing a swim cap over the headphones can provide additional security and seal.
3. **Depth and Duration:** The headphones can withstand submersion up to 8 meters (26 feet) for a maximum of 6 hours. Avoid exceeding these limits.
4. **Post-Swim Care:** After use in chlorinated water, saltwater, or sweat, rinse the headphones thoroughly with clean fresh water. Allow them to air dry completely before charging or storing.

IPX8 Top Waterproof Rating

With an IPX8 waterproof rating, Mtybbyh S25 can withstand submersion in up to 8 meters of water for up to 6 hours, allowing you to enjoy your music while swimming.

Before swimming, please disconnect Bluetooth connection and switch to MP3 mode.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Charging Port:** Keep the magnetic charging contacts clean and free of debris to ensure reliable charging.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your MTYBBYH S25 headphones, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Headphones not in pairing mode; out of range; already connected to another device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode. Move closer to your device. Disconnect from any other paired devices.
No sound in MP3 mode.	No music files transferred; incompatible file format; low volume.	Transfer compatible audio files (MP3/WMA/APE/FLAC). Increase volume.
Poor sound quality or water leakage during swimming.	Improper ear tip size; ear tips not sealed correctly; not in MP3 mode.	Ensure you are using dual-layer swim ear tips. Adjust ear tips for a secure, waterproof seal. Confirm headphones are in MP3 mode.
Headphones not recognized by computer.	Faulty cable; dirty charging contacts; driver issue.	Try a different USB port or cable. Clean charging contacts. Restart computer.
