1. Introduction

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- · Always ensure the tail light is securely mounted before riding.
- · Do not look directly into the light when it is on, as it may cause temporary vision impairment.

- Ensure the USB-C port cover is properly sealed after charging to maintain water resistance.
- This light is designed to increase visibility; it does not replace the need for safe cycling practices.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The NATFIRE A07 Smart Bike Tail Light features a compact design with advanced functionalities to enhance your visibility on the road.

Key Features:

- Smart Brake Sensing: Automatically detects deceleration and activates a brighter brake light.
- USB-C Rechargeable: Convenient and fast charging.
- 800mAh Battery: Provides extended operating time.
- 100LM Ultra Bright: High visibility output.
- IPX5 Waterproof: Resistant to water splashes from any direction.
- Versatile Mounting: Supports both horizontal and vertical installation.
- Automatic Sleep/Wake-up: Conserves battery by entering sleep mode when stationary and waking up upon movement.

Components:




Figure 2: Key features of the NATFIRE A07 Tail Light.

5. CHARGING

Before first use, fully charge the NATFIRE A07 tail light.

- 1. Locate the USB-C charging port on the side of the tail light.
- 2. Open the rubber cover protecting the USB-C port.
- 3. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the tail light and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer, wall adapter).
- 4. The indicator light will show charging status (e.g., red for charging, green for fully charged).
- 5. Once fully charged, disconnect the cable and securely close the rubber cover to maintain water resistance.

The NATFIRE A07 offers flexible installation options for various bicycle setups.

This image details two primary installation methods: using a slant bracket with a silicone strap for the seatpost, and a seat bracket for mounting under the saddle rails.

6.1. Slant Bracket Installation (for Seatpost)

- 1. Attach the silicone strap to the seatpost.
- 2. Fasten the silicone strap securely around the seatpost.
- 3. Install the tail light onto the base of the slant bracket.
- 4. The light can be installed horizontally or vertically on the bracket.

6.2. Seat Bracket Installation (for Saddle Rails)

- 1. Buckle the strap of the seat bracket, fixing it onto the seat rail track.
- 2. Install the tail light onto the bracket.

3. The light can be installed horizontally or vertically on the bracket.

7. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The NATFIRE A07 features intuitive controls for power and mode selection.




Figure 4: NATFIRE A07 Light Modes and Smart Functions.

7.1. Power On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the power button (located on the top of the light) for approximately 2 seconds.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the power button for approximately 2 seconds.

7.2. Mode Selection

With the light powered on, short press the power button to cycle through the available lighting modes:

- Running Light Mode 1: Standard steady light.
- Running Light Mode 2: Another steady light pattern or intensity.
- Double Flashing: A distinct flashing pattern for increased visibility.

7.3. Smart Functions

- Automatic Brake Light: When the light detects deceleration (braking), it will automatically switch to a brighter strobe for approximately 5 seconds to alert following traffic.
- Automatic Sleep: If the light is on and no movement is detected for a period (e.g., when you stop cycling), it will enter a sleep mode to conserve battery.
- Auto Wake Up: When movement or shock is detected while in sleep mode, the light will automatically turn on and resume its last active mode.

8. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the light with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the light in a cool, dry place when not in use. For long-term storage, charge the battery every 3-6 months to prolong its lifespan.
- Water Resistance: Ensure the USB-C port cover is always securely closed to maintain the IPX5 water resistance rating.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on	Low battery Power button not pressed correctly	Charge the light fully Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds
Light does not charge	Faulty cable or power source USB-C port obstructed	Try a different USB-C cable and power source Check the USB-C port for debris
Brake sensing not working	Light not securely mounted Sudden deceleration not detected	Ensure the light is firmly attached to the bracket and bike Brake sensing activates with significant deceleration, not minor speed changes
Auto sleep/wake-up not functioning	Constant minor vibrations Feature disabled (if applicable)	Ensure the bike is completely stationary for auto-sleep to activate Refer to operating instructions for feature activation
