Electactic Countertop Ice Cube Maker Machine Z5813AF User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Electactic Countertop Ice Cube Maker Machine. This appliance is designed to provide a convenient and efficient way to produce ice cubes for various uses. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the machine to ensure safe and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow basic safety precautions when using this appliance:

- Read all instructions before use.

- Ensure the power outlet voltage matches the appliance's requirements.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep the appliance away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Always unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Use only potable water in the ice maker.
- Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2 hours before plugging in to allow the refrigerant fluid to settle.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Fast & Efficient Ice Making:** Produces 16 ice cubes in approximately 5 minutes, with a daily capacity of up to 34 lbs. Includes a 1.65 lbs ice basket.
- **Two Convenient Water Fill Options:** Features a 1.5L external removable water tank and a 0.5L top-opening reservoir for flexible water addition.
- **Simple & User-Friendly Operation:** Equipped with three intuitive mechanical buttons and bright indicator lights for 'ice full' and 'water needed' alerts. Operating noise is below 45dB.
- **Perfect Hard & Slow-Melting Cube Ice:** Produces clear, classic square ice cubes (5-10g/pcs) that melt slowly to prevent beverage dilution.
- **24-Hour Timer Function:** Allows scheduling of ice production to start or stop at desired times, optimizing energy use.

4. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The package includes:

- Electactic Countertop Ice Cube Maker Machine
- Ice Scoop

5. SETUP

5.1 Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging.
2. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
3. Allow the ice maker to stand upright for at least 2 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant fluid to settle, ensuring proper operation.

5.2 Initial Cleaning

1. Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker with a mild detergent solution and warm water.
2. Rinse the interior parts thoroughly with clean water.
3. Drain the water by unplugging the drain cap located on the front bottom side.
4. Dry the interior completely with a soft cloth.

5.3 Adding Water

The ice maker offers two ways to add water:

- **External Water Tank:** Fill the 1.5L external removable water tank and place it securely on top of the unit.
- **Built-in Reservoir:** Open the top lid and pour water directly into the 0.5L built-in reservoir. Ensure water level does not exceed the MAX fill line.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Powering On and Ice Production

1. Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Press the **ON/OFF** button to start the ice production cycle. The machine will begin making ice automatically.

3. The display panel will show the estimated time remaining for the current ice-making cycle.

6.2 Adjusting Ice Cube Thickness

Use the + and - buttons on the control panel to adjust the thickness of the ice cubes. Thicker cubes take longer to produce but melt slower.

6.3 Indicator Lights

- **ICE FULL:** A light will illuminate when the ice basket is full. The machine will pause production until ice is removed.
- **ADD WATER:** A light will illuminate when the water reservoir is low. Refill the water tank to resume ice production.

6.4 24-Hour Timer

To set the timer, press the **Timer** button and use the **+** and **-** buttons to set the desired ON/OFF time. This allows you to schedule ice production in advance.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

7.1 Auto-Cleaning Function

The ice maker features a built-in auto-cleaning mode:

1. Ensure the unit is empty of ice and water.
2. Add clean water to the reservoir.
3. Press and hold the "+" button for 5 seconds to activate the auto-cleaning cycle.
4. The cleaning process will take approximately 20 minutes.
5. Once complete, drain the water and dry the interior.

7.2 Regular Cleaning

- Regularly clean the exterior of the ice maker with a mild detergent solution and a soft cloth.
- Descaling: If you live in an area with hard water, descale your ice maker once a month or more frequently. Refer to the user manual for specific descaling instructions.
- When the machine is not to be used for a long time, drain the water completely and dry the interior.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If the ice maker is not functioning correctly, please check the following common issues before contacting support:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- **No Ice Production:** Check if the water reservoir is filled and if the 'ADD WATER' indicator is off. Ensure the ambient temperature is within the recommended operating range.
- **Ice Not Forming Properly:** Verify that the water temperature is appropriate (cold water is recommended). Ensure the unit has proper ventilation.

- **'ICE FULL' Indicator On, but Basket Not Full:** The ice sensor might be obstructed. Clean the sensor area.
