1. INTRODUCTION

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the charger from its packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check the charger and cable for any visible damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Connect to Vacuum:** Insert the barrel round connector of the charger cable into the charging port of your XenonLab W750 Cordless Stick Vacuum.
4. **Connect to Power Outlet:** Plug the AC adapter into a standard 100-240V AC, 50/60Hz wall outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once properly connected, the charger will begin supplying power to your XenonLab W750 Cordless Stick Vacuum. The vacuum's indicator lights (if present) will typically show the charging status.

- Allow the vacuum to charge fully before its first use or after extended periods of non-use.
- Charging times may vary depending on the battery's current charge level and condition.
- The charger is designed to prevent overcharging, but it is good practice to disconnect the vacuum once fully charged.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Heat Dissipation:** The charger incorporates pure copper plates for efficient heat dissipation. Ensure adequate ventilation around the charger during use.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Charger not working / Vacuum not charging	Loose connection, power outlet issue, damaged charger/cable	Ensure all connections are secure. Test the power outlet with another device. Inspect the charger and cable for damage. If damaged, discontinue use and replace.
Charger feels hot during use	Normal operation, poor ventilation, excessive load	A slight warmth is normal. Ensure the charger is in a well-ventilated area. If it becomes excessively hot, disconnect immediately and contact support.
