1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The COZIOWOW Extra Large Chicken Coop Run (Model CW805-806) provides a spacious and secure habitat for 10-15 chickens, ducks, rabbits, or quails. Designed for outdoor use, this wooden structure includes essential features for poultry comfort and safety, such as nesting boxes, roosting bars, and a waterproof cover for all-season protection.

- **Spacious Enclosure:** Offers 54 sq ft of space for poultry to roam.
- **Comfort Features:** Includes 2 elevated roosting bars and 4 nesting boxes.
- **All-Season Protection:** Equipped with a waterproof cover to shield against rain, snow, and cold, while allowing ventilation in warmer weather.
- **Enhanced Security:** Features a reinforced solid wood frame, strong galvanized wire mesh, and secure locks to protect against predators.
- **Easy Access & Cleaning:** Designed with a 55.5-inch tall front door and additional openings for convenient egg collection, feeding, and maintenance.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the COZIOWOW Chicken Coop Run requires careful attention to the provided instructions. All parts are pre-drilled for ease of installation. It is recommended that at least two adults participate in the assembly process, and a power drill may expedite construction.

2.1 Unpacking and Part Identification

- Carefully unpack all components and verify against the parts list in your physical manual.
- Ensure all hardware (screws, bolts, latches) is present. Extra screws are typically included.
- Note that the product ships in two boxes, which may arrive at different times.

2.2 Assembly Steps

1. Begin by assembling the main wooden frame sections.
2. Attach the wire mesh panels to the frame, ensuring they are securely fastened to prevent gaps.
3. Install the elevated nesting boxes and roosting bars according to the diagrams.
4. Mount the access doors and ensure all latches operate smoothly.
5. Position the ramp for easy access to the elevated areas.

2.3 Waterproof Cover Installation

The waterproof cover is designed for seasonal use to provide additional protection. It should be draped over the entire structure and secured using the integrated ties or fasteners.

- Unroll the cover and carefully place it over the roof and sides of the coop.
- Align the openings in the cover with the coop's doors and windows.
- Secure the cover using the provided straps or ties to prevent wind displacement.
- For warmer weather, the cover can be rolled up or removed to allow for increased ventilation.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details the proper use of your COZIOWOW Chicken Coop Run to ensure the well-being of your poultry.

3.1 Poultry Placement and Acclimation

- Introduce poultry to the coop gradually, allowing them to explore the spacious run and elevated areas.
- Ensure fresh water and feed are always accessible within the run.

3.2 Utilizing Nesting Boxes and Roosting Bars

- The 4 nesting boxes are designed for egg-laying. Provide soft bedding material like straw or wood shavings.
- The elevated roosting bars offer a comfortable and secure place for poultry to sleep, promoting natural behavior.

3.3 Access and Security

- Use the 55.5-inch tall front door for easy entry and exit for human caretakers. Always secure the door with the robust latch.
- Additional side openings provide convenient access for egg collection and routine checks without entering the main run.
- Ensure all doors and openings are securely latched at all times to protect poultry from predators.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your chicken coop run.

4.1 Cleaning

- Periodically remove soiled bedding from nesting boxes and the floor of the run.
- Clean the interior surfaces with a pet-safe disinfectant.
- Inspect the wire mesh for any damage or weak points that could compromise security.

4.2 Weather Protection

- During cold or wet weather, ensure the waterproof cover is fully deployed and securely fastened to

provide insulation and protection from elements.

- In hot weather, roll up or remove the cover to allow for maximum airflow and prevent overheating.
- Regularly check the cover for tears or damage and repair or replace as needed to maintain its protective qualities.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your chicken coop run.

5.1 Predator Intrusion

- **Issue:** Signs of attempted entry by predators (e.g., raccoons, coyotes, foxes).
- **Solution:** Regularly inspect the entire structure, including the wire mesh and all latches, for any damage or weak points. Reinforce any compromised areas immediately. Ensure all doors are securely locked,

especially overnight.

5.2 Water Leakage

- **Issue:** Water entering the coop during rain or snow.
- **Solution:** Verify that the waterproof cover is correctly installed and fully extended over the roof and sides. Check for any tears or holes in the cover and repair them using waterproof tape or patch kits. Ensure the cover is tightly secured to prevent wind from lifting it.

