1. INTRODUCTION

9. **Security Setup:** Set up a screen lock (PIN, pattern, password, fingerprint, or face recognition) for device security.
10. **Complete Setup:** Follow the remaining on-screen prompts to finalize your setup.

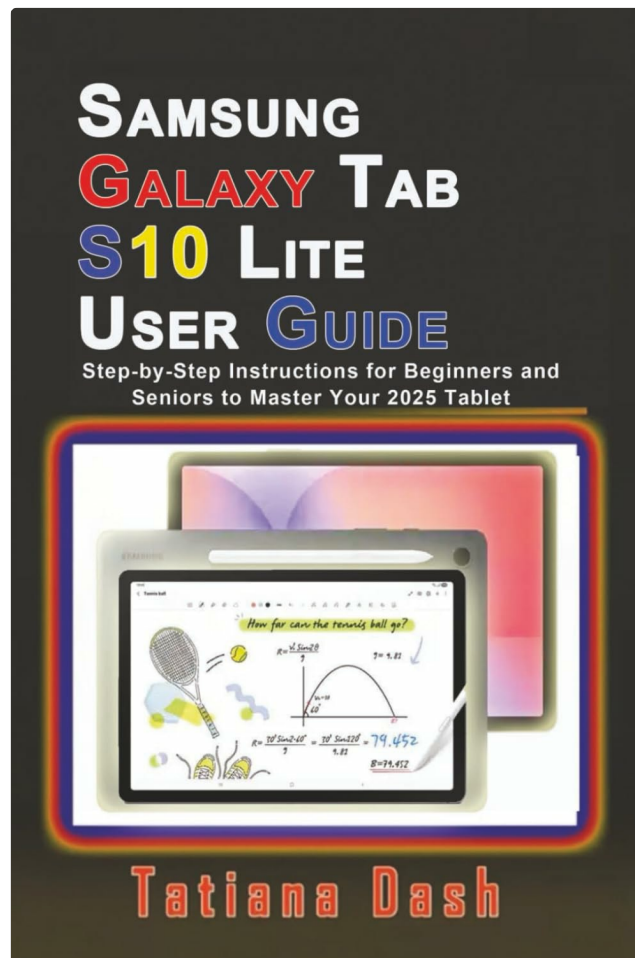


Figure 2.1: An illustrative image of the Samsung Galaxy Tab S10 Lite, as depicted on the cover of its user guide, showing the device's display and S Pen.

2.3 Inserting SIM and MicroSD Cards

If your model supports cellular connectivity and expandable storage:

1. Locate the SIM/microSD card tray on the side of your tablet.
2. Insert the ejection pin into the small hole next to the tray to open it.
3. Place the Nano-SIM card and/or microSD card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down, ensuring they are correctly oriented.
4. Gently push the tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.

- **Translate:** Hover the S Pen over text to translate words or phrases.
- **S Pen to Text:** Convert your handwritten notes into digital text.

- **Wi-Fi/Bluetooth Connectivity Issues:** Toggle Wi-Fi/Bluetooth off and on, restart the tablet, or reset network settings in the Settings app.
- **Apps Crashing:** Clear the app's cache and data in Settings > Apps, or reinstall the app. Ensure your tablet's software is up to date.

8.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to Settings > Software update > Download and install.
