It includes a 3-inch flip IPS screen, 16X digital zoom, autofocus, Wi-Fi connectivity, and various shooting modes to enhance your creative experience.

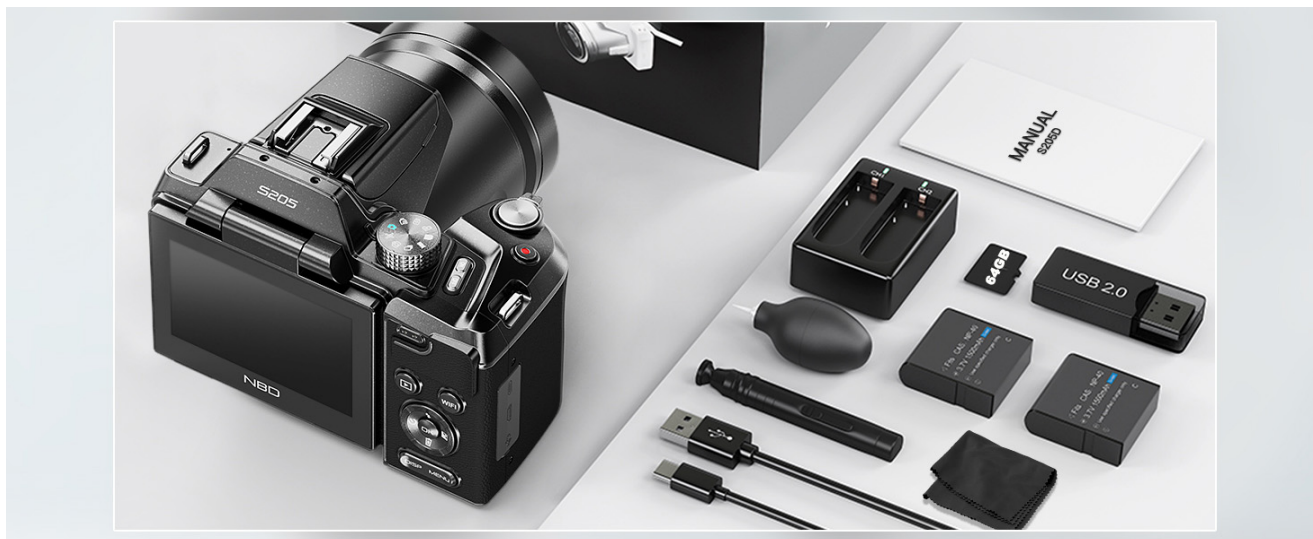

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

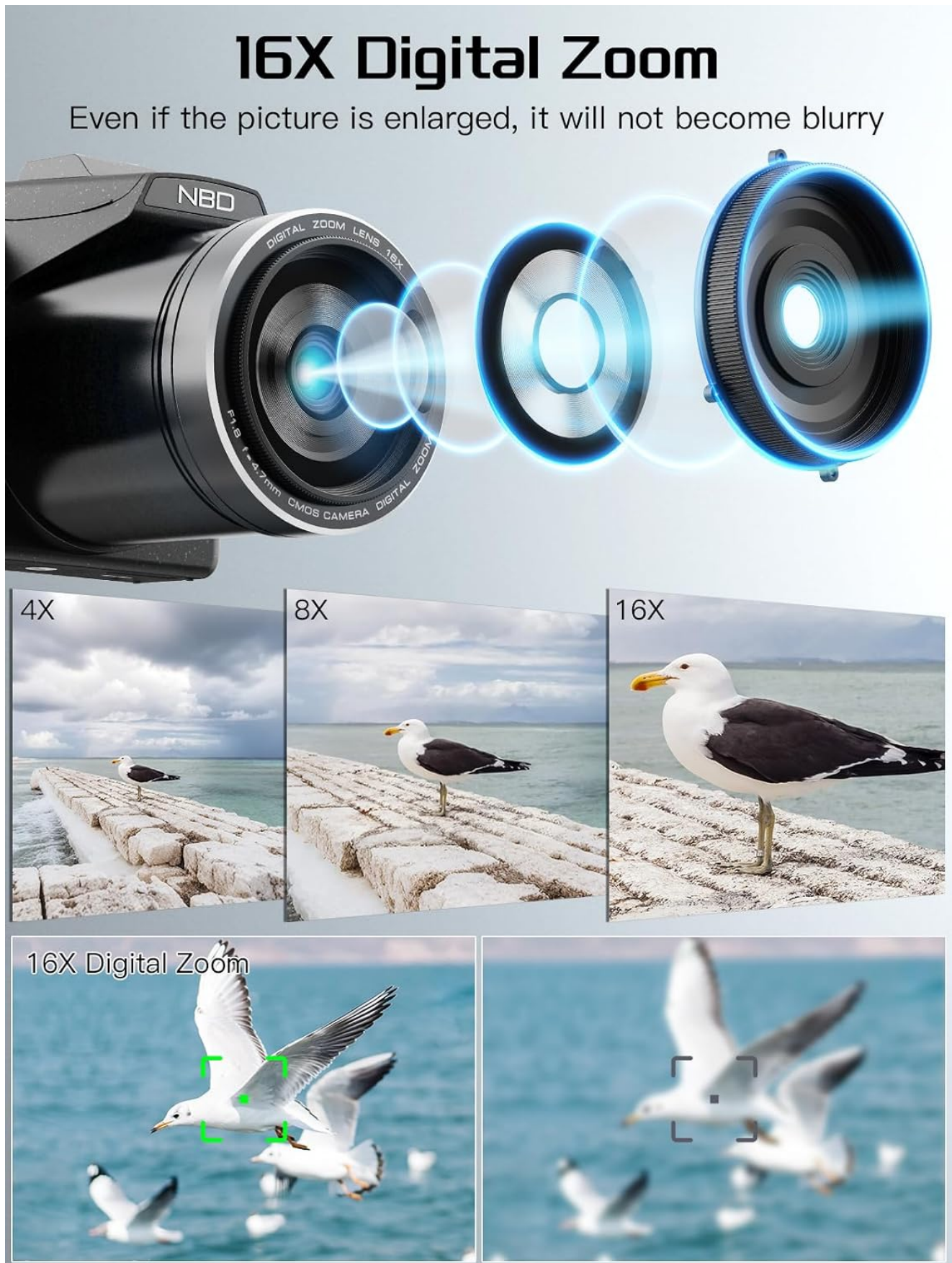

3.2 Controls and Ports

- **Power Button:** Turns the camera on or off.

- **Shutter Button:** Half-press to focus, full-press to capture.
- **Mode Dial:** Selects various shooting modes (Intelligent Scene, Program, Aperture Priority, Shutter Priority, Manual Exposure, Scene Mode, Continuous Shooting, Filter Mode).
- **Zoom Lever:** Controls the 16X digital zoom.
- **Navigation Buttons:** For menu navigation and settings adjustment.
- **Flip Screen:** 3-inch IPS screen that can rotate 180 degrees for selfies and vlogging.
- **USB Port:** For data transfer and webcam functionality.
- **HDMI Port:** For connecting to external displays.
- **Microphone Input:** For connecting the external microphone.

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

1. Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the camera.
2. Insert the rechargeable battery, ensuring the correct orientation as indicated inside the compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment cover until it clicks securely into place.

Charge the battery fully before first use using the provided charger.

4.2 Memory Card Installation

The camera supports Micro SD (TF) cards up to 64GB.

1. Locate the memory card slot on the side of the camera.
2. Insert the 64GB TF card with the metal contacts facing down, pushing it gently until it clicks into place. The TF card slot should face the icon.
3. To eject the card, push it in again until you hear a click, and it will spring out.

5. BASIC OPERATION

5.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button to turn the camera on or off.

5.2 Taking Photos

1. Turn the mode dial to the desired photo mode (e.g., Intelligent Scene, Program).
2. Frame your shot using the 3-inch flip screen.
3. Half-press the shutter button to activate autofocus. The focus frame will turn green when the subject is in focus.
4. Fully press the shutter button to capture the photo.

5.3 Recording Videos

1. Turn the mode dial to video mode.
2. Press the shutter button to start recording. A red 'REC' indicator will appear on the screen.
3. Press the shutter button again to stop recording.

5.4 Autofocus

The camera features precise autofocus. To use autofocus, half-press the shutter button. The camera will automatically detect and focus on the subject. The focus indicator on the screen will change to green when focus is achieved.

5.5 Zoom

Use the zoom lever to adjust the 16X digital zoom. Zoom in to magnify distant subjects or zoom out for a wider field of view.

