Garvee Stainless Steel Utility Sink Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Garvee Stainless Steel Utility Sink. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient installation, operation, and maintenance of your new utility sink. Please read these instructions thoroughly before assembly and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all connections are secure and leak-free to prevent water damage.
- Do not overload the sink or undershelf beyond their weight capacity.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before beginning assembly.

- Stainless Steel Sink Bowl and Drainboard Unit
- Legs (4 pieces)
- Undershelf
- Hot and Cold Faucet
- Drain Assembly (including filter basket and pipes)
- Mounting Hardware and Tools (wrenches, screws)

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage during transit. Report any missing or damaged parts to the retailer immediately.

2. Assembling the Frame

Attach the four legs to the main sink unit using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are tightened securely for stability. Install the undershelf at the desired height on the legs, securing it firmly.

3. Faucet Installation

Mount the hot and cold faucet onto the designated hole on the sink unit. Connect the hot and cold water supply lines to the faucet inlets. Use thread seal tape on all threaded connections to prevent leaks. Tighten connections firmly but do not overtighten.

4. Drain Assembly

Install the drain assembly into the sink bowl. Ensure the rubber gaskets are correctly seated to create a watertight seal. Connect the flexible drain pipe to the drain outlet and direct it to a suitable waste disposal system. The removable filter basket should be placed inside the drain opening.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

