1. INTRODUCTION

The Dell 16 Laptop DC16251 features a 16-inch 16:10 FHD+ display, an Intel Core 7 150U processor, 16GB DDR5 RAM, and a 1TB SSD. It operates on Windows 11 Home and includes Intel Graphics.

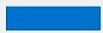
5. PORTS AND CONNECTIONS