5.6 Flash

The camera features a built-in flash. You can adjust flash settings (e.g., Fill Flash) through the camera menu to suit different lighting conditions.

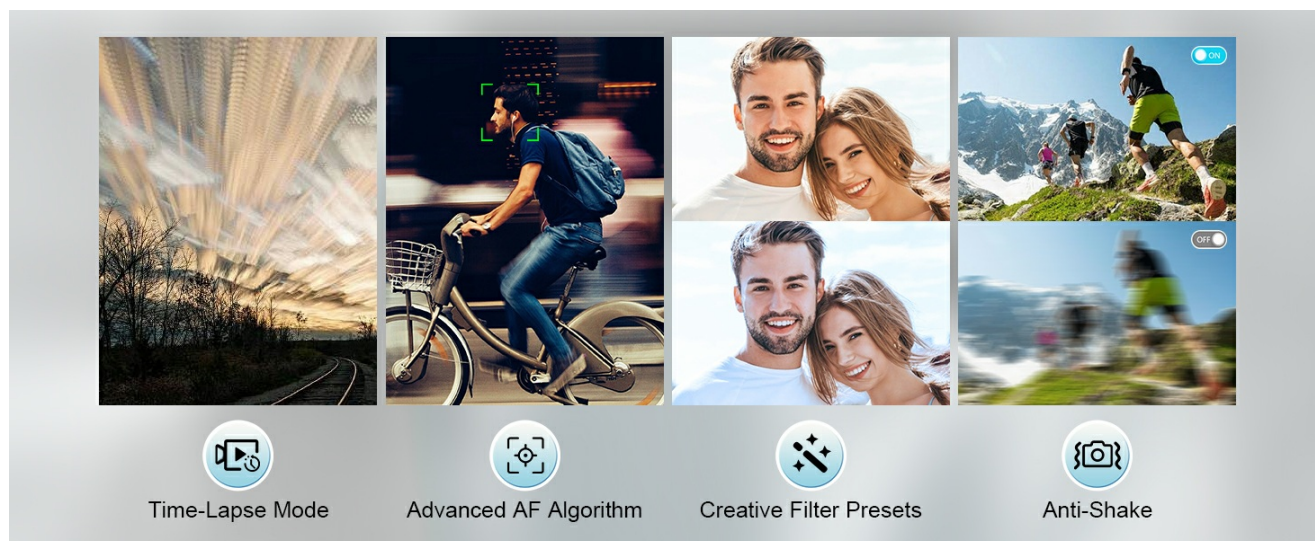

5.7 Shooting Modes

Rotate the mode dial to select from various shooting modes:

- **Intelligent Scene:** Automatically optimizes settings for common scenes.
- **Program:** Camera sets aperture and shutter speed, you control other settings.
- **Aperture Priority:** You set aperture, camera sets shutter speed.
- **Shutter Priority:** You set shutter speed, camera sets aperture.
- **Manual Exposure:** Full control over aperture and shutter speed.
- **Scene Mode:** Pre-set modes for specific scenarios (e.g., Portrait, Landscape).
- **Continuous Shooting:** Captures multiple photos in quick succession.
- **Filter Mode:** Applies creative filters to your photos.

