4. INITIAL SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Bmax B2 Power Mini PC for the first time:

1. **Connect to a Display:** Use the provided HDMI cable or a DisplayPort cable to connect your Mini PC to a monitor or TV.
2. **Connect Peripherals:** Plug in your USB keyboard and mouse into the available USB ports.
3. **Connect to Power:** Connect the power adapter to the DC Power Port on the rear of the Mini PC, then plug the adapter into a power outlet.
4. **Power On:** Press the power button on the front panel of the Mini PC. The system will begin to boot.
5. **Initial Windows Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows operating system setup, including language, region, network connection, and user account creation.

5. OPERATING YOUR MINI PC

Connecting to the Internet

Your Bmax B2 Power Mini PC supports both wired and wireless internet connections.

- **Wired Connection (Ethernet):** Connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the RJ45 LAN port on the rear of the Mini PC.
- **Wireless Connection (Wi-Fi):** During initial setup, you will be prompted to connect to a Wi-Fi network. If you skipped this, navigate to Windows Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi, select your network, and enter the password. The device supports 2.4G/5G dual-band Wi-Fi 5.

Dual Display Setup

The B2 Power supports dual 4K display output via its HDMI 1.4b and DisplayPort 1.2 interfaces, enhancing productivity for multitasking environments.

1. Connect your primary monitor to either the HDMI or DisplayPort.
2. Connect your secondary monitor to the remaining video output port.
3. Once both monitors are connected, Windows should automatically detect them. You can configure display settings (extend, duplicate, etc.) by right-clicking on the desktop and selecting "Display settings."

Storage Expansion

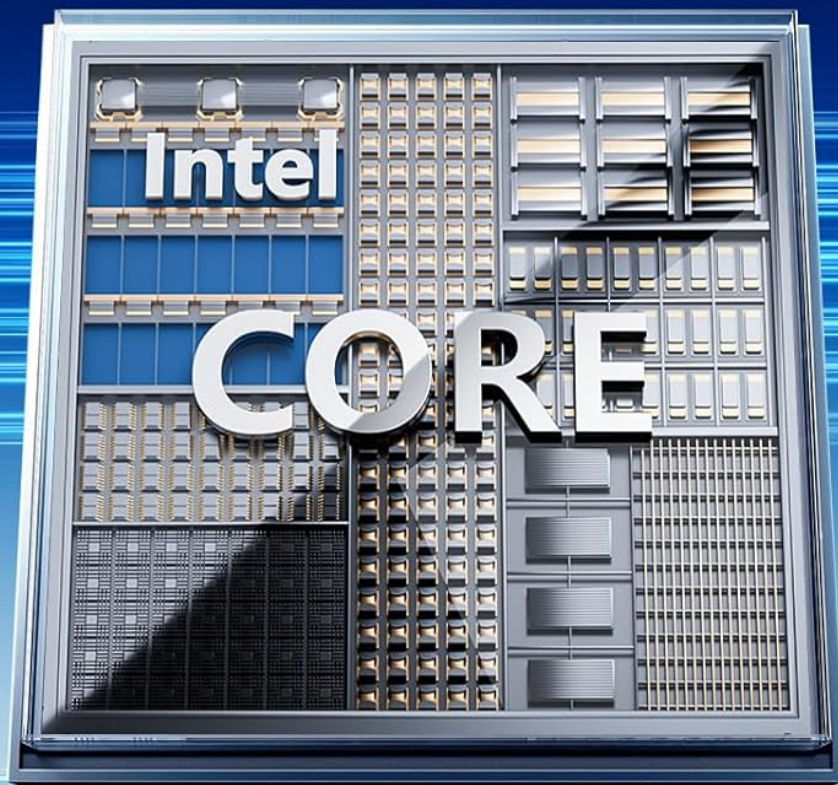



6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Mini PC.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the device. For vents, use compressed air to remove dust buildup. Ensure the device is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates and driver updates to maintain system stability and security.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clean up unnecessary files and applications to free up disk space and improve performance.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the Mini PC is placed in a well-ventilated area and that its vents are not obstructed to prevent overheating.