5.3 Difficulty with Assembly

- **Issue:** Parts not fitting correctly or assembly taking longer than expected.
- **Solution:** Double-check the instruction manual diagrams and part numbers. Ensure all parts are oriented correctly. If a power drill was not used, consider using one for pre-drilled holes. If issues persist, refer to the support section for assistance.

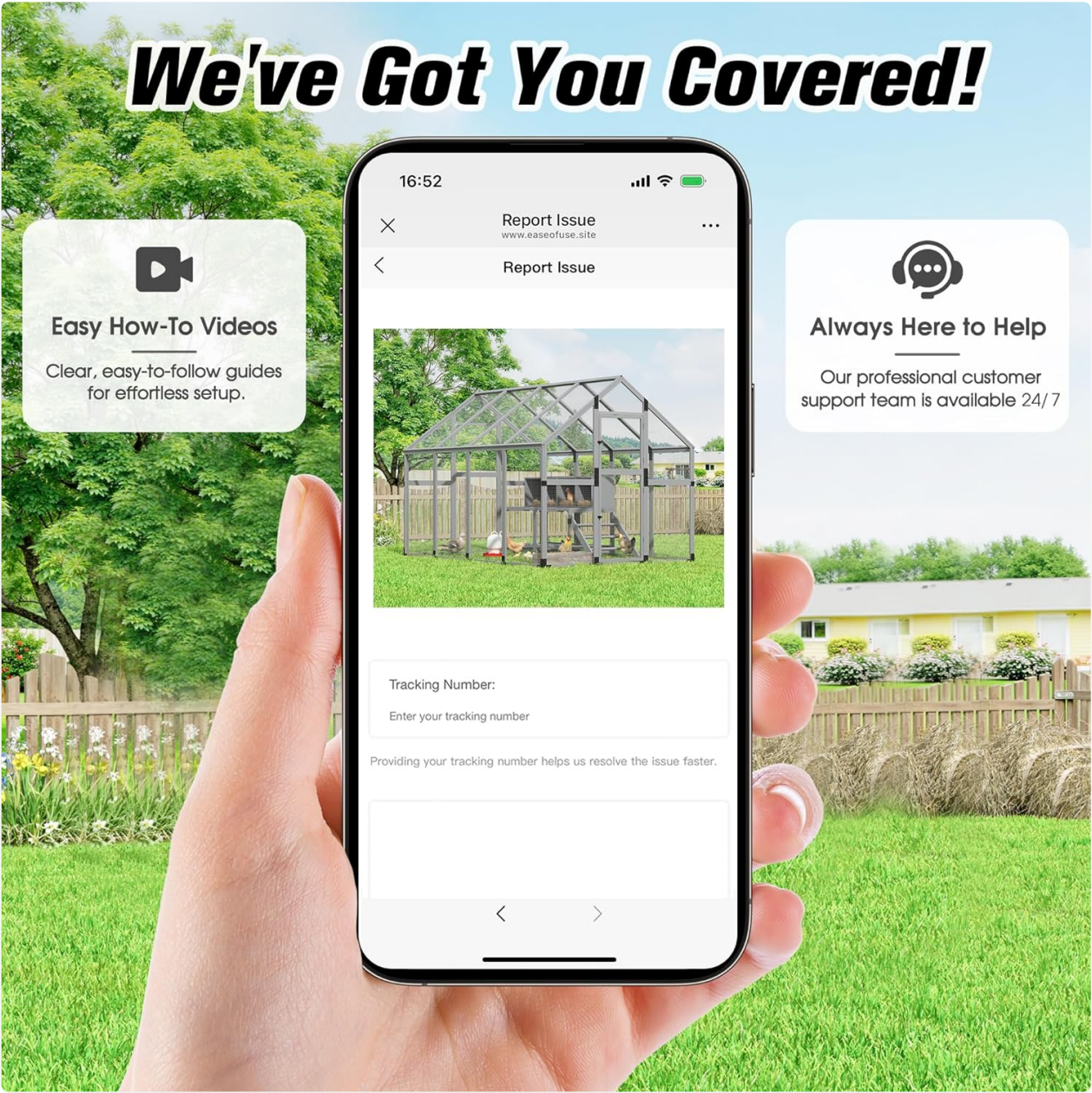





