- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the main unit in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating label on the appliance.
- Keep out of reach of children. This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities unless supervised.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.

- Use only attachments recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Place the appliance on a stable, level surface.
- Do not overload the washing machine. Refer to the capacity guidelines.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The 3-I N-1 Portable Washing Machine is designed for efficient and quiet operation, featuring a compact form factor and multiple washing modes.

### Key Features:

### Components:

## SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.

3. **Power Connection:** Connect the charging cable to the power input port on the machine and then plug it into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, it is recommended to run a short wash cycle with only water to clean any manufacturing residues.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## **Loading Laundry:**

- Open the lid of the washing machine.
- Place a small load of clothes (e.g., underwear, socks, baby clothes) into the inner rotating basket. Do not overload the machine to ensure effective cleaning.
- Add an appropriate amount of water, ensuring it covers the clothes but does not exceed the maximum fill line (if indicated).
- Add a small amount of liquid detergent suitable for delicate items.
- Close the lid securely.

### Using the Control Panel:

The control panel features several buttons for different functions:

- **On/Off Button:** Press to power the machine on or off.
- **Wash Button:** Selects the washing cycle. The machine offers Gentle, Normal, and Strong modes. Press repeatedly to cycle through modes.
- **Rinse Button:** Initiates a rinse cycle to remove detergent residue.
- **Dehydrate Button:** Activates the dehydration (spin-dry) function to remove excess water from clothes.
- **Blue Light Button:** Activates the blue light function, which may be used for sterilization or enhanced cleaning.

## Starting a Wash Cycle:

1. Ensure the machine is plugged in and the lid is closed.
2. Press the **On/Off** button to power on the machine.
3. Press the **Wash** button to select your desired wash mode.
4. The machine will begin the selected wash cycle.
5. After the wash cycle, you may press the **Rinse** button for rinsing and then the **Dehydrate** button for spin-drying.
6. Once the cycle is complete, press the **On/Off** button to turn off the machine and unplug it.
7. Carefully remove the washed clothes.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life of your portable washing machine.

- **After Each Use:**

- Unplug the machine from the power outlet.
- Drain any remaining water completely.
- Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Leave the lid slightly ajar to allow the interior to air dry and prevent odors.

- **Deep Cleaning (Monthly):**

- Fill the machine with clean water and add a small amount of washing machine cleaner or white vinegar.
- Run a short wash cycle without clothes.
- Drain the water and wipe down the interior.

- **Storage:** Store the machine in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use for extended periods.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

| Problem                   | Possible Cause                                     | Solution   |
|---------------------------|--|--|
| Machine does not turn on. | Not plugged in; power outlet issue; damaged cable. | Ensure plug is securely inserted. Test outlet with another device. Check cable for damage. |

| Problem                       | Possible Cause   | Solution   |
|-------------------------------|--|--|
| Washing cycle not starting.   | Lid not closed properly; incorrect mode selected.                  | Ensure lid is securely closed. Press the Wash button to select a mode.       |
| Poor washing performance.     | Overloaded machine; insufficient water/detergent.                  | Reduce load size. Add appropriate amount of water and detergent.             |
| Excessive noise or vibration. | Machine not on a level surface; uneven load.                       | Place on a stable, level surface. Redistribute clothes evenly in the basket. |
| Water not draining.           | Drainage hose kinked or blocked (if applicable); drain pump issue. | Check and clear any obstructions in the drainage path.                       |