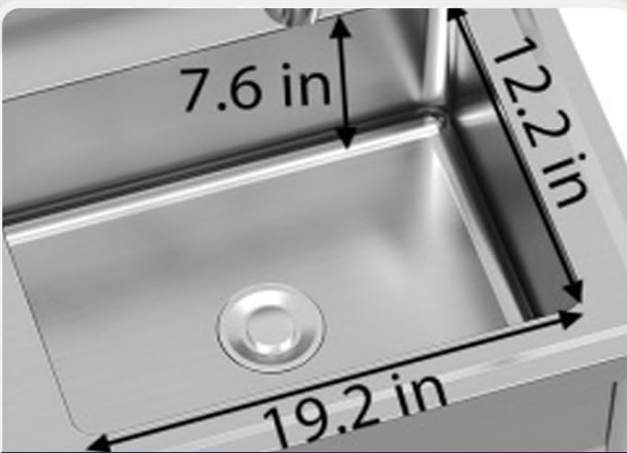

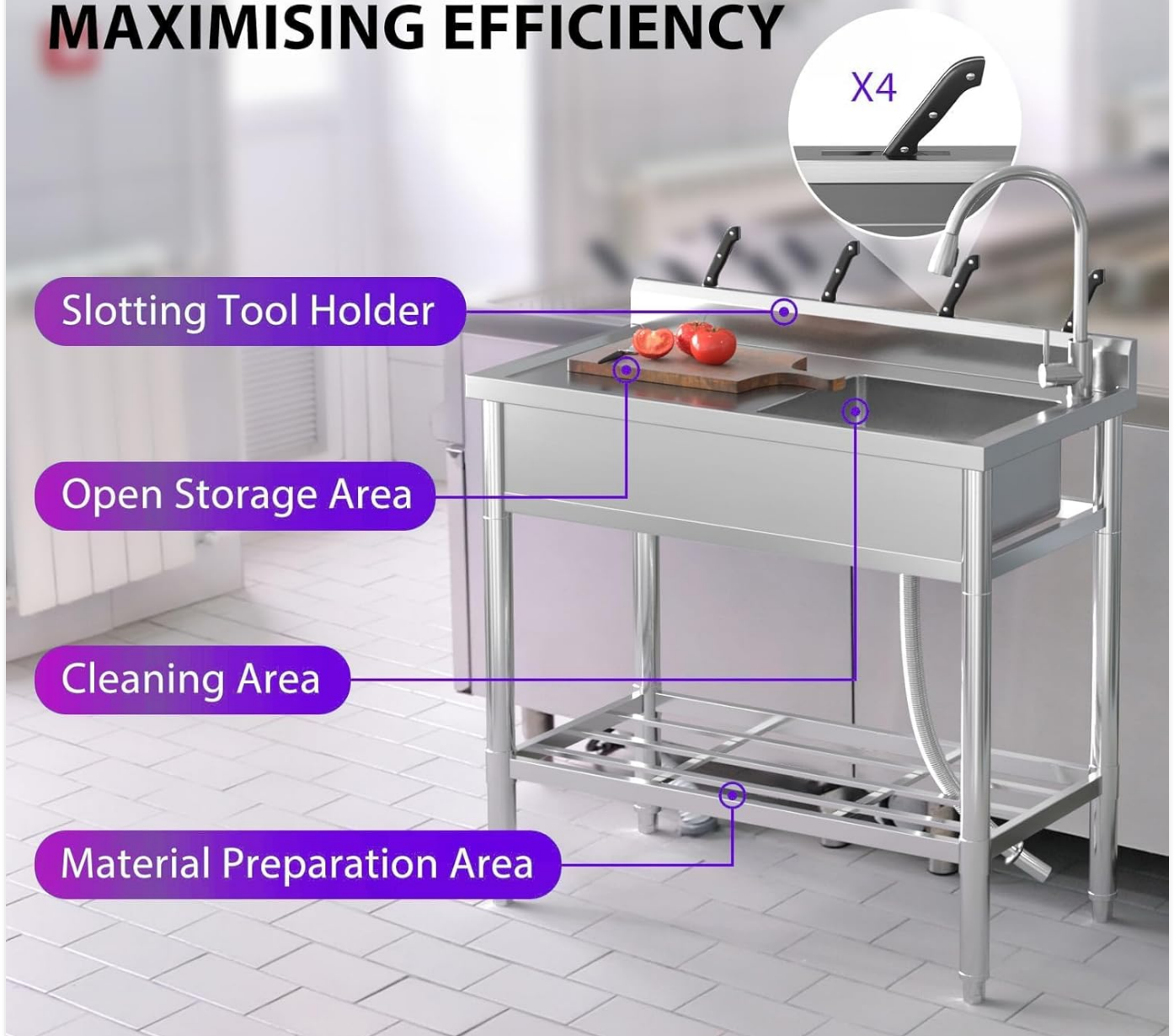

MULTIPLE FUNCTIONS IN ONE MAXIMISING EFFICIENCY

MAINTENANCE

1. Daily Cleaning

Clean the sink and drainboard regularly with a mild detergent and a soft cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly with water and dry to prevent water spots. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that can scratch the stainless steel surface.

2. Drain Filter Maintenance

Remove and empty the filter basket daily or as needed. Wash it with soap and water to remove any accumulated debris or grease. This prevents clogs and ensures proper drainage.

3. Preventing Stains and Rust

Although made of rust-resistant 304 stainless steel, prolonged contact with highly acidic foods, harsh chemicals, or iron-

containing objects can cause discoloration or surface rust. Rinse the sink immediately after contact with such substances. For stubborn stains, use a stainless steel cleaner according to the product instructions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage from Faucet or Connections	Loose connections, worn gaskets, improper sealing.	Tighten all connections. Check and replace any worn gaskets. Ensure thread seal tape was used correctly.
Slow Drainage	Clogged filter basket, obstruction in drain pipe.	Remove and clean the filter basket. Inspect the drain pipe for blockages and clear if necessary.
Sink Wobbles	Uneven floor, loose leg connections.	Adjust the leveling feet on the legs if available. Tighten all leg attachment bolts. Ensure the sink is on a flat, stable surface.
Surface Discoloration/Rust Spots	Exposure to harsh chemicals, acidic substances, or iron particles.	Clean immediately with a stainless steel cleaner. Avoid prolonged contact with corrosive materials.
