INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your Skeleton Keychain. Designed for durability and style, this zinc alloy keychain features a unique skeleton design and a secure lobster claw clasp, perfect for attaching to backpacks, keys, or other items.

SETUP

The Skeleton Keychain is designed for immediate use. No assembly is required.

- Identify Attachment Point:** Choose a secure loop, ring, or zipper pull on your backpack, keys, or desired item.
- Open the Clasp:** Gently press the lever on the lobster claw clasp to open the gate.
- Attach Keychain:** Hook the open clasp onto your chosen attachment point.
- Secure the Clasp:** Release the lever to allow the gate to close securely. Ensure the clasp is fully closed before use.

OPERATING THE CLASP

The keychain features a spring-loaded lobster claw clasp for easy attachment and detachment.

- To open, gently push the small lever on the side of the clasp. This will open the gate.
- To close, simply release the lever. The spring mechanism will automatically close the gate, securing the keychain.
- Always ensure the clasp is fully closed to prevent accidental detachment.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Skeleton Keychain, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the keychain with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and fingerprints. For more stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can

damage the finish of the zinc alloy.

- **Storage:** Store the keychain in a dry place when not in use to prevent tarnishing or damage.
- **Avoid Excessive Force:** Do not apply excessive force to the skeleton figure or the clasp, as this may cause bending or breakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Skeleton Keychain, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Clasp Not Closing Properly:**

Check for any debris or foreign objects obstructing the clasp mechanism. Gently clear any obstructions.

If the spring mechanism feels loose, avoid forcing it and consider replacing the keychain if functionality is compromised.

- **Keychain Appears Dull or Tarnished:**

Clean the keychain as described in the "Maintenance" section. Regular cleaning can restore its luster.

Tarnishing is a natural process for some metals and can often be reduced with proper care.
