1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Gearwiz Pro Steam Station Iron. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Always ensure the appliance is connected to a grounded outlet.
- Do not immerse the iron or base unit in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the iron from the electrical outlet when filling with water, emptying, or when not in use.
- Do not operate the iron with a damaged cord or if the appliance has been dropped or damaged. Contact customer support for repair.
- Keep the iron and its cord out of reach of children.
- Use the iron only for its intended purpose as described in this manual.
- Exercise caution when handling hot parts, hot water, or steam. Burns can occur from touching hot metal parts, hot water, or steam.
- Never direct steam towards people or pets.
- The iron features an **Auto Shutoff** function, which activates after 10 minutes of inactivity for added safety.

2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Gearwiz Pro Steam Station Iron:

- **Diamond-Coated Ceramic Soleplate:** Provides smooth gliding and even heat distribution.
- **Detachable Water Tank (1.2L):** Easy to fill and provides ample capacity for extended use.
- **Smart LED Screen:** Displays current settings and status.
- **Power Cord (6.6ft):** Connects the unit to the electrical outlet.
- **Silicone Steam Hose (5.6ft):** Connects the iron head to the base unit.
- **Strong Hanger:** For convenient storage or steaming garments while hanging.
- **Power Button:** To turn the unit on or off.

- **Steam & Dry Switch Button:** Toggles between steam and dry ironing modes.
- **90° Rotatable Head:** Allows for flexible use as an iron or steamer.
- **Secure Lock System:** Keeps the iron head securely attached to the base.
- **Heat-Safe Base:** Provides a safe resting place for the hot iron head.
- **Built-In Water Filter:** Filters impurities for cleaner steam and extended performance.

