# Casio Edifice EFV160D Series Analog Watch Instruction Manual

Model: EFV160D-1AV

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the Casio Edifice EFV160D Series analog watch. This timepiece features a three-hand display, a date indicator, and 100-meter water resistance. It is designed for reliable timekeeping and durability, suitable for various daily activities.

## SETUP

---

### Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown out to the **second click** position.
2. Rotate the crown to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
3. Push the crown back in to the **normal position** to start timekeeping.

### Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown out to the **first click** position.
2. Rotate the crown to adjust the date.

3. Push the crown back in to the **normal position**.

**Note:** Avoid setting the date between 9:00 PM and 1:00 AM, as this may interfere with the automatic date change mechanism.

## OPERATING

---

### Timekeeping

The watch displays hours, minutes, and seconds using three central hands.

### Date Display

The current date is shown in a dedicated window located at the 3 o'clock position on the dial.

### Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant up to 100 meters (10 ATM). This rating makes it suitable for swimming, snorkeling, and general water activities. It is **not** suitable for scuba diving. Ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water. Do not operate the crown or any buttons while the watch is wet.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by an SR920SW battery, which has an approximate life of 3 years. When the watch stops or the second hand moves erratically, the battery may need replacement. It is recommended that battery replacement be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

### Cleaning

- **Case and Crystal:** Wipe regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Stainless Steel Band:** Clean with a soft brush and a mild soap solution. Rinse thoroughly under running water and dry completely with a soft cloth.

### Care Precautions

- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures (above 60°C / 140°F or below -10°C / 14°F).
- Keep the watch away from strong magnetic fields, as they can affect timekeeping accuracy.
- Avoid contact with harsh chemicals, solvents, or detergents, which can damage the case, band, or seals.
- Do not subject the watch to strong impacts.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Watch is not running.	Ensure the crown is fully pushed in. If the watch still does not run, the battery may need replacement.
Date changes at noon instead of midnight.	The AM/PM setting is incorrect. Advance the time by 12 hours.
Condensation or water inside the watch.	Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center for inspection and repair to prevent further damage.
Timekeeping is inaccurate.	Check for exposure to strong magnetic fields. If the issue persists, the watch may require servicing.