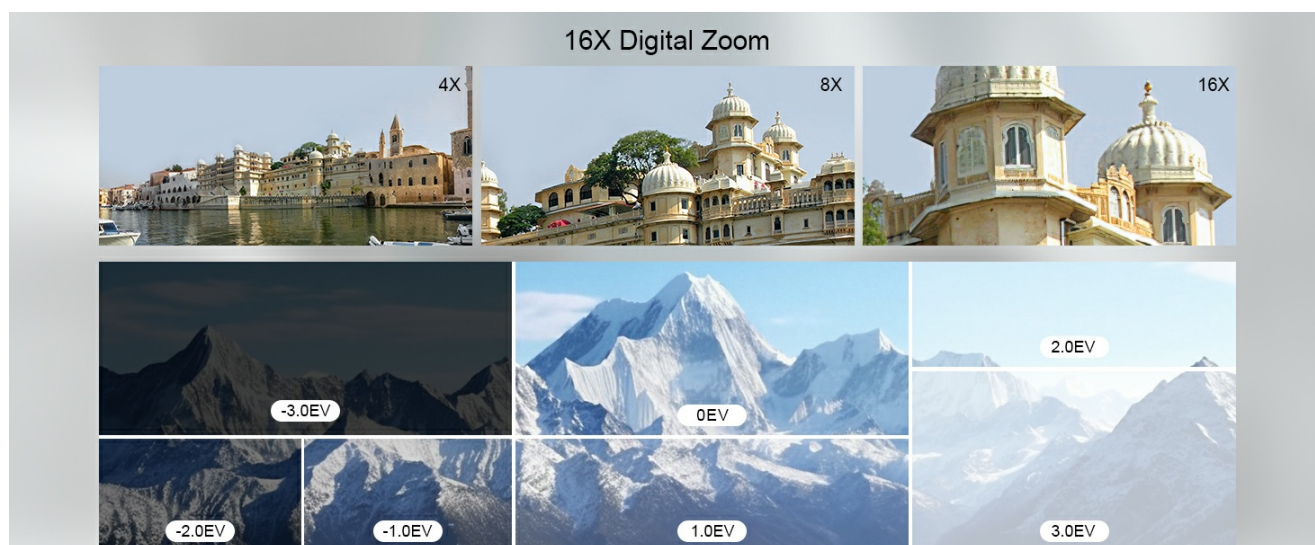

5.8 Adjusting Picture and Video Quality

You can adjust the resolution for both photos and videos through the camera's menu.

1. Press the **OK** button to access the menu.
2. Navigate to the settings for Photo Resolution or Video Resolution.
3. Select your desired resolution. For photos, options include up to 64MP. For videos, options include 8K 15FPS, 6K 25FPS, 5K 30FPS, and 4K 60FPS.

6. ADVANCED FEATURES

6.1 Wi-Fi Connectivity and App Control

The camera supports Wi-Fi for instant sharing and remote control via a mobile app.

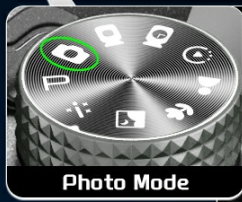
1. On the camera, navigate to the Wi-Fi settings in the menu and turn Wi-Fi on.
2. Download the dedicated mobile app (scan the QR code displayed on the camera screen or refer to the manual for app name).
3. Connect your smartphone to the camera's Wi-Fi network (SSID and password will be displayed on the camera).
4. Use the app to transfer photos/videos, control camera functions remotely, and share directly to social media platforms.

6.2 Webcam Functionality

Connect the camera to your PC via USB to use it as a high-quality webcam for live streaming or video calls.

1. Connect the camera to your computer using the provided USB cable.
2. Select 'Webcam Mode' on the camera screen if prompted.
3. Your computer should recognize the camera as a webcam. Select it in your video conferencing or streaming software.

6.3 HDMI Output

View your photos and videos on a larger screen by connecting the camera to a TV or monitor via HDMI.

1. Connect one end of an HDMI cable (not included) to the camera's HDMI port.
2. Connect the other end to an HDMI input on your TV or monitor.
3. Select the correct HDMI input on your display device.

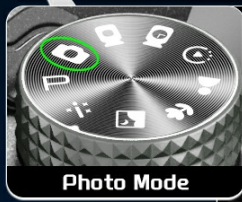
6.4 Special Shooting Modes

The camera offers advanced shooting modes for creative content creation:

- **Time-Lapse:** Capture a series of images over time and combine them into a sped-up video.
- **Slow Motion:** Record videos at a higher frame rate to play back in slow motion.
- **Continuous Shooting:** Capture a burst of photos, ideal for fast-moving subjects.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning the Camera

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body.
- For the lens and screen, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Use an air blower to remove dust from the lens surface.

7.2 Battery Care

- Store batteries in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Avoid fully discharging the batteries regularly to prolong their lifespan.
- Use only the provided charger for charging.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your camera, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not power on	Battery is depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Charge the battery fully. Reinsert the battery correctly.
Blurry photos	Incorrect focus, camera shake, or low light.	Ensure autofocus is engaged (half-press shutter). Use anti-shake feature. Increase ISO or use flash in low light.
Cannot record video/take photos	Memory card full or not inserted.	Insert a memory card. Delete unnecessary files or replace the card.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password or app issues.	Verify Wi-Fi password. Restart camera and phone. Reinstall the app.
Dark photos/videos	Insufficient lighting or incorrect exposure settings.	Use flash. Adjust ISO, aperture, or shutter speed in manual modes.