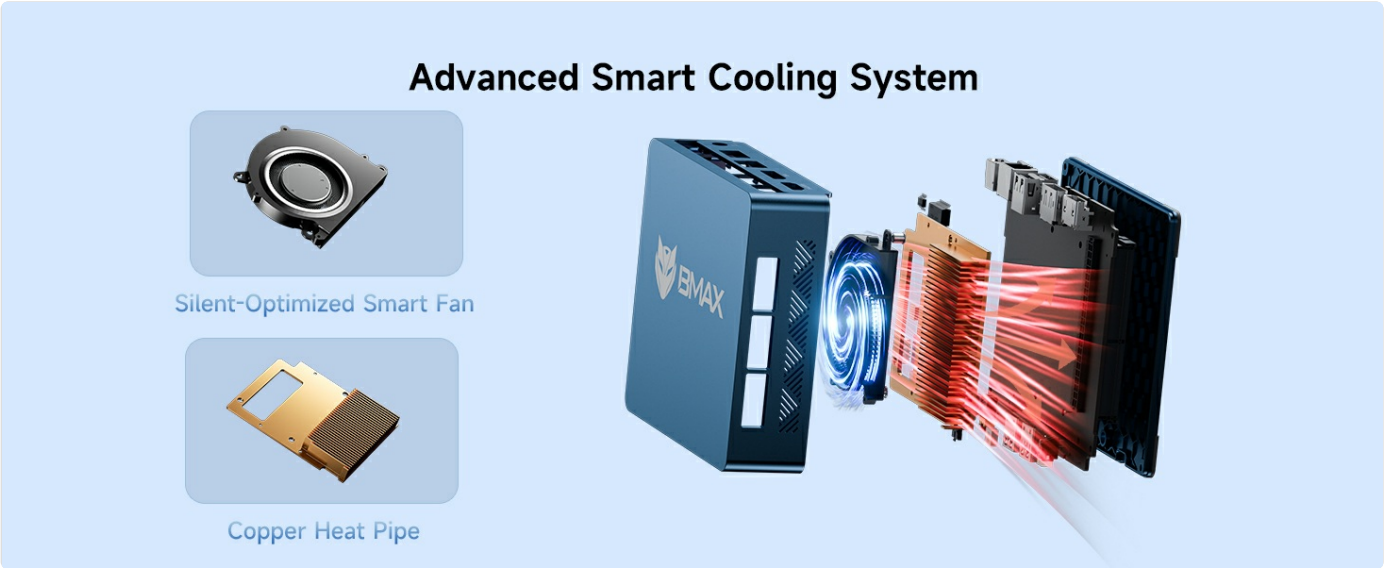


Image: Advanced cooling system design with silent-optimized smart fan and copper heat pipe.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Bmax B2 Power Mini PC.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No display on monitor	Incorrect cable connection, monitor input not selected, power issue.	Ensure HDMI/DisplayPort cable is securely connected. Select correct input on monitor. Verify power adapter is connected and power button is pressed.
No internet connection	Wi-Fi not connected, Ethernet cable loose, router issue.	Check Wi-Fi settings and password. Ensure Ethernet cable is securely plugged in. Restart your router/modem.
Slow performance	Too many background applications, low disk space, outdated drivers.	Close unnecessary programs. Free up disk space. Update Windows and device drivers.
System not booting	Power issue, corrupted OS.	Check power connections. Try the Bmax exclusive Smart Recovery System (see below).

Bmax Exclusive Smart Recovery System

If your system encounters issues, you can restore your PC to its factory-fresh condition using the Bmax recovery tool. This process typically takes 5-10 minutes.

1. **Step 1: Power On** - Power on your Mini PC.
2. **Step 2: Enter Recovery Mode** - As soon as the screen lights up, immediately and repeatedly tap the **F9** key until

the System Recovery menu appears.

3. **Step 3: Start the Recovery** - You have two options:
- Using Keyboard: Press the **Y** key to begin the factory reset.
 - Using Mouse: Click the **[Restore System]** button.

The recovery process will begin and will take approximately 5-10 minutes. Your PC may restart during this time.

4. **Step 4: Set Up Windows** - Once complete, you will be greeted by the initial Windows setup screen. Simply follow the on-screen instructions to set up your fresh system.

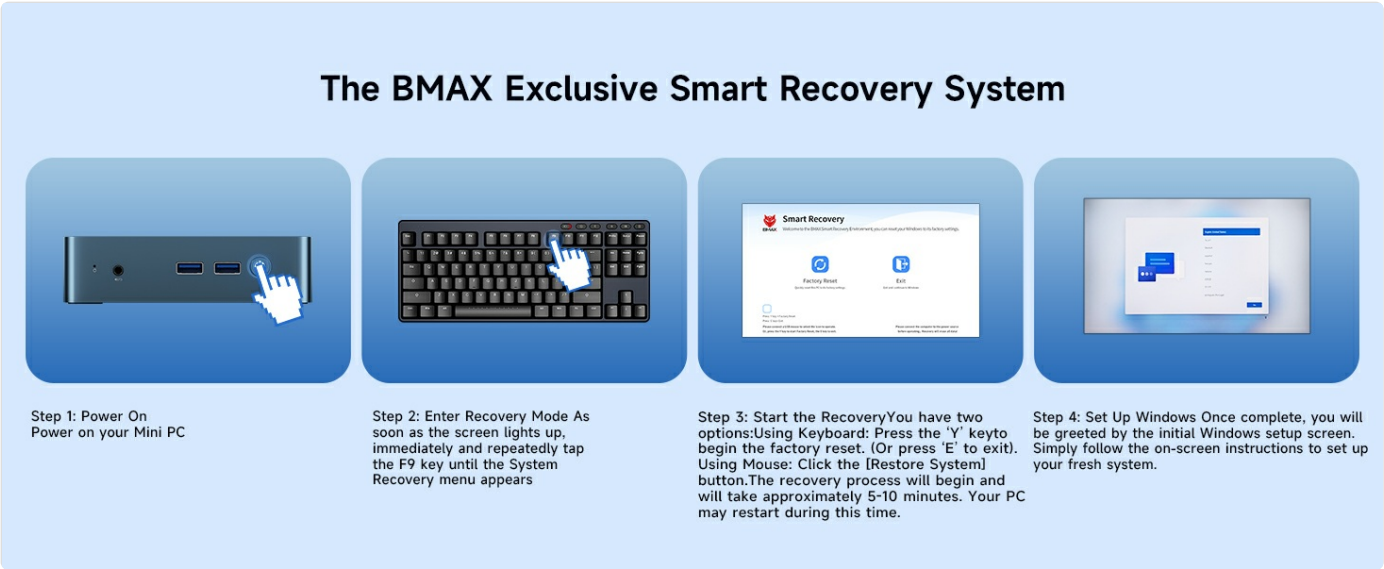


Image: Visual guide for the Bmax Exclusive Smart Recovery System.




