INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all items listed in the package contents are present and undamaged. If any items are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

2. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the flashlight's internal rechargeable battery. Connect the provided charging cable to the flashlight's charging port and plug the other end into a compatible USB power source. The charging indicator light will typically show red during charging and turn green when fully charged. Charging time may vary.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

Press the power button located on the flashlight body to turn the flashlight on. Press the button again to

cycle through different light modes or to turn it off, depending on the model's specific sequence.

2. Mode Selection

The XP14R typically features multiple light modes. With the flashlight on, press the power button repeatedly to cycle through modes such as High, Medium, Low, and Strobe. Some models may include a momentary on function by lightly pressing the button without fully clicking.

3. Focusing (Pure Beam Focusing Optic)

The XP14R features a Pure Beam Focusing Optic. To adjust the beam from a broad floodlight to a focused spot beam, grasp the head of the flashlight and slide it forward or backward. This allows for versatile illumination depending on your needs.

4. Recharging the Battery

When the battery level is low, the flashlight's performance may diminish. To recharge, connect the flashlight to a USB power source using the supplied cable. Ensure the charging port is clean and dry before connecting. Do not attempt to charge with incompatible chargers.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

Wipe the flashlight's exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the finish or internal components. Keep the lens clean for optimal light output.

2. Battery Care

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently to prolong its lifespan.
- Store the flashlight with a partial charge if it will not be used for an extended period.
- Do not expose the battery to extreme temperatures.

3. Storage

Store the flashlight in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and corrosive materials. Ensure the flashlight is turned off to prevent accidental activation and battery drain.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Flashlight does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Recharge the battery fully.
Light is dim or flickers.	Low battery charge.	Recharge the battery.
Flashlight not charging.	Charging cable or adapter issue; dirty charging port.	Ensure cable and adapter are functional. Clean charging port gently. Try a different USB power source.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Beam adjustment is stiff.	Dirt or debris in the focusing mechanism.	Gently clean the exterior of the focusing mechanism. Do not force movement.