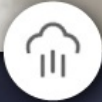

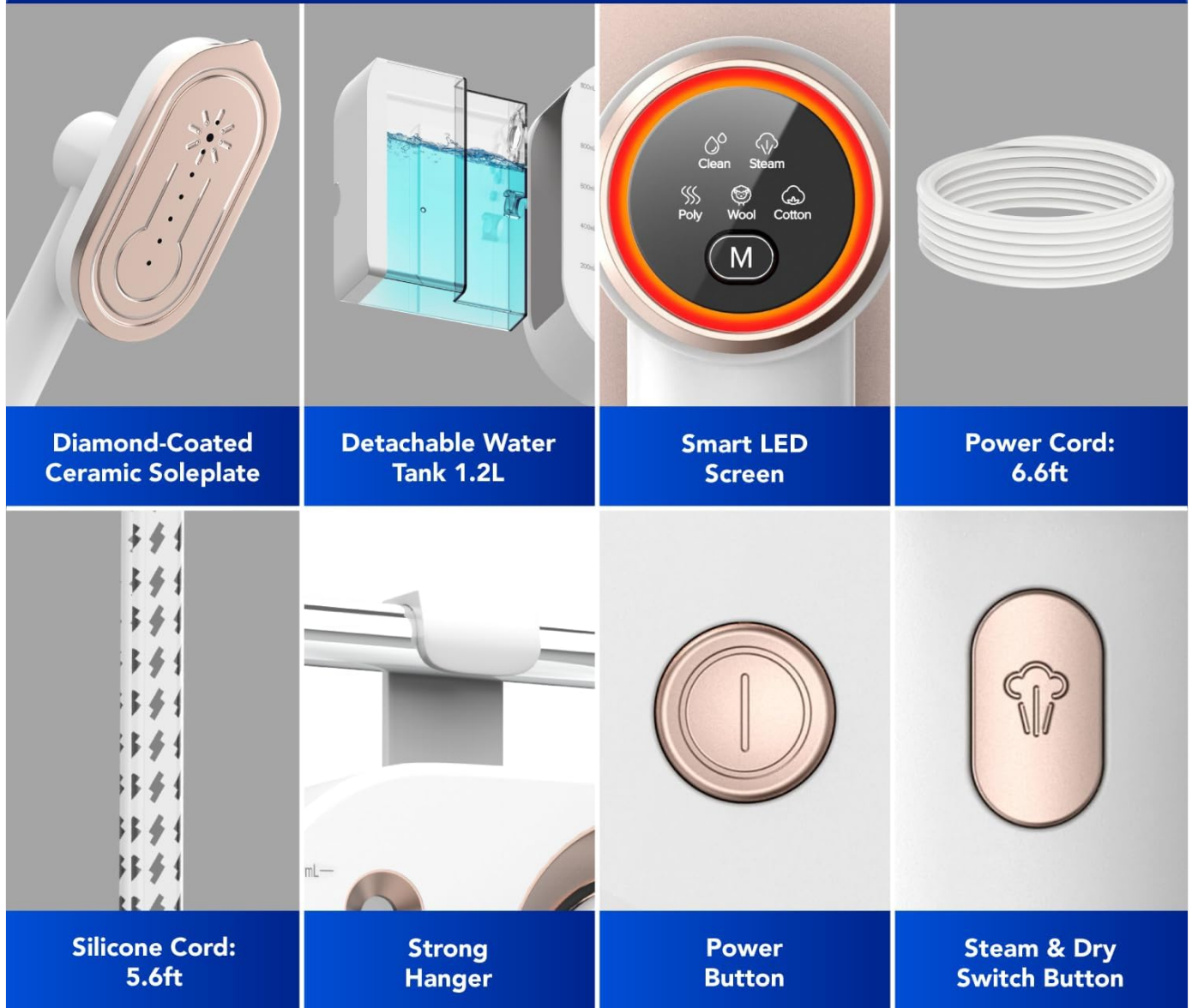

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Filling the Water Tank

1. Ensure the iron is unplugged and cool.
2. Remove the 1.2L detachable water tank from the base unit.
3. Fill the tank with distilled or demineralized water to prevent mineral buildup. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.
4. Securely reinsert the water tank into the base unit until it clicks into place.

3.2 Mounting Options

The Gearwiz Pro Steam Station Iron offers flexible mounting for convenience:

- **Wall-Mounted Storage:** Use the provided hardware to mount the base unit on a wall. Ensure it is secured to a stud or using appropriate anchors.
- **Flexible Hook:** Utilize the integrated hook to hang the unit on a door or closet rod.
- **Ironing Board Setup:** Place the unit flat on a stable surface, such as an ironing board.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On and Heating

1. Ensure the water tank is filled and the iron head is securely placed in the base or held.
2. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
3. Press the **Power Button** to turn on the unit. The LED screen will illuminate.
4. The iron will heat up in approximately 60 seconds. The LED indicators will show when it is ready for use.

4.2 Selecting Ironing Mode and Temperature

The iron features an **AI Temp Control Chip** for consistent performance and offers a custom heat range of 239°F-311°F.

- Use the controls on the LED screen to select the desired temperature setting based on fabric type (e.g., Polyester Fiber, Wool Nylon, Cotton Denim).
- Press the **Steam & Dry Switch Button** to toggle between dry ironing and steam modes.

4.3 Steam Modes

The iron offers three steam levels for various fabric needs:

- **Small Gear Steam (20g/min):** Suitable for delicate fabrics like Polyester Fiber.
- **Mid-range Steam (30g/min):** Ideal for fabrics such as Wool Nylon.
- **Large Steam (40g/min):** Recommended for heavier fabrics like Cotton Denim.

4.4 Using the 90° Rotatable Head

The iron head can rotate 90 degrees for flexible use as a traditional iron or a handheld steamer.

- To adjust the head angle, ensure the unit is cool and unplugged. Rotate the head to the desired position.
- For ironing, place garments on an ironing board. For steaming, hang garments on a hanger.

