Homary 72-inch Kitchen Island with Sintered Stone Top Instruction Manual

1. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always use proper lifting techniques when moving the cabinet.
- Secure the cabinet to the floor to prevent tipping.
- Keep sharp edges away from children and pets.
- Do not overload the cabinet; ensure proper weight distribution.
- Always follow manufacturer's instructions for installation and use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Homary 72-inch Kitchen Island is designed to provide extensive workspace and storage for your kitchen. It features a durable sintered stone top, multiple drawers, and spacious shelves, all supported by a robust wood frame.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the packaging list for a complete inventory. Common components include:

- Sintered Stone Top
- Wood Frame Panels (Side, Back, Base)
- Drawer Components (Fronts, Sides, Backs, Bottoms, Glides)
- Door Panels and Hinges
- Adjustable Shelves and Shelf Pins
- Hardware (Screws, Dowels, Cam Locks, Handles)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires at least two people. Clear a spacious area for assembly and have the necessary tools ready.

4.1 Tools Required

- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Hammer (optional, for dowels)
- Allen Wrench (usually included with hardware)

4.2 Assembly Steps

1. **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Verify all parts against the components list.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:** Connect the base panels and side panels using the provided hardware (dowels, screws, cam locks). Ensure all connections are secure and aligned.
3. **Install Drawer Glides:** Attach the drawer glides to the interior side panels of the cabinet frame according to the pre-drilled holes. Ensure they are level and parallel.

4. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct the drawer boxes by connecting the drawer sides, front, and back panels. Slide the drawer bottom into the grooves. Attach the remaining drawer glide components to the assembled drawers.
5. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully slide the assembled drawers onto the glides in the cabinet frame. Test for smooth operation.
6. **Attach Door Hinges and Doors:** Secure the hinges to the door panels and then attach the doors to the cabinet frame. Adjust hinges as needed for proper door alignment.
7. **Install Shelves:** Insert shelf pins into the desired height positions within the cabinet compartments. Place the adjustable shelves onto the pins.
8. **Place the Sintered Stone Top:** With assistance, carefully lift and place the sintered stone top onto the assembled cabinet base. Ensure it is centered and aligned. Secure the top using the provided fasteners from underneath the cabinet.
9. **Attach Handles:** Install the handles onto the drawers and doors.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your kitchen island is designed for versatile use in your culinary space.

- **Countertop Use:** The sintered stone top provides a durable surface for meal preparation, baking, and dining. Avoid direct contact with extremely hot items; always use trivets or heat pads.
- **Drawer Functionality:** The three drawers are designed for smooth operation. Pull handles gently to open and push firmly to close. Avoid overloading drawers to maintain glide integrity.
- **Shelf Utilization:** The five adjustable shelves offer flexible storage. Distribute weight evenly across shelves. Adjust shelf height by removing pins, repositioning, and reinserting pins.
- **Seating Area:** The island can accommodate seating for two, serving as a breakfast bar or casual dining spot. Ensure appropriate stool height for comfortable use.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your kitchen island.

6.1 Sintered Stone Top Care

- **Daily Cleaning:** Wipe the surface with a soft cloth dampened with warm water and a mild, pH-neutral cleaner. Dry immediately with a clean cloth to prevent water spots.
- **Stain Removal:** For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for stone surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, or acidic cleaners (e.g., vinegar, lemon juice) as they can damage the finish.
- **Heat Protection:** While sintered stone is heat-resistant, prolonged exposure to extreme heat can cause damage. Always use trivets under hot pots and pans.
- **Scratch Prevention:** Although highly scratch-resistant, avoid cutting directly on the surface. Always use a cutting board.

6.2 Wood Frame Care

- **Cleaning:** Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For spills, wipe immediately with a slightly damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Do not allow liquids to sit on the wood surface, as this can cause warping or discoloration.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid placing the island in direct sunlight for extended periods, which can cause fading or cracking.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check and tighten any loose screws or hardware to maintain structural integrity.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to these common issues and solutions.

- **Wobbly Island:** Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened. Check that the floor is level; use shims if necessary.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Verify that drawer glides are correctly installed and aligned. Check for any obstructions within the glides or drawer tracks. Ensure drawers are not overloaded.
- **Doors Not Aligning:** Adjust the hinges on the doors. Most hinges allow for minor adjustments in height, depth, and side-to-side movement.
- **Scratches on Surface:** For minor scratches on the sintered stone, consult a professional or use a specialized repair kit. For wood, touch-up pens or furniture polish may help.