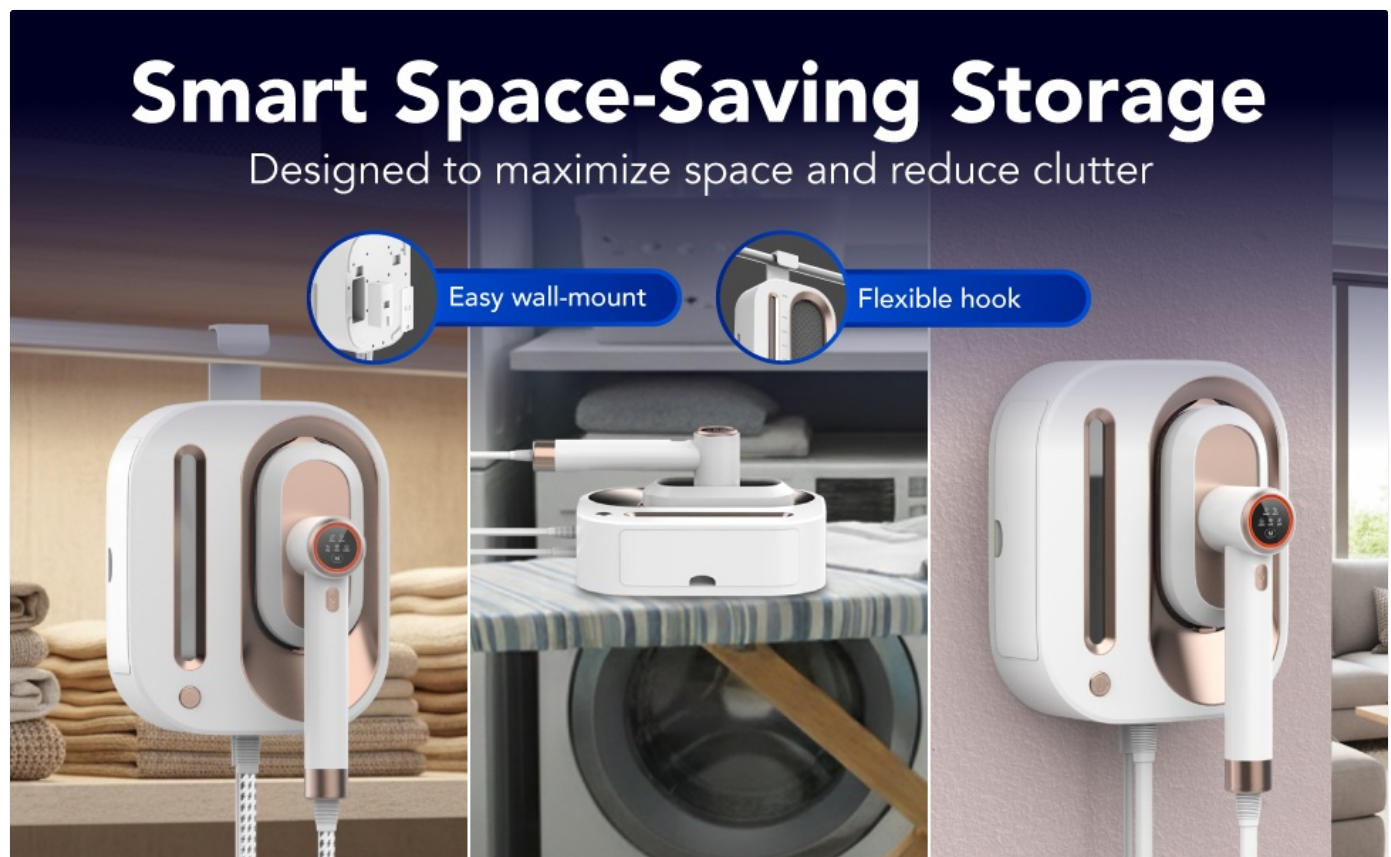

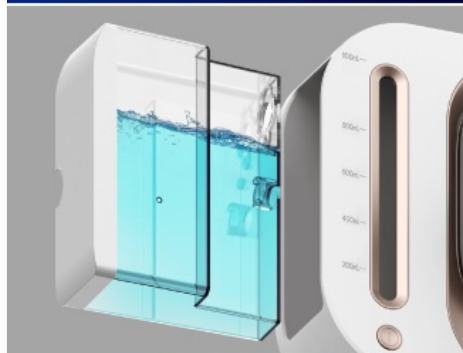

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

5.1 Self-Clean Function

The iron features a 2-way anti-scale system with a built-in water filter and a self-clean function to ensure cleaner steam and longer-lasting performance.

1. Ensure the water tank is filled.
2. Turn on the iron and allow it to heat up.
3. Hold the **M button** on the control panel to activate the self-cleaning cycle. This helps reduce mineral buildup and extends the lifespan of your steamer.

5.2 General Cleaning

- Always unplug the iron and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the iron and base unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Clean the soleplate with a damp cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner if necessary.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank after each use to prevent stagnant water and mineral buildup.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam produced	Water tank empty; Iron not heated sufficiently; Steam button not pressed.	Fill water tank; Allow iron to heat up (approx. 60 seconds); Press the steam button.
Water leaking from soleplate	Temperature too low for steam; Overfilled water tank; Mineral buildup.	Increase temperature setting; Do not overfill tank; Perform self-clean function.
Iron not heating	Not plugged in; Power button not pressed; Auto shutoff activated.	Check power connection; Press power button; Turn off and on again to reset auto shutoff.
White flakes on garments	Mineral buildup in water tank or steam vents.	Use distilled water; Perform self-clean function regularly.
